

PARK MANAGER'S REPORT

The shuffleboard and pool area expansion and improvement is underway. By the time you read this, we are expecting that the pool renovation will be completed. Special thanks to Geri Howlett and the ROC Board for all their work on behalf of Four Seasons residents. The pool area is a great attraction for potential homeowners. Also, special thanks to Pointe West for opening their pool facilities to our residents during renovation. The shuffleboard courts project is scheduled for early April.

The office staff (Desiree and Beryle) continues to be extremely busy at this time of year; sales and rentals, paperwork on a variety of projects, support for the Resident Review Committee, servicing our residents' complaints and other important issues. Beryle did a wonderful job completing the 55+ census properly as per HUD regulations. And many thanks to Beryle for covering the office when Desiree is unavailable.

Management has contacted both City of Largo & Pinellas County regarding algae growth observed in both the canal between Grosse Pointe & Four Seasons Estates and the channel between Pointe West and FSE. I have repeatedly requested some sort of communication of any scheduling so I can relay to concerned residents in intelligent fashion. Dead growth along the bank at the channel will be removed as soon as possible on Four Seasons Estates side where the City of Largo had sprayed. The invasive water lettuce by Ulmerton Road was sprayed & successfully remedied by our Pinellas County representative.

Management also worked with the SAC & called in Largo Piping & Gas to retrofit a new supply line to the kitchen gas stove & a safety device was implemented in place to prevent movement of the stove

Clubhouse exit signs are being updated & repaired. There was a suggestion at the latest board meeting regarding the possibility of a speed hump that I researched & found that we can do the work ourselves without permitting if that decision comes to fruition.

Asphalt Maintenance promised to come out & black out some white striping areas that are bleeding through & redo white striping where we do have stop signs in place.

Fill dirt & St. Augustine grass was added in front of the dock area to refurbish low areas. Many park stumps will be ground down soon & Clay will commence retrofitting individual coach shut off valves in the coming weeks. Tampa Bay Plumbers should have their bid/proposal on next step(s) in about a week or two for our Board review.

Many of our winter residents will soon be leaving for northern homes. Please sure to let Desiree know when you leave the Park and update your contact/emergency information if necessary. It is important for park safety that we know which units are occupied or not.

If you notice a street light out in your area, jot down the number on the pole and give Desiree a call. She will notify Duke Energy for repair.



We also appreciate your cooperation on our trash/recycling pick-up days. Trash in a covered trash receptacle will keep the streets clean and the animals and birds under control. An instructional flyer will be left at your coach's door when a proper trash receptacle is not implemented.

For those owners who wish to have Alexander's (or any individual/other company) care for your planter and/or flower beds while you are away, I am requesting that you deal directly with Alexander's and contract with them. Greetings in Jesus' Name from Chuck and Linda Truitt: 10 March, 2016

Today is a milestone for Linda and me; it marks 33 years that we have been missionaries with BIMI (Baptist International Missions, Inc.). I recall very well when we met with the BIMI board on the Campus of TTU, above the mail room, in Chattanooga, TN. I'm looking (in my minds eye) at Drs. Tom Freeny, Jim Kennard, Don Sisk, Leroy Perry, Lee Roberson, and J.R. Faulkner. Linda and I were absolutely certain that we were in the center of God's Perfect Will. We've spent over half of our lives overseas in service of our country (USMC), and of the Lord, and have been in just over 50 countries and provinces. Right now I'm kind of side-lined medically, but hopefully that shouldn't be much longer. Nevertheless, we are managing to stay busy for the Lord and seeing souls saved and coming closer to Christ in the mean time.

Let me tell you about Charles, an 86 year old Korean War Marine, and later an Air Force Airman whom I've been befriending for several months. About four weeks ago he was on his back in bed while I went through the plan of salvation in the KJV. He squeezed my hand - really hard - as he prayed and asked Jesus to forgive, and save him. Last week I had mixed emotions as I attended, with many others, a memorial service for him, complete with The Patriot Guard Riders, representatives from the local Police Department, and a couple hundred others.

This past October I had a relapse of the CHF that waylaid me on Okinawa in January 2000. Then in November I was in the hospital again with what they thought was a heart attack. After an inspection of my arteries doctors said they look like a 30 or 40 year old man. Turns out I have contracted a virus in my heart muscles. That helps explain why I have been in such dire shape for the past many months. The doctors suggested that maybe by April I'll be better. I do feel better, but have very little stamina.

Thank you for your continued faithfulness to support us in the midst of our medical difficulties. Be sure, folks continue to be ministered to, and souls are still being saved.

We continue to hold Chapel Services in the Four Seasons clubhouse on Sundays at 9AM. Once again I want to thank you all. And encourage you to always remember to thank God for everything - Colossians 1:12-14. In Christ's Service, Chuck and Linda Truitt



WHERE IN THE WORLD HAVE YOU BEEN?

ISITING CUBA PEOPLE TO PEOPLE: During my nine day trip to Cuba in February, I saw the country thru the eyes and words of the people. Our Cuban tour guide/ translator and the American escort provided the dialogue necessary for us to learn their culture and for the people to experience ours. At every stop it was permissible for either side to ask and to receive answers on any topic.

Our travel every day took us up, thru and over the low mountains. Roads were good but rough and always filled with two wheeled carts pulled by oxen, or one horse. People walked, rode bicycles, or rode packed shoulder to shoulder in old army vehicles or school buses. Scenery went from foothills, comparable to our Smoky Mts. with narrow roads and hairpin turns, to areas that looked like Rocky Mt. foothills but without cactus. The rock was crumbly instead of solid with flat farmland covered in sugar cane. We would round a curve and before us was a view of lakes, rivers, and rolling mountains.

In the town squares you saw the young people of Cuba with the cell phones and more modern fashions. Relatives in the US would send a cell phone, then in the square one person would have a lap top, this person would pay the fee to hook up to the internet, then all the cell phone users would pay them a Cuban dollar for an hour to use the wifi, so they could talk to relatives.

Santiago de Cuba is a historical city; it is like going to Washington DC for us. San Juan Hill, changing of the guards at historic grave site, monuments to heroes, free concerts for the people, etc.

The Cuban people live in houses of crumbling stones, no doors, some just old wooden slats laid together, but they keep their living area and themselves clean. After hurricane Sandy, the government was right there to put some kind of roof over their heads and provide basic furniture and food items. They were polite, helpful, and happy and proud of their country. They do not have guns or drugs. Government provides healthcare, but toilet paper, soap, shampoo, aspirin (or any normal over the counter items available to us) are unavailable. The average wage is \$25.00 per month, there is an allotment given on some items such as rice and sugar, farmers are able to keep 20% of what they raise to sell or barter to neighbors for their income.

I enjoyed my people to people visit; otherwise I would have not known Cuba. The people brought it to life. I saw the heart of Cuba presented by the people who enjoyed sharing themselves - thru music and contentment - even though they have next to nothing.

Although several airlines are preparing for flights from Florida, I'm not sure that the island nation is ready for an influx of tourists – it will take time to have transportation, airports, and hotels in place to welcome the outside world




