

# **HOW TO RECOGNIZE A STROKE!**

ometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. This might be a lifesaver if we can remember the three questions. Doctors now say any bystander can recognize a stroke by asking three simple questions:

Ask the individual to smile Ask him or her to raise both arms Ask the person to speak a simple sentence

If he or she has difficulty with any of these tasks, call 911 immediately and describe the symptoms to the dispatcher. Widespread use of this test could result in prompt diagnosis and treatment and prevent brain damage.

uestion: Is it legal to feed birds and other wildlife?

Answer: Feeding wildlife is generally discouraged and, in some cases, illegal. In Florida, it is illegal to feed manatees, Sandhill cranes, bears, raccoons, foxes, and alligators. Intentionally placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts black bears, foxes, raccoons, or Sandhill cranes and thereby creates a public nuisance is prohibited.

Additionally, intentionally feeding species listed as threatened, endangered, or of special concern - including Florida scrub-jays - is prohibited unless authorized by FWC permit. Feeding listed species



is prohibited because it can negatively alter feeding behavior in some species and can cause them to become accustomed to people.

Feeding wildlife often has a detrimental rather than a helpful effect. Feeding animals may cause some species to concentrate so much on this supplemental feeding that they become a nuisance or a threat to people (e.g., bears, Sandhill cranes). When fed, alligators can overcome their natural wariness and learn to associate people with food. When this happens, some of these alligators have to be removed and killed.

Please neighbors, DO NOT FEED THE ALLIGATORS. You are putting yourself at risk and not doing the alligators any favors!

- Make an itemized list of personal property and take photos.

Hurricane Warning means that a hurricane is expected within 24 hours. If there is a MANDATORY EVACUATION, <u>all</u> residents must leave when notified. Announcements will be made over the radio and TV. Decide in advance where you would go (a friend, relative, or hotel). Leave early. If you need assistance in evacuation, you should register in advance with the Largo Fire Department. THERE ARE FORMS IN THE CLUBHOUSE ON THE CREDENZA. Also a list of hotels in non-evacuation zones.

### If you must evacuate:

- Take your survival kit, important papers including identification with local address, jewelry and any other items of value.
- Let friends or relatives know where you will be going.
- Turn off electricity, gas and water.
- Check your neighbors and make sure they have a ride.
- Lock all windows and doors when leaving.
- Drive carefully to nearest assigned shelter.

**Once evacuation is lifted**, and you can return home, beware of fallen branches, flooding and hanging electrical wires. Before entering your home:

- Check for damage from the outside.
- Turn water, gas and electricity back on.
- If area has been without power for extended period, the perishables in your refrigerator may have to be discarded.

# **GOOD NEIGHBOR TIP #2!**

ow that the rainy season has started, please check to be sure there is no standing water in your yard to attract mosquitos. And if your neighbor is away, please walk around his/her home as well. Empty flower pots and lid covers are a great place for mosquitos to lay their eggs!

## **KEEP THIS IN MIND WHEN PREPARING FOR THE WORST**

The worry about shopping for bottled water and bread and milk, and there are plenty of things we should keep in our pantry (peanut butter, crackers, soups, etc.), but it's most important to stock up on fresh produce, says Barry Swanson, a food scientist at Washington State University. "You want some nutrients and some fiber – something to keep your diet normal."

Although you may think of fruit and vegetables as having a shorter shelf life, Swanson says many of them can last for quite a while. Here's a list of go-to fruits and veggies, and the reason behind why you should be sure and snag a few before the next storm.

Apples. Skip quick-ripening bananas and reach for long-lasting apples. They're high in fiber, and can last for up to three months when stored somewhere cool and dry.

Citrus fruits. With high acid content and thick skin, fruits like oranges and grapefruits can last for up to two weeks without refrigeration, particularly if you buy them on the under-ripe side. Plus, think about all that vitamin C you'll be getting, and the hydration from the juice.

Avocados. Buy this one unripe, and it will last for at least a week at room temperature, providing plenty of vitamins and minerals (and a delicious meal during a crisis).

Tomatoes. When purchased unripe, these antioxidant-packed fruits (nope, not a vegetable!) will last for up to a week unrefrigerated.

Potatoes, sweet potatoes, and yams. These tasty root vegetables, loaded with potassium, will last for about a month if stored in a cool, dark place.

Cucumbers and summer squash. These vegetables will last a few days without refrigeration and don't need to be cooked.

Winter squash. These guys should keep for up to a few months. If you've still got access to a working stove (or outdoor grill), cooked squashes such as acorn and butternut are nutritious and delicious.

Assuming you've got a working cooking source, most of these veggies can be cooked up into a yummy soup, but plenty of them can be eaten raw and will last you quite a while. Now, make sure you have plenty of stormy entertainment to keep you busy when you're not eating!






