A MESSAGE FROM OUR PARK CHAPLAIN, CHUCK TRUITT

B E CONTENT: Hebrews 13:5: Be content with such things as ye have, for He hath said, "I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee." That promise from the Word of God has been a comfort to my wife and me for the many years that we served overseas in foreign lands, and even when things seemed grim and immitigable. It has at times been easy to think how nice it would be to just go home and be like everyone else.

In a book, "Acres of Diamonds," it tells of a farmer in Pennsylvania who wrote to his oilman-cousin in Canada, asking for a position in his business. "But you don't understand the oil business," replied the cousin. The farmer thought, "Well, I'll go to college and study and then I'll understand it." So he sold his farm for a mere \$833 and moved to Canada.

The new owner of the farm went out one day to search for a watering place for his cattle. He came across a stream running down a hillside. It was there that the previous owner had made a bulwark to channel the flow of water away from a "nasty scum" that oozed from the ground and made the water unsuitable for the cattle to drink.

That previous owner, the farmer who moved to Canada, had for 23 years, considered that "nasty scum" just a troublesome nuisance that devalued his farm. But it was really the flow from an underground reservoir of coal oil that the State Geologist of Pennsylvania valued at \$100,000,000. The oil town of Titusville today stands on the site of that farm. That farmer departed for another country to pursue a dream that could have been fulfilled beyond his wildest imagination right in his own back yard.

Question: Is it legal to feed birds and other wildlife?

Answer: Feeding wildlife is generally discouraged and, in some cases, illegal. In Florida, it is illegal to feed manatees, Sandhill cranes, bears, raccoons, foxes, and alligators. Intentionally placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts black bears, foxes, raccoons, or Sandhill cranes and thereby creates a public nuisance is prohibited.

Additionally, intentionally feeding species listed as threatened, endangered, or of special concern - including Florida scrub-jays - is prohibited unless authorized by FWC permit. Feeding listed species is prohibited because it can negatively alter feeding behavior in some



species and can cause them to become accustomed to people.

Feeding wildlife often has a detrimental rather than a helpful effect. Feeding animals may cause some species to concentrate so much on this supplemental feeding that they become a nuisance or a threat to people (e.g., bears, Sandhill cranes). When fed, alligators can overcome their natural wariness and learn to associate people with food. When this happens, some of these alligators have to be removed and killed.

Please neighbors, DO NOT FEED THE ALLIGATORS. You are putting yourself at risk and not doing the alligators any favors!

- Protect the windows, and secure your awnings and outdoor objects.
- Purchase bottled water, freeze containers of water, have coolers handy.
- Refill prescriptions.
- Make an itemized list of personal property and take photos.

Hurricane Warning means that a hurricane is expected within 24 hours. If there is a MANDATORY EVACUATION, <u>all</u> residents must leave when notified. Announcements will be made over the radio and TV. Decide in advance where you would go (a friend, relative, or hotel). Leave early. If you need assistance in evacuation, you should register in advance with the Largo Fire Department. THERE ARE FORMS IN THE CLUBHOUSE ON THE CREDENZA. Also a list of hotels in non-evacuation zones.

If you must evacuate:

- Take your survival kit, important papers including identification with local address, jewelry and any other items of value.
- Let friends or relatives know where you will be going.
- Turn off electricity, gas and water.
- Check your neighbors and make sure they have a ride.
- Lock all windows and doors when leaving.
- Drive carefully to nearest assigned shelter.

Once evacuation is lifted, and you can return home, beware of fallen branches, flooding and hanging electrical wires. Before entering your home:

- Check for damage from the outside.
- Turn water, gas and electricity back on.
- If area has been without power for extended period, the perishables in your refrigerator may have to be discarded.




