

Scream, You Scream, We all Scream for Ice Cream!





### **Architectural Review Committee**

The ARC Policies and Procedures Manual defines and outlines the guidelines for all exterior changes to homes as well as for replacing homes. This manual is available from the office or may be downloaded from the FVRA website (Fairway Info; Home Buyers information, ARC Revised P and P). Before you begin your project please obtain a Home Replacement or Modification Request form from the FVRA office or download it (page 12, Exhibit D, in the manual) and return the completed form to the FVRA office. The ARC, which meets most Mondays in the clubhouse, looks forward to working with you in replacing your home or planning the changes to the outside of your home.



### **WWW - Meals on Wheels**

In or information on Meals on Wheels call 727-573-7773 or 727-756-1001. To qualify you must be a home-bound person of 60 years of age or older, unable to prepare nutritious meals due to physical, mental or financial limitations. The Meals on Wheels office is open Monday through Friday 8:00 - 5:00. If interested contact them and they will send you a form that must be filled out to begin your service. If you elect the full hot-meal program (one meat, two sides, milk, bread, dessert) your cost will be \$6.25 and you can expect delivery daily between 10:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. M-F. If you opt for the frozen meals (one meat and two sides) your cost will be \$3.00 and your meals will be delivered every other week between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Meals are ordered the day before delivery. Therefore, if you will not be home to accept a meal, you must contact Meals on Wheels by 10:00 a.m. the preceding day to avoid being charged for that meal.

### **June Scramble**



### Consumers nervous about online data

If you're worried about how well businesses are protecting the data they collect from you, you're far from alone. A survey from IBM found that 77 percent of consumers say that an organization's ability to keep their personal data secure is a factor in their buying decisions—and only 20 percent say they "completely trust" businesses to ensure their privacy.

The survey also found that 75 percent of buyers refuse to purchase from organizations they don't trust, regardless of the quality of their products. Another finding: Almost three-fourths of consumers believe that sellers are more concerned about profits than about privacy and data protection.

### Retirement: Golden years or a fading dream?

mericans these days are worried about their retirement—and whether they'll even be able to retire.

A Willis Towers Watson survey of approximately 5,000 U.S. workers found that 37 percent expect to keep working to age 70 or longer, up from 30 percent two years ago. Only 26 percent believe they'll be able to retire before they're 65, a drop from 29 percent in 2015.

### Minimum wage: What should it be?

ebates about the minimum wage have been heating up for years. To find out what Americans think it should be, CreditLoan surveyed 2,669 people across the country. The results? People in every state said it should be higher than the current federal level of \$7.25 an hour. On average, Americans support a minimum wage of \$11.56 an hour, allowing employees working 40 hours a week 52 weeks a year to earn \$24,044 for the year.

Most Americans, though, don't even know what the minimum wage is. Just 35.5 percent identified the actual amount correctly. The average estimate was \$8.09 an hour.

### Life on Venus? Don't write it off yet

Tenus seems an inhospitable spot for life to develop, with its superhot surface and an atmospheric pressure 90 times stronger than Earth at sea level. Yet, a Fox News website article suggests, ruling out the possibility of life on the second planet from the Sun may be premature.

Venus had a more temperate environment billions of years ago, covered by seas for eons, and thus may have been habitable for some organisms for much of its history. Today, its upper atmosphere is much less forbidding and comparable to the pressure and temperature of Earth's surface. Some scientists speculate that ancient life could have risen and migrated to higher altitudes after the dramatic climate change that turned Venus' surface into the barren landscape it is today. Others suggest that microbial life could have arrived on Venus from Earth, borne on rocks hurled into space by meteorite impacts over the last 4.5 billion years.

The opposite could also be true—meaning that Earth could have been "invaded" by Venusian life in the distant past.

### **Sharpen your powers of persuasion**

ou need other people's help if you want to succeed. Try these two tips to get them on your side:

- Give to get what you want. It's the code of reciprocity—people are more likely to go along with your ideas if you give them something first. For example, leaders at the Disabled American Veterans discovered that when they mailed fund-raising letters without a perk, about 18 percent of their appeals were successful. When they included free personalized address labels, they had a success rate of 35 percent.
- Call people to nobler conduct. If you are seeking agreement on an issue, allow people the chance to contribute. For example, a Chicago restaurant cut its reservation no-show rate from 30 percent to 10 percent by asking people to call if their plans changed rather than telling them to call. In pausing after the question, "Will you please call if you have to change your plans?" restaurant staff found customers more willing to commit to an answer.
