plastic cups, etc.), mixed paper, aluminum cans, aluminum foil and trays, tin or steel food cans, glass (any color) flattened cardboard and paper cartons (milk and juice) etc. What we CAN'T recycle is plastic bags (trash bags, Ziplock bags, grocery bags, etc.), plastic wrap, no Styrofoam packaging or take-out containers, constructions materials, hazardous materials/electronics (batteries, computer, light bulbs, etc.), "molded" plastic, or plastic items without a recycling symbol.

James and Clay have become CPO certified (Certified Pool Operators). They are both maintaining our pool now and taking real good care of it. Come by and look at the pool and our new pool sign. The shower has also been retiled. The pool heater has now been turned on. All our residents should have a warm swim.

If you need repair to your home, please remember to hire only licensed and insured contractors. If you have any questions, contact the FSE office. Please come to the office for a Construction Request, you only need a construction request for work you are doing to the outside of your home, ex (mailbox, painting house, painting driveway, gardens, windows, roof, siding, concrete, pavers, carports, doors, handrails, awnings etc.). A construction request needs to be filled out and approved by our Construction Committee. You will also need to check with the City of Largo to see if your contractor will need to pull a permit. Most contractors know whether they need a permit or not. PLEASE make sure that the office receives a copy of the permit.

ALLIGATORS!!! If you see anyone feeding an alligator please report it to FWC Law Enforcement, this kind of behavior is illegal, and they will get fined. I have posted flyers with the law enforcement phone number up at the Clubhouse or you can call the office and request the number. I also have an FWC open permit for catchers to come out and catch the alligators. If you see a gator please report it, even the little ones, you can get fined for feeding and for touching.


Four Seasons has five empty lots - #162, 366, 440 and 446. Lots #440, #205 and #446 have houses that have been approved and the housing committee is ready to move forward with the permits for these homes. Our new Unit #205 has arrived, come by and look. #205 has been put together, plumbing set on 11/13/2018, so we will continue to move forward with this home.

Please let the office know if you ARE NOT receiving VOLO messages so we can update our emergency list. All the emergency messages are sent by phone call, text message and/or email, so if your phone number has changed or your email has changed it is important to let us know.

PLEASE LET THE OFFICE KNOW if are leaving the park for any length of time. And notify the office when you return. This helps to keep our resident records up to date. Provide any up to date telephone numbers and update emergency contact information. Many times, the numbers are outdated in just a short time.

If your planter is overgrown and needs attention, or your house needs power washed, or your driveway and home need painting the FSE office will send out a violation letter to inform

you that this work needs to be done in a timely manner (please read the rules and regulations). Now please understand that some of these letters that go out do take a while for you to receive, so sometimes the work is completed before you receive the letter. If that's the case, just call the office and let us know. Please be sure that the outside of your home is kept neat year-round. Alexanders will no longer be doing summer weeding. I have a few contacts to call for weeding, Karen Delmont, her number is 330-367-7853 and Paul Young 727-348-2414. You will have to call and discuss charges with them.

Please advise the office if any damage is done by the lawn crew on cutting days as soon as possible. We then can address this issue immediately and have an immediate response system in place.

We appreciate your attention to the Pinellas County water restrictions in place. They are posted on the bulletin board in the clubhouse. PLEASE NOTE THAT WATER IS VALUABLE. USE IT WISELY. A SHUT OFF NOZZLE OR ANOTHER WATER-EFFICIENT DEVICE MUST BE USED. Water is our most valuable commodity - it is not free! If you do not have a copy of the current restrictions, the office will gladly make you a copy. Check your garden hose daily just in case you forget to turn it off.

FSE Office hours are Monday-Friday 9-3PM. The office phone is 727-584-1413, Office Fax is 727-581-8505. Please be sure to see the office if you need to update your emergency contact information or address/phone number. After hours, the clubhouse can be accessed with your key card through the side door. If your key card does not work, please come in and have it checked first before you dispose of it. If you lose your key card to the door it is \$5 for a replacement card. Don't forget we have an after-hours emergency phone # that goes directly to Associa offices (727)-577-2200.

