

PARK MANAGER'S REPORT

The summer mowing schedule is in effect - every Tuesday of the month.

We are delighted with the completion of the pool and shuffleboard court renovations.

They are certainly a great enhancement to our park. Thanks to the SAC and ROC Boards for their support of these projects.

Management continues to be in contact with both City of Largo & Pinellas County regarding algae growth observed in the canal between Grosse Pointe & Four Seasons Estates and the channel between Pointe West and FSE. I have repeatedly requested some sort of communication of any scheduling so I can relay to concerned residents in intelligent fashion. Dead growth along the bank at the channel will be removed as soon as possible on Four Seasons Estates side where the City of Largo had sprayed. The invasive water lettuce by Ulmerton Road was sprayed & successfully remedied by our Pinellas County representative. We will do our best to keep on top of this situation.

Clubhouse exit signs have been updated & repaired. There was a suggestion at the March ROC board meeting regarding the possibility of a speed hump that I researched & found that we can do the work ourselves without permitting if that decision comes to fruition. Speed bumps might also be considered. The sign at the 2nd entrance has also been redone.

Desiree & I presented a communicational tool to the Executive Board called Volo Village which was approved by the ROC Board at the April Board Meeting. This is a system of communication through automatic calling, texting, or email regarding emergencies & such to each coach, each resident.

Diane Guckin will be working part time as administrative assistant in the office.

Ryan Pelky, managing partner of Tampa Bay Plumber, is on sick leave at present & will get back to us shortly on his presentation of additional valves, possible water line replacement remedies. Asphalt Maintenance was in the park in mid-April to blacken out the white striping that was bleeding through at various places in the park. Fill dirt, top soil & Floratam sod was placed by the dock to secure lower lying areas.

I had Largo Piping & Gas out to replace a pipe fitting to rear of stove in the kitchen; also perform overall inspection. The City of Largo has also passed the clubhouse, kitchen area & maintenance yard, plus storage area for tools & flammables. The inspector was impressed by our new flammable liquid sizable container Clay installed.

A beautiful new Coach at # 484 was delivered & the concrete drive at # 480 will be broken down with concrete placed at the bank for erosion purposes.

Mathew Gridzlo, Pinellas County canal rep, will also be spraying near the bank along our canal for weed growth; he just sprayed the algae in the canal last week. Alexander's will be out soon for stump grinding. Ongoing discussion on additional palm tree trimming was commenced due to the warm weather we are experiencing.



The pool paver project was completed with the sealing of the pavers on April 13th. Many residents have commented on its beauty & added vista. Special thanks to Clay & Joe for all their extra help & push to perform various duties on this project as called upon. The shuffleboard court project is also finished & looks wonderful. Benches will be painted to match the color scheme. I suggested some new signage, coat of paint to rear of the courts to further brighten up that area. This is an inexpensive cure that will add beauty & quality to the shuffleboard area.

We are grateful that many of our winter residents, who have left for northern homes, notified the office upon their leaving. It is also important for our summer residents to let Desiree know when you leave the Park even for a week. For the safety of all residents it is imperative that we know which units are occupied or unoccupied.

If you notice a street light out in your area, jot down the number on the pole and give Desiree a call. She will notify Duke Energy for repair.

We also continue to appreciate your cooperation on our trash/recycling pick-up days. Trash in a covered trash receptacle will keep the streets clean and the animals and birds under control. An instructional flyer will be left at your coach's door when a proper trash receptacle is not implemented.

For those owners who wish to have Alexander's (or any individual/other company) care for your planter and/or flower beds while you are away, I am requesting that you deal directly with Alexander's and contract with them. The FSE office will not be responsible for any contractual agreements between a home owner and Alexander's (or any individual/other company). You must deal directly with the company (or the individual) – phone 727-535-7314 or info@alexanderspm.com. Ryan Hudson is our representative and is usually in the Park on Tuesdays.

be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. 18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence."

We read of an ungrateful king in the Old Testament, 2 Chronicles 32:24–25, "In those days Hezekiah was sick to the death, and prayed unto the LORD: and he spake unto him, and he gave him a sign. But Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit done unto him; for his heart was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem."

When the prophet Isaiah came and told Hezekiah that he would not recover from his sickness, the king did what we all should do in time of trouble - he prayed. God heard the prayer of his heart and miraculously healed him.
