I will continue to be in the office as a liaison for Kathleen and to answer any licensure based questions on policies, bid processes, etc. Once Kathleen becomes fully up to speed in her role, my presence in the office will be on an “as needed” basis. I would also like to state for our homeowners and those ROC members who were not in attendance at the last shareholder meeting, that any and all changes in policies and staff have been a joint venture with full Board approval and unanimous vote. We are and continue to be a Board of seven.

Another item to be addressed is the renting and selling of your homes. There have been a few changes to the process. If you are renting your home, the prospective renter/s must come to the office and fill out an admittance packet. This has to be done prior to the rental. Once filled out, we will run a credit check and background check on them. The minimum credit score is now 650. The same holds true if you are selling your home, whether it is with or without a share. As an owner in either scenario, you cannot just simply rent your home or sell it without prior approval from the office. We have a vetting process in place that must be followed. Going forward, there will be two (2) board members doing all interviewing of prospective buyer/s and renter/s. This is under the advice of our attorney. As of January 1, 2019 this will be and has become our standard practice.

BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

Are you a good neighbor? We are fortunate to have so many good people in this park who are willing to lend a helping hand to their neighbors. Each week at Koffee Klatch an announcement is made about any residents who may currently be hospitalized or are in a rehab facility or are now home from one or the other. This is done so that their friends or neighbors may offer their assistance to the resident as they are recovering. But that leaves us to wonder if their needs are being met or if there are other residents in the park currently in the same situation.

We realize that there are many federal, state and local government agencies already in place for the purpose of assisting our neighbors in need. One such Agency is the Senior Helpline (Phone number – 727-217-8111) which provides information on aging services including caregiver support, case management, daycare, home - delivered meals, in - home help, insurance counseling, legal help and alternative living arrangements.

According to a recent AARP study, 28 percent of people age 75 and older in Florida live alone. The AARP Florida state director, Jeff Johnson, says that Floridians are particularly at risk of isolation because many moved here from elsewhere and may not have family or other companions nearby.

We have a group of individuals in our park who are concerned that we may have some neighbors who may be in need of a helping hand but do not know who to ask or where to get information on resources that may be available to them. This group is presently an informal network who would like to act as a “good neighbor resource” for our neighbors in need. We do not wish to “reinvent the wheel”. However, we would appreciate hearing from anyone with ideas as to how we can best assist in meeting the needs of a neighbor that are not currently being met by the agencies already out there. There is a great deal of experience, knowledge and talent in this park and we would appreciate hearing from you.
