- 1. CALL BEFORE YOU DIG! Please remember that the office must be notified if you plan to do any work on the outside of your coach particularly plantings, fences, patios, etc. Underground cables for phone and electricity and fragile water lines need to be protected. A construction request must be filled out and approved before any work can begin.
- 2. The park water valve project is an on-going discovery process. We will try to notify all residents when the water needs to be off a phone tree is being prepared (as of this writing) and should be in place in early July. We appreciate your patience and cooperation
- 3. Sidewalk repair and seal coating of the streets is in the process of scheduling.

from an ATM as most stores won't take a credit/debit card?

FOOD? What do you have in your evacuation kits. Put high protein non-perishable food items like tuna, chicken, beans, peanut butter, spam, maybe some dry cereal cups, crackers. How about non-refrigerated milk. Can opener? Plastic utensils? Paper plates, paper napkins...

BEDDING? If you have to leave do you need to bring bedding supplies with you? Your favorite blankets or pillow? What about bath towels?

CLOTHING? What will you need for a couple of days? What about a week? Warm clothes in case of a chill? Rain gear? Footwear? Anything special?

MEDICATIONS? Do you have your medications together? Do you have enough for a couple of weeks in case pharmacies are closed or shipments can't get in? If the medications are in refrigerator do you have a note in your evacuation kit to remind you to grasp. Do you need needles? Alcohol swabs? Do you have a first aide kit at the ready?

DO YOU HAVE A NOAA weather alert radio/device? Make sure you have it on and if it needs batteries put in new ones now in case of electrical outages. Are you listening to the weather to keep track of what the updates are? DONT PANIC, BUT BE PREPARED!

IMPORTANT PAPERS – take them with you. If you have a fireproof box, take that! Let your family and friends know where you will be staying for the duration. Let the office at Four Seasons know where you are going and when you are leaving. Make sure the office has an emergency telephone number for you. Let the office know when you return.

I found most of this information in the Verizon telephone book so if you want more information, please check it out.

**Another thought:** Look around your mobile home before a storm is approaching and determine what your plan will be for patio furniture, plants in pots, hanging baskets and other outdoor items. Heavy winds can create damaging missiles out of just about anything in your yard. Protect yourself and your neighbor. Be prepared – don't be sorry!

We will pick up trash and recyclables EVERY MONDAY AND THURSDAY. Please rinse any jars, bottles, and cans. THANK YOU FOR HELPING OUR ENVIRONMENT.

Trash may be deposited 24/7 in the garbage dumpster behind the gate in the maintenance area. Do not leave anything outside the gate. Our trash pickup days are Monday and Thursday – unless a holiday falls on the usual pickup day. This will be noted in the monthly calendar. Please put your trash in a can with a lid to deter animals from getting into it and spreading food, etc. all over the streets.



#### **Ancient bones offer clues to evolution**

cientists may have discovered a new human ancestor to go along with "Lucy," the 3.2 million-year-old Australopithecus afarensis female from eastern Africa. Dubbed "Little Foot" because of his small bones, this specimen was unearthed in South Africa in the early 1990s. His skeleton was almost completely preserved after falling down a narrow cave shaft and dying there. Whether Little Foot was a relative of Lucy's or a different pre-human species has been a subject of debate among anthropologists, but a new dating process suggests that Little Foot lived and died some 3.67 million years ago, close to the same time as Lucy.

Although some scientists dispute the accuracy of the dating technique, if it holds up it suggests an evolutionary link between different species of Australopithecus in ancient Africa, as well as evidence of where in Africa modern humans began to develop.

#### Birds do it, bees do it, and so do amorous mice

rom time immemorial, men have wooed their lady loves with romantic (if sometimes off-key) music. Now scientists from Duke University believe that love songs aren't just for humans. Mice also sing to females they hope to attract, although they aren't likely using Barry White.



Instead, mice rely on high-pitched sounds outside the range of human hearing, using specific tunes when they smell a potential mate and different ones when they finally set eyes on her. The songs are louder and composed of more complex sounds when they smell a female scent, and get simpler—but longer—when they finally meet face to face. The complex songs seem to attract females, although what specifically draws them close is still uncertain.
