Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

re are now into the fall/winter mowing schedule – one cut in November on Tuesday, the 14th. After that cut you are free to put up holiday lights and lawn decorations. If you need repair to your home, please remember to hire only licensed and insured contractors. If you have any questions, contact the FSE office or talk to a board member.

New coach #480 is for sale. Contact Pat Long at 727 505 5591 for additional information. Also four lots are available.

PLEASE LET THE OFFICE KNOW IF are leaving the park for any length of time. And also notify the office when you return. This helps to keep our resident records up to date. Provide any up to date telephone numbers and update emergency contact information. Many times the numbers are outdated in just a short time.

If you wish to have Alexander's Landscape Maintenance Company take care of your weeding/trimming of flower beds/planters, email Desiree at djenkins@associagulfcoast.com and she will contact Ryan Hudson, our representative. Ryan is generally in our park on the mowing days. If your planter is overgrown and needs attention, the FSE office has the right to hire out this work to be completed & then charge you, the owner, as necessary. 
If you are a registered voter in Florida, one of the important items on the ballot this year will be a referendum for Penny for Pinellas – City of Largo.



A MESSAGE FROM OUR PARK CHAPLAIN

s what God gave us in His Word true? Well let's consider this, it says in Exodus 3:14; "And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you."

When Moses first met with God, he was frightened and unsure as a voice came to him from a burning bush. God told him to go to Pharaoh and set the children of Israel free. Moses asked for God's name since he believed that people would want to know who was sending him on such a bold mission. God told Moses "I AM THAT I AM" sends you or the Self Existent One.

God had Moses write the first five books of the Old Testament - The Pentateuch - which contains the Creation of the heavens and the earth and ancient human history. Much of it is spectacular, and filled with supernatural events. To some it is unbelievable.

Let's test it. A people named Hittites are mentioned in Genesis 15:20. God promised to give Abraham the land previously occupied by the Hittites. Abraham buried Sarah, his wife, in a field he purchased from Ephron the Hittite, Genesis 23:10-20. David the King fathered Solomon by Bathsheba, previously married to Uriah the Hittite. The Hittites are mentioned 48 times, and in some of the most critical places, and they have a prominent role in Biblical History. But, many scholars denied the existence of a people known as Hittites, just as they still deny so many other things of God's Word.

But, In 1904, a German cuneiform expert named Hugo Winkler got news of many clay tablets found at Boghaz-Koy, an ancient city about 100 miles east of Ankara, Turkey. There he excavated between 1904 and 1913 found about 10,000 clay tablets. After deciphering, and translating (one of the great achievements in Near Eastern archaeology) they revealed that Boghaz-Koy was the site of the Hittite empire's capital called Hattusha. The Hittite language has since been studied and classified with other Indo-European languages of which German and English are a part. Once again the Bible has proven to stand the test of historical accuracy, and it will absolutely stand the test, any test, because its author is all-knowing.

Remember that Moses told us of the Hittites, though some scholars foolishly doubted their existence. What God had Moses scribe is totally reliable and trustworthy, and it's really of God who is "the self-existent one". His existence does not depend on anything outside himself. He had no beginning, and will have no ending. He has no predecessor, and no equal. Everything that is important to us depends upon him and his powerful and righteous decrees. Let us encourage one another to spend our days studying the Bible's truths, and to apply them in our life.




