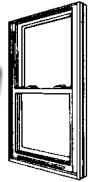

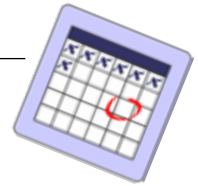

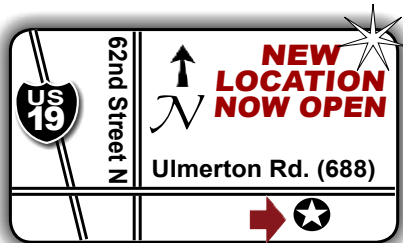

This was the final regular meeting of the GHOA Board of Directors for the winter season. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors will resume in October.

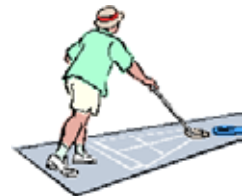
GATEWAY SHUFFLEBOARD

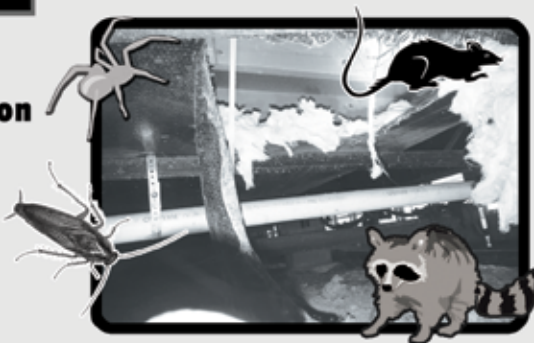

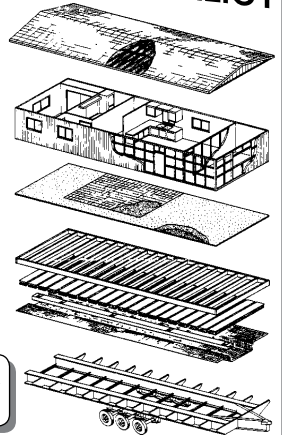

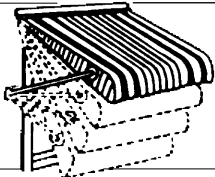
