



<u>NEW TRASH RATE</u>: The Trash collection service provider has changed to Waste Pro. Your new rate is \$9.06.

Your pick up days have changed to <u>Tuesday</u> and <u>Friday</u>.

The new company has provided a new trash container to all homes that MUST be used, as the truck will pick these up automatically and dump into their truck. All trash must be placed in these containers ONLY and placed at the curb on the scheduled dates of service. No loose trash or personal trash cans will be emptied or picked up. Please store your trash container at the back of your carport or in the shed.

Do NOT store them near or around the front of your home.

BULK trash pickup will be on the last Wednesday of every month.

December's BULK pickup will be on the last Thursday of December 12/28/2017, due to the holiday schedule. Place your bulk items to be removed at the curb next to your driveway. DO NOT place trash containers out on this day as they will NOT be picked up.

Items that will <u>NOT</u> be picked up are: Electronics (ex. TV's, computers, monitors, stereos), Paints, Chemicals, Tires, Batteries, Air Conditioners and Refrigerators. All yard waste must be cut to 4 foot sections or smaller and tied/bundled together.

ver the past weeks there has been discussion within the Park regarding the requirements for Board Training as set forth in Florida Statutes. According to the Federation of Manufactured Homeowners of Florida, Inc. the provision of the law applies to those Board members elected or appointed after July 1, 2016.

Florida Statutes Chapter 723 Mobile Home Park Lot Tenancies provides general rules for how Home Owners Associations shall function.

723.0781Board member training programs.—

(1)Within 90 days after being elected or appointed to the board, a newly elected or appointed director shall certify by an affidavit in writing to the secretary of the association that he or she has read the association's current articles of incorporation, bylaws, and the mobile home park's prospectus, rental agreement, rules, regulations, and written policies; that he or she will work to uphold such documents and policies to the best of his or her ability; and that he or she will faithfully discharge his or her fiduciary responsibility to the association's members.

(2)In lieu of this written certification, within 90 days after being elected or appointed to the board, the newly elected or appointed director may submit a certificate of having satisfactorily completed the educational curriculum approved by the division within 1 year before or 90 days after the date of election or appointment. The educational certificate is valid and does not have to be resubmitted as long as the director serves on the board without interruption.


A 50/50, which David Hickenbottom graciously donated back, was sufficient to finance the morning and assist in supporting Bike Parade and other activity expenses.



Book Recommendation:

Here Vultures Fly

by Rudy Rodrigues

This is the narration of the personal experiences of the author, Rudy Rodrigues, during his ten years of service with the United Nations in Afghanistan, where he was engaged in emergency relief and later rehabilitation programs in close collaboration with the Communist government, the mujahideen, the Taliban, and the post-Taliban government.

The author was responsible for opening the first UNICEF office in Kyrgyzstan soon after the collapse of the Soviet Union in a unique environment and culture. During this time, he was working with a government unfamiliar with the United Nations and its goals and objectives. In addition, the Kyrgyz population was traumatized by this sudden period of transition and uncertainty. A major focus of the author's work was gaining the



confidence of the government in Uzbekistan and to ensure the building of meaningful partnership programs for women and children.

This book also covers the adventures, romance, and thrill of being born and raised in Kenya; serving as an officer in the army; the challenges of working in Papua New Guinea; and having the glorious opportunity of working in the UN in different parts of the world with a multiethnic/multicultural community.

About the Author

Rudy Rodrigues was born and raised in Kenya. He graduated from the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and the British Army Staff College. He was commissioned and served as an officer in the Kenya Army in both command and staff appointments. Resigning after sixteen years of active service, he then immigrated to Canada with his wife and three children.

Later, Rodrigues was appointed country director of a Canadian NGO in the Sudan, with a mandate to provide leadership, strategic planning and the delivery of UN (WFP) emergency relief supplies to the more than three million starving people displaced by the famine of 1985. He did so using a fleet of 350 cargo vehicles and a staff of over 3,000 people. This trucking operation was later taken over by the UN, and Rodrigues served as its Director.

In 2006 Rodrigues ended his career, and moved from Afghanistan, where he was last working with the United Nations. He retired to Winter Park, Florida where he lives today, and enjoys traveling, writing and spending time with his family, children and grandchildren.



Control that holiday glow

andles are a popular holiday decoration, but they're also one of the most dangerous. It's important that you follow these precautions to prevent full-blown fires:

- Never leave a lighted candle unattended.
- Always put candles in a metal or ceramic holder. Never place them in combustible containers or ones that can melt.
- Put out candles once they get within two inches of their holders or decorations. This is especially important to follow with natural or plastic decorations that often grace holiday candle holders.
 - Keep wicks trimmed to a quarter-inch.
- Never burn candles near things that can catch fire—including Christmas trees and curtains.

Be safe on your bicycle

Bicyclist deaths have risen significantly in recent years, and adult men, not kids, are most often the victims, according to the Medline Plus website. In 2015, the most recent year figures are available, biking deaths rose 12 percent. Of the 818 fatalities in 2015, a hefty 85 percent were men, with an average age of 45.

A report by the Governors Highway Safety Association noted that bikers often believe they have the right of way and are unable stop in time to avoid a collision. Drivers also often don't see bikers until it's too late.

Intersections aren't the most dangerous area. Seventy-two percent of bicycle fatalities occur away from intersections. More than half take place between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Alcohol, whether consumed by the biker or the driver, is also a factor in 37 percent of collision deaths.

If we are creating ourselves all the time, then it is never too late to begin creating the bodies we want instead of the ones we mistakenly assume we are stuck with.