Also, please remember to tell the office if you notice any unregistered occupants. Everyone staying over a month that is not family needs to come to the office and fill out the proper application for a background check. Make sure if you are selling your home that before any sale closes or any money is exchanged that buyers also get an application for a background and credit check. 10% of the homes in this park can be under 55 years old but not younger than 45. If you have any questions or concerns, please ask.

Please watch out for your neighbors' homes - be alert - and report issues to the police if you ever feel threatened or scared. Thank you, Desiree Jenkins, Park Manager

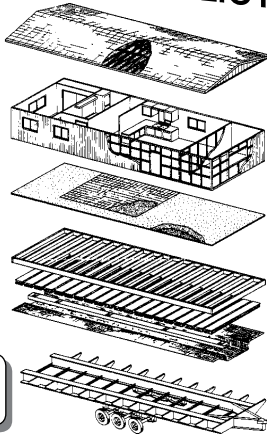

Urban or rural, it was common to see cows randomly milling about sharing the road, since Hindus consider them sacred. We were able to hitch a ride on a bicycle rickshaw in Old Delhi, which felt like being on a crazy Disney ride with other bikes and vehicles coming at you from every direction.

We experienced the beauty of India as an explosion of colors. So many people, so many colorful costumes, women often draped in colorful fabrics head to toe (saris), and men in turbans and long cotton garments. Hindu religious traditions were visible everywhere. One day we saw a festival procession of people traveling in colorful caravans noisily and joyfully celebrating Ganesha, the elephant-headed Hindu god.

Yes, we drank nothing but bottled water (to avoid illness), but this was always provided by the hotels or tour bus. Food, in general, was a part of the adventure. Rice and vegetables with curry are staples of the Indian diet, and often with chicken added. But no beef, even at McDonalds! If a menu says “beef”, it is probably serving ox or water buffalo.

We also experienced folk music and dancing, hand weaving of Persian rugs, puppet performances, and painting demonstrations, and the hand inlaying of semi-precious stones in marble known as pietra dura, which mimicked the art on the Taj Mahal.

We visited several notable and amazing architectural wonders like tombs and shrines, but the high point of the trip had to be the Taj Mahal in Agra, which must be seen to be fully appreciated. It is the largest structure in a whole complex of buildings, gardens and pools. The delicate floral patterns of semi-precious stones in the marble are unbelievable works of art. The Taj is actually a tomb that contains Shah Jahan and his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal from 1643.

The last few days were spent in Kathmandu, Nepal which is a gateway city to Mt. Everest and the Himalayas. It is primarily Buddhist and was nearly as colorful as India, but the dress was a bit more modern (westernized). It is smaller and poorer than its neighbor, and is still recovering from a major earthquake in 2015. We visited many Buddhist shrines and temples in Kathmandu, and was immersed in the many Buddhist traditions. Troops of monkeys could be found running wild at most of our stops. Remarkably, one Nepalese tradition that we were able to witness was outdoor public cremations. We watched from across a small river while 4 cremations were each at different stages of completion. At this site, as many as 50 cremations were performed per day!

If you are ready for exotic and unpredictable travel, India and Nepal may be perfect for you, too. We loved every minute of it. Chris & Terry Helopoulos

Coldest place in the world

You may think it's cold where you live right now—if you're in the northern hemisphere, at least—but scientists have located the absolute coldest spot on Earth. No surprise—it's in Antarctica.



The National Geographic website reports that satellite data have identified an ice sheet in the middle of the southern continent with a temperature of minus 144 degrees Fahrenheit. This breaks the previous record for the chilliest place on the globe—minus 128 degrees, recorded in 1983 at the Russian Vostok Station close to the South Pole. At that low temperature, breathing itself is dangerous—more than a few breaths would make your lungs hemorrhage.

Chances are we won't find any colder places. Increases in greenhouse gases and water vapor in the air have scientists expecting a rise in temperatures across the Antarctic of three to four degrees in the coming years.
