

A VOLO reminder; the system cannot distinguish between calls or texts. We cannot set it for one or the other. If you have a phone number listed in our system, you will get a call and a text (if you have a cell phone listed). You will also get an email if you have an email in our system. Now that our major projects are done, I will not be sending out too many VOLO's. There seems to be a misconception about the VOLO system. The VOLO system, is not "just for emergency use" as some may have thought. It is a messaging system that allows mass communication throughout our Community. It can be used for various reasons and situations. While I will not be sending out VOLOs on a whim, it can be helpful for announcements, cancellations of scheduled events, alternative dates of scheduled events, as well as emergency situations. A MESSAGE FROM OUR PARK CHAPLAIN, CHUCK TRUITT

We're Never Too Old For God's Word

e have a great example from God's Holy Word here, 2 Timothy 4:9–13. "Do thy diligence to come shortly unto me: For Demas hath forsaken me, having loved this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia. Only Luke is with me. Take Mark, and bring him with thee: for he is profitable to me for the ministry. And Tychicus have I sent to Ephesus. The cloke that I left at Troas with Carpus, when thou comest, bring with thee, and the books, but especially the parchments."

In 1933, just after Franklin Roosevelt was inaugurated president, he paid a visit to former Supreme Court Justice Oliver Wendell Holmes, Jr. who was celebrating his ninety-second birthday. During their conversation Holmes mentioned that he was reading through Plato again to which FDR famously responded, "*Why are you reading Plato?*" with the undertone of "at your age" but Roosevelt was too polite to say it directly. Holmes replied that he was reading Plato because it improved his mind.

Going back almost 2000 years, and in the final years of the Apostle Paul, he was in a Mamertine Prison cell in Rome awaiting execution. Paul wrote to Timothy and asked him to bring the books and particularly the parchments which he had left behind on his journeys. Even in captivity and facing death, Paul wanted to keep studying and learning the Word of God and hiding it in his heart.

No matter how many years we have been saved or how much we have learned about the Bible or how much we have grown spiritually, we must have a continuing input of truth from God. Although faithful church attendance is important, it is not enough. Each Christian should be striving to learn, grow, and become more like Jesus. Latest Social Security Scam

The Social Security Administration (SSA) scam is currently the number one scam reported to the Federal Trade Commission. Recently there has been a new twist on the scam in the form of an SSA imposter robocall, which instructs individuals to press 1 to talk with an SSA officer or their SSA benefits will be cut off.

If you get a call like this, do not press 1. Instead, just hang up and remember:

- Your Social Security number is not about to be suspended.
- The real SSA will never call to threaten your benefits.
- The real SSA will never tell you to wire money, send cash, or put money on a gift card.

uestion: Is it legal to feed birds and other wildlife?

Answer: Feeding wildlife is generally discouraged and, in some cases, illegal. In Florida, it is illegal to feed manatees, Sandhill cranes, bears, raccoons, foxes, and alligators. Intentionally placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts black bears, foxes, raccoons, or Sandhill cranes and thereby creates a public nuisance is prohibited.

Additionally, intentionally feeding species listed as threatened, endangered, or of special concern - including Florida scrub-jays - is prohibited unless authorized by FWC permit. Feeding listed species is prohibited because it can negatively alter feeding behavior in some species and can cause them to become accustomed to people.

Feeding wildlife often has a detrimental rather than a helpful effect. Feeding animals may cause some species to concentrate so much on this supplemental feeding that they become a nuisance or a threat to people (e.g., bears, Sandhill cranes). <u>When fed, alligators can overcome their</u> <u>natural wariness and learn to associate people with food. When this</u> <u>happens, some of these alligators have to be removed and killed.</u>

Please neighbors, DO NOT FEED THE ALLIGATORS. You are putting yourself at risk and not doing the alligators any favors!

HURRICANE PREPARATION INFORMATION

^rust one more month to go – the 2019 Hurricane season comes to end on November 30th. Let's stay alert and be prepared just in case!

- Listen for weather updates radio (WEOC AM940) and TV.
- Build your survival kit.
- Get cash and fuel your car.
- Protect the windows, and secure your awnings and outdoor objects.
- Purchase bottled water, freeze containers of water, have coolers handy.
- Refill prescriptions.
- Make an itemized list of personal property and take photos.

Hurricane Warning means that a hurricane is expected within 24 hours. If there is a MANDATORY EVACUATION, all residents must leave when notified. Announcements will be made over the radio and TV. Decide in advance where you would go (a friend, relative, or hotel). Leave early. If you need assistance in evacuation, you should register in advance with the Largo Fire Department. THERE ARE FORMS IN THE CLUBHOUSE ON THE CREDENZA. Also a list of hotels in non-evacuation zones.

If you must evacuate:

• Take your survival kit, important papers including identification with local address, jewelry and any other items of value.

- Let friends or relatives know where you will be going.
- Turn off electricity, gas and water.
- Check your neighbors and make sure they have a ride.
- Lock all windows and doors when leaving.
- Drive carefully to nearest assigned shelter.

Once evacuation is lifted, and you can return home, beware of fallen branches, flooding and hanging electrical wires. Before entering your home:

- Check for damage from the outside.
- Turn water, gas and electricity back on.

• If area has been without power for extended period, the perishables in your refrigerator may have to be discarded.


