The office has the right to hire out this work to be completed & then charge the owner, as necessary. Please advise the office if any damage is done by the lawn crew as soon as possible. We can then address immediately and have an immediate response system in place.

Golden Corral completed their retention pond area. Possible consideration regarding a PVC fence along that area is being discussed.

Pinellas County continuing their spraying of the canal on an intermittent basis. We are in a drought & Lake Seminole is down by one and a half feet. City of Largo commenced their one time cleanup along the canal & drainage ditch area. Next tall palm trimming shall be toward the end of summer. Trees less than 10 feet are handled by Joe. Joe will also be finishing up cleaning of our PVC fencing.

I continue to receive many appreciative & kind comments on the trash & recycling performances. Thanks much to Joe, James, & Johnny.

We are working toward some resolution on the water distribution & valve scenario in the park. Engineer Richard Claybrooke is in process to formulate next plans from the utility survey & will report back to the BOD. Blue flags marking water lines are still to be left up for now until further notice from the engineer.

The perimeter PVC fence cleaning will shortly be underway. Clay & Joe completed new PVC fencing installation at the maintenance yard & parking lot, also placing new irrigation for plantings in the bed area.

Remember to hire only licensed & insured contractors for their necessary work. Always check with the City of Largo whether a permit might be required for remodeling. Please come to the office for any construction requests & approval form.

our Atomic Bomb - Much of this is from a pastor friend, Dr. Paul Chappell. Ecclesiastes 9:10 "Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest."

I like the whole poem by C. T. Studd, but especially this last stanza, "Only one life twill soon be past; only what's done for Christ will last."

Robert Oppenheimer was born in New York City in 1904, and he was the main man responsible for the development of the atomic bomb the United States used against Japan that greatly shortened the war, and which ultimately saved the lives of numerous Americans and Japanese alike.

After the first bomb test, and upon seeing the fireball and mushroom cloud, he quoted from the Bagavad-gita, "I am become death." Shortly thereafter he resigned his position at Los Alamos and spent much of the remainder of his life trying to undo the damage, trying to get the genie back in the bottle... his whole life Oppenheimer had been working toward advancing science and when he finally succeeded, he regretted it. He had spent his life developing something that would take the lives of others.

Imagine you are ten years down the road. The date is May 2027, and you are looking back on your life. What was your driving force for those ten years? What did you live for? Will vou have regrets?

So often we can get caught up in the hustle and bustle of good activities that we lose focus on what really matters in life. While work, hobbies, and leisure time is important, spending your life focusing on those activities is a wasted life. Only when you pour your life into serving Christ and living for Him will you be able to look back at your life with no regrets.

It's not wrong to have hobbies and spend leisure time with family, but when it comes between you and serving God, your focus needs to be reexamined. So what is your driving

force today? What is the focus and goal in your life: your work, kids, hobby, house or leisure? Robert Oppenheimer looked back with regret at what he poured his life into. Don't live with regrets as to how you spent your life.

HURRICANE SEASON IS HERE: JUNE 1 – NOVEMBER 30

Florida resident or new to the area, now is the time to take an inventory of your home, prepare your evacuation kit, decide where you will go if we need to evacuate. Because we live in a mobile home community, we will be required to evacuate in case of a hurricane. Make sure you have your medications at the ready with a supply of them in case you are gone for an extended length of time. There are many things to consider – we will publish information each month to help you prepare in case of an emergency evacuation.

First thing...where would you go? Friends or family? Hotel? If you need help by police/ fire there are forms that must be filled out and returned into them before a disaster strikes. Which hotel would you go too? How long will it take you to get ready to leave? Remember you have to also prepare the outside of your home...bring in "flying" objects like outside chairs, tables, plants, decorations, BBQ grills, etc. - how long will this take? Put your awnings down!



Will you need help? Is there gas in your car as the gas pumps won't work if no power? Do you have cash available in case there is no power and you can't withdraw from an ATM as most stores won't take a credit/debit card?

