

Personal Safety Presentation

On April 8, the Board of Directors hosted a presentation by Deputy Sean O'Brien of the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. There were about 30 residents there and I think the approaching bad weather that evening kept some away. This was a very informative talk on personal safety. Here are a few of the points he spoke about. He started by talking about the Alert Pinellas which you can sign up for and receive emergency alerts for severe storms and hurricanes. Crime Viewer is another free program that show Police reports around your home area. There is a Safety Net program for people who may 'wander' due to dementia or Alzheimer's which provides a tracking device that enables authorities to locate missing individuals in as few as 20 to 30 minutes.

Deputy O'Brien also spoke of **FREE home checks** when you are out of town for vacation or when you are at another residence. This Sheriff's Department service is available by first calling 727-582-6177 and answering a series of questions regarding the residence the Sheriff Deputies will then check regularly and often. This is wonderful! The more the Police are seen around our park, the more it tells the bad guys to stay away!

No Solicitation Policy

The week of April 8, there were some people walking around the park claiming to be selling for a cable company. First, Gateway has a **No Solicitation Policy**. There is a sign saying so at the entry. If someone is going door-to-door trying to sell something, Deputy O'Brien said call the Sheriff to have them removed from the park, it is not the responsibility of park residents to confront people. He said to treat a salesperson the same way you **treat a phone solicitation or tele-marketing call - Don't answer your door!**

From speaking with people and the Deputy these individuals did not sound like sales people. The did not introduce themselves, provided no sales material and when someone asked them for a business card, they were told a very unprofessional colorful comment. You don't know, they may have been 'casing' our community. They could have been looking to see how many out of state vehicles are here that may be leaving soon or any number of other things. Trust your intuitions.

Deputy O'Brien said if solicitors are seen in the park or come to your door call the Sheriff's Department at (727) 582-6200 and be prepared to provide a detailed description of the individual(s) you are reporting. And, if a person refuses to leave or behaves in a threatening manner in any way you should call 911!

I approached the men and they told me that they were sent up from Sarasota to help cover routes. They did go back down the street and pick up additional trash cans that had been put out.

Fuel from plastic? It could be coming

Recycling to reduce waste and protect the environment isn't a new idea. However, a new process may be able to recycle up to 25 percent of our plastic waste into fuel, according to the Science Alert website. Chemists at Purdue University have been able to liquefy the polymers that make up about a quarter of plastic waste and turn it into diesel-like products that can be used as a blendstock for fuel.



The process, called hydrothermal liquefaction, involves heating water under heavy pressure to work as a solvent and catalyst for transforming the molecular makeup of polymers. With the addition of some hydrogen atoms, this converts the plastic into a fluid called naphtha.

Previous results were disappointing, but the Purdue team of chemical engineers recently converted more than 90 percent of the polypropylene used in an experiment into fuel-grade naphtha. Further analysis suggests that the process could be a more efficient and environmentally friendly way of dealing with plastic waste than burning it or recycling it.

Mysteries of the ancient stone monuments

tonehenge is probably the most well-known monument built by ancient humans, but it's not alone. As The New York Times reports, there are as many as 35,000 such structures in Europe, ranging from stone circles to dolmens (tablelike structures) and standing stones. Recent radiocarbon dating reveals that the earliest of these stone structures were built in France some 6,500 years ago and their construction spread to England, Ireland, and Scandinavia, as well as along the Atlantic and Mediterranean coasts over 200–300 years.

Many of the dolmens were used as tombs and could be reopened to permit additional burials. The earliest known dolmen was built in central western France between 4371 and 4262 B.C.

Sicily, Apulia and the Balearic Islands saw a wave of megaliths built between 1000 and 2000 B.C. Stonehenge was constructed sometime late in the megalithic heyday, in approximately 2500 B.C.
