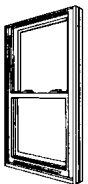

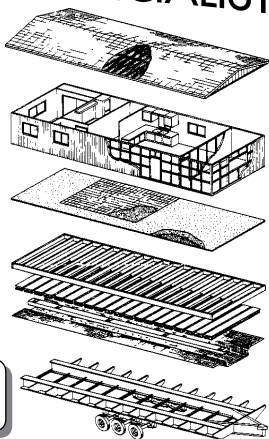

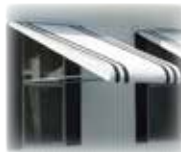

**GATHER PERSONAL SUPPLIES:** • Water – at least 1 gal. per person for three to seven days • Non-perishable packaged or canned food/juices • Snack foods • Non-electric can opener • Paper plates/plastics utensils • Garbage bags • First-aid kit • Flashlight(s)/batteries • Rain gear • Medicines/prescriptions • Cash – ATM and/or banks may not be open for a few days/weeks • Gas – fill your car with fuel in case of an evacuation • A fully-charged emergency cell phone • Keys to unit • Waterproof container of important documents (medical, insurance, financial, social security, etc.) • Reading material, games, etc.

**WHEN YOU EVACUATE:** • Contact family/friends as to the situation • Let the FSE office know where you will be staying. Leave in daylight if possible • Secure/lock mobile; remove everything from carport or deck • Place towels on all window and door sills in case of water • Do not tape windows, this will not strengthen them • Turn off all water faucets • Disconnect all electrical items at the switches in the breaker panel box (except refrigerator) • Remove antenna(s) or satellite dish, be careful not to touch electrical wire • Have a primary and second-



any evacuation route (traffic may be heavy) • Relocate ASAP prior to winds/rain becoming too dangerous • Bring any of the provisions listed that can be managed; add a pillow and blanket. We strongly recommend you evacuate in the event of a hurricane. If you choose to remain, please remember that you do so at your own risk.

**SHOULD YOU CHOOSE TO STAY:** • Clean, sterilize and fill available containers with water for emergency drinking purposes • Fill bathtub with water for bathing and to flush the commode • Move to an interior room or closet of your unit without windows • Be aware that as the hurricane approaches you should remain in your mobile. There will be no help available until after the storm passes.

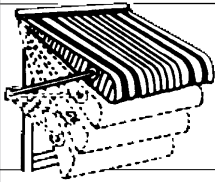

**W**e are each individuals, but no matter how individual we may feel, we depend on others. In fact, we all depend on God to eat and breathe, and to keep from coming all apart. The Bible tells us that everything is held together by Him. For those who endeavor to please the Lord, it is even more important to rely on God. Think about this.

Galatians 5:16–18 “This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.”

One of the temptations that come up again and again is for us to work in our own strength to try to do good things for God. We see this temptation in the attacks Satan made against Jesus. He tried to get the Lord to do something that was not in itself sinful, changing stones into bread, but was apart from God’s plan. Satan wanted Jesus to act independently from God, and He refused. This kind of temptation works so often because it is so appealing to our pride. We like to view ourselves as being gifted, strong, and able to handle whatever comes. Yet if we attempt to do so, we quickly find ourselves overcome with the weight of a burden we are not meant to carry.

The Lord spoke to His people through the prophet Zechariah after they returned to the land of Israel from their years of captivity in Babylon. They were struggling to rebuild their lives and their nation, and finding the task beyond their ability. The Israelites were led by a man named Zerubbabel, and this is the message God sent him through Zechariah: “Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts” (Zechariah 4:6). No matter how strong we are or think we are, we do not have the strength to do anything for God by ourselves. It can only come from His indwelling Holy Spirit in our lives.

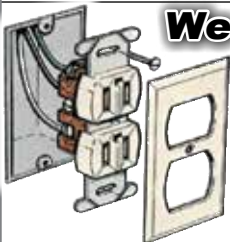

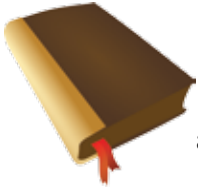

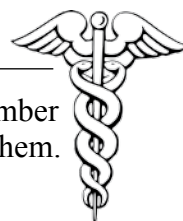

## Avoiding the dentist? It may cost you

**P**roper dental care is important to your overall health. Unfortunately, many of us tend to avoid visiting the dentist—often because of the cost.

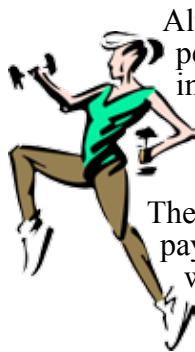
A survey commissioned by Aspen Dental found that almost two out of five Americans have delayed needed dental work, or had it only partially performed, because of their financial situation. It's a figure that has jumped by almost 8 percent over the last two years, even though 80 percent say they're aware that staying away from the dentist will be more expensive in the long run.



## Take one step to lose weight

**W**ant to lose weight? Step onto a scale every day. That may seem like obvious advice, but it's supported by the results of a study reported on the Live Science website.

In the study, researchers challenged 162 people to reduce their weight by 10 percent over the course of the year. They weren't given any specific advice, but about half the participants were given scales and told to check and record their weight every morning.



Although few of the participants in either group achieved their goal of losing 10 percent of their body weight, 29 percent of those given scales succeeded in losing at least 5 percent, but only 11 percent in the scale-free group lost as much.

In addition, participants given scales managed to maintain their weight loss for a second year.

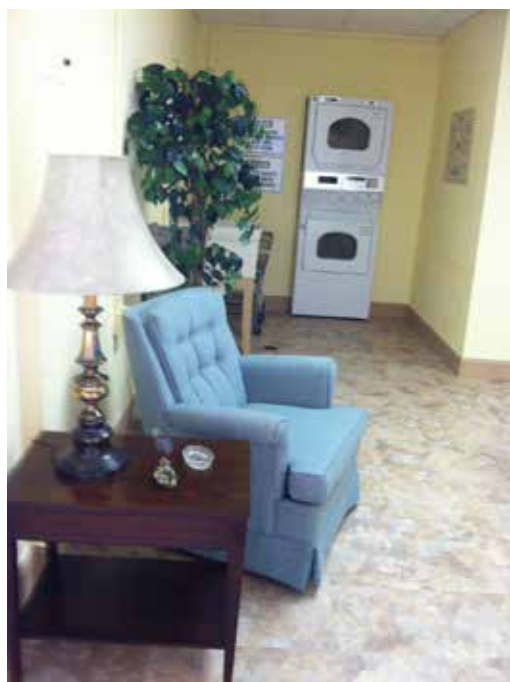
The researchers have theorized that checking weight once a day may help people pay more attention to what they eat (and how much), and reinforce positive weight-loss behaviors like skipping dessert.
