LOCAL CORONA VIRUS AT A GLANCE

s of May 15th there were 17 reported cases in the Gateway Zip Code (33716). Though there are about 435 residents here at Gateway, a number (including myself) have departed for summer homes in the still wintry northern states.

As a 55+ park, Gateway is a 'vulnerable' community and from the beginning of the alarms as to the dangers presented by the virus I am pleased to say that virtually all of us have taken steps necessary to protect ourselves and friends and neighbors from transmission of any cold or flu, let alone Covid-19.

Our community social season came to a halt on March 13th when management was ordered to close our pool area and clubhouse. Throughout the past month our local communities and the State of Florida has begun the process of re-opening businesses and relaxing restrictions. It should go without saying that should you feel ill or are in close contact with someone who is ill with a cold or other flu like symptoms, that you should be reasonable and responsible when it comes to your travels out and about among the now more active public.

LADIES OF GATEWAY RESPOND TO NEEDS

hen the sign appeared on the clubhouse doors and were locked by order of the Sheriff, our active retirement lives were changed in a big way. What to do with our time we used to spend at the hall? Here at Gateway there are some who heard of shortages of protective masks, found fabric patterns online and started sewing.

We are taking time to recognize four talented women who have turned their enjoyment of sewing into colorful face coverings designed to stop the spray of droplets we commonly send out when we speak.

Brenda McAninch and her husband Wally moved to Gateway 17 years ago. Brenda began making masks when she heard healthcare workers were running out. She has made and given several to friends and family also.

Another 1st Way resident, **Tracy Schofield**, who became part of our community in 2017 and while still working full-time has been filling her spare time sewing and giving masks to her fellow workers and sometimes others she happens to meet and appear in need of one.

Newcomer to the park, **Michele Johnson**, joined us in September of last year and immediately began attending hall functions and volunteered to work the Bazaar Craft Table where she had donated several crocheted and sewn items. Michele began making and giving masks to people before the Clubhouse and Pool were closed. Sharing photos on Facebook caused a deluge of requests from her home state of Ohio. She has made over 400.

Long time resident **Karen Feyen** of 1st Street, is well-known for her sewing skills and for the many Ladies Day and Sewing Central projects donated to the Bazaar Craft Table. Her goal at this time it to complete 500 masks for the homeless.

Sewing masks for friends may seem like a far cry from "saving the day" but it means a lot to our residents wanting to help stop the spread of the virus.



ay 5, 2020
The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners extended its COVID-19 Local State of Emergency to May 15 while making no changes to County guidance provided last week in light of Phase 1 of the governor's step-by-step plan for recovery.

The County allowed the conditional reopening of shared pools and childcare facility playgrounds last Thursday and opened public beaches with social distancing requirements on Monday. Additionally, Governor Ron DeSantis' Executive Order 2020-112 went into effect Monday and allows for the limited resumption of many nonessential businesses and limited

restaurant seating.

The Board adopted Resolution 20-40 after discussing ongoing efforts related to monitoring COVID-19 trending data, ramping up testing in all parts of the county, encouraging the wearing of masks in public places, protecting vulnerable populations at long-term care facilities and enforcing compliance in public places with capacity and social distancing requirements. The commissioners received detailed updates from County Administrator Barry A. Burton, Florida Department of Health Pinellas Director Dr. Ulyee Choe and Sheriff Bob Gualtieri.

FLORIDA TESTING RESULTS

s of mid May approximately 650,000 of the population of the State (21.5 million) have been tested for the virus over the past weeks. As testing has increased the percentage of positives for COVID has decreased. At the same time the rate and numbers of fatalities attributable to the disease has continued to decline. Part of the case decline is because there is no longer a requirement that a person have symptoms of the virus.

From the May 4 Tampa Bay Times:

... free testing began Monday at three Community Health Centers of Pinellas testing sites. Residents do not need to be a patient of the facility. People can walk up or drive up to be tested and do not need to be experiencing symptoms. Testing sites are open Monday through Friday 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The testing sites are located at:

- 707 East Druid Road, Clearwater
- 7550 43rd Street North, Pinellas Park
- 1344 22nd Street South, St. Petersburg

Patients are required to fill out a condensed electronic registration and must bring a valid I.D. Residents are encouraged to make an appointment by calling 727-824-8181.

The likely next phase will be the so-called 'antibody' testing that will be used to better identify and quantify the true extent to which the virus has spread among the populace.
