










Telcome to another season of FSO dances. A calendar of all dances for October thru April is located in the Clubhouse on the Dance Kiosk.

Please Note this summary of the new FSO policy for dance tickets:

"On the first night of ticket sales, tickets can only be pmchased for Fairway residents (2 per home). After that, if tickets remaining, residents can purchase 2 additional tickets per home for guests and 2 for themselves if not purchased earlier."

One person can still purchase tickets for a table on behalf of other residents.

To help facilitate ticket selling, we are now using a standard form for filling out your infonnation for tickets, rather than bits of paper or index cards. The "Ticket Info" Forms will be located in a container on the Dance Kiosk in the Clubhouse. Please fill out and bring to Thursday ticket sales dates at the Clubhouse. We will have new color coded tickets for each dance. If you want to use an old ticket from a prior dance or a door prize ticket, please turn it in on the ticket sale night for the dance you want to attend and exchange it for a new color coded ticket and table number. Old tickets can be exchanged for all dances except the Poppy Dance and New Years EveDance.

Thanks for all the suggestions on how we can improve our dances. Please continue to contact Ron orAl with your ideas. We have had many requests to change the dance time from 8pm-llpm to 7:30pm-10:30pm. We will try the earlier time this season for all dances, except the New Years Dance.




