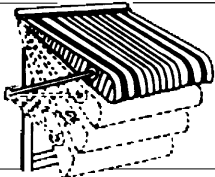

The 2014 Annual Meeting of the Membership and Election of Directors of the Gateway Homeowners Association (GHA) of Pinellas County, Inc. will be held on Monday, February 2, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. in the Clubhouse. Registration and payment of fees will start at 7:00 p.m.

Each paid-up household is entitled to one vote. Please remit your 2015 membership renewal fee of \$2 to the GHA Treasurer, Lana Kennedy, prior to the meeting. It is important to be a paid-up member and attend the meeting as a majority of the membership is required to constitute a quorum.

Two Directors' positions are open for election -- each for a 3-year term (January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2017). If you would like to be a candidate for a director's position, please submit your name to one of the following Nominating Committee Members: June Boudreau, David Hickenbottom, Emma Nebel, Bob Harris, or Ted Baker.

The election shall be by ballot (unless dispensed with by unanimous consent) and a simple majority (50%+1) of the votes cast shall be binding. Votes may be cast in person or by proxy. Proxy forms are available from June Boudreau and must be filed with the GHA Secretary before the meeting.

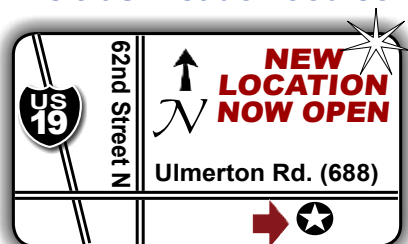

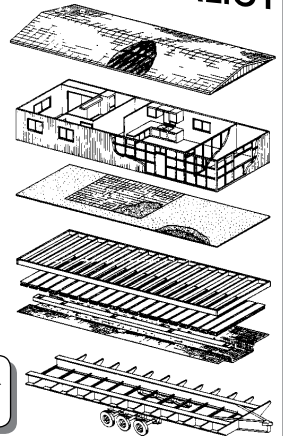

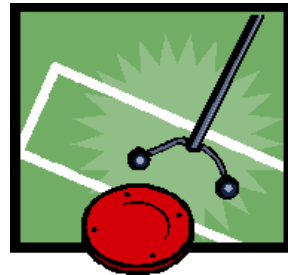
