A MESSAGE FROM OUR PARK CHAPLAIN, CHUCK TRUITT

s a Christian who has trusted in the work and physical sacrifice of Jesus Christ to pay my sin debt, I love this Bible passage from the Word of God. Colossians 1:12 - "*Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: 13 - Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: 14 - In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins.*"

There are some folks who may wonder why we should give thanks to God; well God gives us several reasons right here in this passage. First, right there in verse 12 we should give thanks because He has made it possible for us to inherit or have a part with those who are in Heaven. Additionally, in verse 13 we can see that Satan and his domain have no power over us and we are already a part of Christ's Kingdom, which extends down to us who have trusted in Him. And, we see in verse 14 that we have been redeemed (bought and paid for) with the shed Blood of Christ. We have had all of our sins paid for - past, present, and future - simply by trusting in what Jesus Christ has done alone.

Wow, what a passage. It is elsewhere too, but succinctly so right here in Colossians chapter one.



PROTECT YOURSELF FROM FRAUD

B y 2020, Florida is expected to have a population exceeding 23.5 million with over 28 percent of that population being over the age of 60. Seniors comprise the state's second largest economic sector contributing a \$2.8 billion net tax benefit after all services are rendered. Florida's seniors donate \$3.5 billion to charities in addition to donating their time and talents in their communities.

Unfortunately, senior citizens are also a prime target for con artists perpetrating any number of scams. Seniors are generally hesitant to report when they have been a victim of fraud, and many times the cases are difficult to prosecute. However, informed seniors-like any other consumer-can protect themselves from scammers, and that is where the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) comes in.

FDACS is the state's clearinghouse for consumer complaints, protection, and information. The department provides a variety of resources to protect Florida consumers and ensures they have the information they need to make informed decisions. In that spirit, here is a brief recap of some of the top scams targeting seniors.

- The IRS Phone Scam Scammers claim that an individual owes back taxes and penalties, and say that unless the person pays immediately, they could be arrested or have their home foreclosed on.
- Sweepstakes Scam Fraudsters call or email victims and tell them they've won the lottery and just need to pay a fee to collect their winnings.
- Social Security Scam Scammers either phone or email consumers, claiming to represent the Social Security Administration and ask consumers for personal information, such as their Social Security number, date of birth or bank account information.
- Tech Support Scam Fraudsters pretend they work for a well-known tech company like Microsoft or Dell. They claim the consumer's computer has been infected with a virus, and then try to get remote access to the computer, as well as access to the victim's credit card or bank account information so that they can bill them for fixing the alleged problem.
- **Grandparent Scam** Fraudsters pretend to be the victim's grandchild and claim they need money to get themselves out of an emergency, such as being arrested. Or they may claim to have kidnapped the senior's grandchild and ask for ransom.
- Medicare Scam Scammers pose as Medicare representatives to get seniors to give them their personal information or pay for unnecessary services.
- **Romance Scam** Fraudsters contact seniors through an online dating site or other kinds of social media. Once they've struck up a relationship, they ask for money, perhaps to pay for a trip to visit the senior or to cover some kind of emergency, like medical costs.

Seniors are encouraged to get educated on what frauds are out there and to remain vigilant at all times. Here are some tips on how to protect yourself and avoid being scammed.

- Know who you're dealing with. Independently verify any information you are provided.
- Pay the safest way. You can dispute credit card charges if you never get the goods or services.
- Guard your personal information.
- Stay safe online. Don't send sensitive information unless you are sure the website is secure.
- Be cautious about unsolicited emails.
- Resist pressure. Legitimate companies and charities will be happy to give you time to talk with trusted advisors and make an informed decision.
- Don't believe promises of easy money.
- Fully understand the offer.
- Check your bank accounts and credit reports regularly.

Scams involving your Social Security number and benefits are on the rise!

Here are the facts:

- Government employees will not threaten to take away benefits or ask for money or personal information to protect your Social Security card.
- Scammers can fake your caller ID. So don't be fooled if the call seems to be from the SSA's real phone number (800) 772-1213 or the SSA Inspector General's Fraud Hotline number.
- If a caller asks for your Social Security number, bank account number or credit card information, hang up.

Report suspected scams to the SSA Inspector General at (800) 269-0271 or oig.ssa.gov/ report. Visit IdentityTheft.gov/SSA for more tips.

Question: Is it legal to feed birds and other wildlife?

A nswer: Feeding wildlife is generally discouraged and, in some cases, illegal. In Florida, it is illegal to feed manatees, Sandhill cranes, bears, raccoons, foxes, and alligators. Intentionally placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts black bears, foxes, raccoons, or Sandhill cranes and thereby creates a public nuisance is prohibited.

Additionally, intentionally feeding species listed as threatened, endangered, or of special concern - including Florida scrub-jays - is prohibited unless authorized by FWC permit. Feeding listed species is prohibited because it can negatively alter feeding behavior in some species and can cause them to become accustomed to people.



Feeding wildlife often has a detrimental rather than a helpful effect. Feeding animals may cause some species to concentrate so much on this supplemental feeding that they become a nuisance or a threat to people (e.g., bears, Sandhill cranes). <u>When fed, alligators can</u> <u>overcome their natural wariness and learn to associate people with food. When this happens, some of these alligators have to be removed and killed.</u>

Please neighbors, DO NOT FEED THE ALLIGATORS. You are putting yourself at risk and not doing the alligators any favors!



HURRICANE PREPARATION INFORMATION

fust two months to go and our 2019 Hurricane season will come to the end. How blessed we were in September not to be affected by Dorian. But let's stay alert and be prepared just in case!

- Listen for weather updates radio (WEOC AM940) and TV.
- Build your survival kit.
- Get cash and fuel your car.
- Protect the windows, and secure your awnings and outdoor objects.
- Purchase bottled water, freeze containers of water, have coolers handy.
- Refill prescriptions.
- Make an itemized list of personal property and take photos.

Hurricane Warning means that a hurricane is expected within 24 hours. If there is a MANDATORY EVACUATION, all residents must leave when notified. Announcements will be made over the radio and TV. Decide in advance where you would go (a friend, relative, or hotel). Leave early. If you need assistance in evacuation, you should register in advance with the Largo Fire Department. THERE ARE FORMS IN THE CLUBHOUSE ON THE CREDENZA. Also a list of hotels in non-evacuation zones.

If you must evacuate:

- Take your survival kit, important papers including identification with local address, jewelry and any other items of value.
- Let friends or relatives know where you will be going.
- Turn off electricity, gas and water.
- Check your neighbors and make sure they have a ride.
- · Lock all windows and doors when leaving.
- Drive carefully to nearest assigned shelter.

Once evacuation is lifted, and you can return home, beware of fallen branches, flooding and hanging electrical wires. Before entering your home:

- Check for damage from the outside.
- Turn water, gas and electricity back on.
- If area has been without power for extended period, the perishables in your refrigerator may have to be discarded.