FOOD: What do you have in your evacuation kits? Put high protein non-perishable food items like tuna, chicken, beans, peanut butter, spam, maybe some dry cereal cups, crackers. How about non-refrigerated milk. Can opener? Plastic utensils? Paper plates, napkins, utensils.

BEDDING: If you have to leave do you need to bring bedding supplies with you? Your favorite blanket or pillow? What about bath towels and toiletries?

CLOTHING: What will you need for a couple of days? What about a week? Warm clothes in case of a chill? Rain gear? Footwear? Anything special?

MEDICATIONS: Do you have your medications together? Do you have enough for a couple of weeks in case pharmacies are closed or shipments can't get in? If the medications need refrigeration do you have a note in your evacuation kit to remind you? Do you need needles? Alcohol swabs? Do you have a first aid kit for emergencies?

Most important – if you are in need of assistance, Largo Fire Department will send someone to help you in the event of an evacuation. Desiree has a special form which must be filled out NOW – in advance – and will only be put in effect as needed.

Do you have a NOAA weather alert radio/device? Make sure you have it on and replace the batteries in case of an electrical outage. Are you listening to the weather to keep track of the updates? DONT PANIC BUT BE PREPARED!

IMPORTANT PAPERS - take them with you. If you have fireproof box take that! Let your family and friends know where you will be staying for the duration. Let the Four Seasons office know where you are going and when you are leaving. And let Desiree know when you have returned to the park.

If you need help, don't hesitate to ask a Board member or a neighbor.







GO GREEN AND KEEP THE BUGS AWAY

ooking to get rid of those pesky bugs that come with Florida heat and humidity? If you are like me, you hate to use any kind of poison in your home. So what to do?

Homemade recipe for roaches and palmetto bugs.

1/2 cup Borax laundry detergent

1 or 2 potatoes - boiled and mashed, and cooled

Mix together equal amounts of the Borax and mashed potatoes and form into linch round balls. Water can be added if it is too dry to form balls. Place on a cookie sheet to dry overnight. Next day place balls in back of cabinets, behind stove and refrigerator, etc. Can even be used in the car. The roaches will eat and carry back to their nests and die. Within two weeks, you are pest free. These balls last 6 months or longer.

For ants you can put a small amount of honey mixed with Borax in bottle caps and leave on the ant trail. Same result. Also honey and peppermint essential oil - 6 drops (I use Young Living brand) works well for ants. Have a great bug free summer. From Linda Truitt

MAY YOU NEVER HAVE TO TEST THIS – BURNS

young man sprinkling his lawn and bushes with pesticides wanted to check the contents of the barrel to see how much pesticide remained in it. He raised the cover and lit his lighter; the vapors inflamed and engulfed him. He jumped from his truck, screaming. His neighbor came out of her house with a dozen eggs, yelling: "bring me some eggs!" She broke them, separating the whites from the yolks. The neighbor woman helped her to apply the whites on the young man's face. When the ambulance arrived and when the EMTs saw the young man, they asked who had done this. Everyone pointed to the lady in charge. They congratulated her and said: "You have saved his face." By the end of the summer, the young man brought the lady a bouquet of roses to thank her. His face was like a baby's skin.

Healing Miracle for burns: Keep in mind this treatment of burns which is included in teaching beginner fireman this method. First aid consists to spraying cold water on the affected area until the heat is reduced and stops burning the layers of skin. Then, spread egg whites on the affected area.

One woman burned a large part of her hand with boiling water. In spite of the pain, she ran cold faucet water on her hand, separated 2 egg white from the yolks, beat them slightly and dipped her hand in the solution. The whites then dried and formed a protective layer.

She later learned that the egg white is a natural collagen and continued during at least one hour to apply layer upon layer of beaten egg white. By afternoon she no longer felt any pain and the next day there was hardly a trace of the burn. 10 days later, no trace was left at all and her skin had regained its normal color. The burned area was totally regenerated thanks to the collagen in the egg whites, a placenta full of vitamins.
