

LOCAL CORONA VIRUS AT A GLANCE

s of April 18 there were between 5 and 9 confirmed cases reported in the Gateway Zip Code (33716). Our zip code is roughly rectangular bordered by Brighton Bay Blvd to the East; 28th St, which is just beyond I-275 to the west; Ulmerton Road to the north and Gandy Blvd on



the south. There are about 435 residents here at Gateway and when we take the time to consider our sister park at Pinewood and the myriad of apartments and condominiums to our east, west and north it would appear we have been quite safe and secure from the spread of the illness.

As a 55+ park, Gateway is a 'vulnerable' community and from the beginning of the alarms as to the dangers presented by the virus I have noticed that virtually all of us have taken steps necessary to protect ourselves and friends and neighbors from transmission of any cold or flu, let alone Covid-19.

Our community social season came to a halt on March 13th when management was ordered to close our pool area and clubhouse. If as you are reading this we are again able to enjoy the friendly social atmosphere and gatherings as in some seven weeks past (yep, it has been that long) then do take the opportunity to do so.

It should go without saying that should you feel ill or are in close contact with someone who is ill with a cold or other flu like symptoms, that you should be reasonable and responsible when it comes to your social contacts.

PINELLAS COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

ince the beginning of the COVID-19 emergency declaration Pinellas County Commissioners have met weekly in order to assess the ongoing impact of the disease upon the community. The commission usually meets Thursday mornings beginning at 9:30 AM at which time the current Safer-At-Home order, which must be voted upon to extend each week, is discussed. At the time this NewsNDos was sent for publication (April 18, 2020) the commission had voted to maintain the order in its current form.

The Thursday public meeting is available for live viewing on Spectrum 637, Frontier Channel 44 and WOW! Channel 18 and for live internet streaming at http://www.pinellascounty.org/TV.

At the April 16th meeting there appeared to be but a single commissioner, Kathleen Peters, who expressed interest in reopening Pinellas County HOA pools for use by residents. It should be noted that while the State of Florida Stay-At-Home order does not restrict the use of any swimming pool nor the use of our beaches it was the decision by our local authorities, County Administrator, County Sheriff and County Commissioners to restrict beach and pool use. These actions we are told was in response to an observed lack of social distancing. At the same time restrictions were placed upon Pinellas residents these same authorities found no issues with allowing 10 people to be on the deck of a boat anchored at beaches and sand bars throughout Pinellas County.

SCARLET & GREY ARE HERE

Park. December 27th at 7:00 a.m. they arrived via a non-stop ride via the 'FunVan' to take up their permanent residency here. Welcome. I am talking about the pair of white mute swans now gracing the entrance to Gateway once again.

Thanks go out to the grandsons of Jack and Carolyn Rex for the capture of, and son Roger and his friend Jerry Zimmerman for the transport of these swans to Gateway. There is a lot of story there to tell, no doubt. Think you would have had to live it. Scarlet and Grey have nestled in and seem apparently content in their new surroundings, preening and feeding from the bottom of the lake. Just the latest in a long list of retirees from Ohio.

Since early times, and in ancient countries, the swan has been a symbol of gracefulness and a favorite motif for literature, music, and art. In Greek mythology, Zeus, in the form of a swan courted Leda and fathered Apollo Swans have appeared in Operas by Wagner, ballets by Tchaikovsky, and Norse and Finnish mythology. They are revered throughout the Hindu world

Most cultural references concern the European 'mute' swan. Legend has it that these birds only begin to sing when nearing death, creating the phrase 'swan-song'. In England, unmarked swans in open water have belonged to the crown since 1482; prior to this time they were treated as game.

Despite their elegance and seeming ability to glide through water without apparent effort, they are quick to defend their young and can be dangerous when roused.

It is the fable of 'The Ugly Duckling' that has the greatest relevance. A plain grey bird is born in a farmyard and suffers bullying, and abuse in it childhood, growing to maturity much more slowly than its fellow ducks until, much to his delight and to the surprise of those around him, he develops into an elegant swan. It is a heart-warming tale of personal transformation for the better and has provided inspiration to millions since Hans Christian Anderson wrote it in 1843.

OOD NEWS EVERYONE!!!!!

THE RESIDENT PORTAL IS NOW FREE!!!!!!

We have finalized the new contract with PayLease and, effective April 1st, the following changes will be in effect for residents using the Resident Portal:

Any resident that pays their rent using ACH (i.e. a checking or savings account) will not be charged a fee. (We will be absorbing the fee at a rate of \$1 per transaction. These are charged as "Bank Charges" on your budgets.)

Any resident that pays their rent using a debit card will be charged a flat \$6.95 convenience fee, regardless of the amount of the transaction.

Any resident that pays their rent using a credit card will still be charged the \$2.95 convenience fee, plus 3.5% of the transaction amount.

We are working on the ePay Authorization forms for residents who, for some reason, are not able to access the Resident Portal. Through this program, we will be able to set it up in Rent Manager to have a resident's bank account automatically debited each month for their rent charges. We hope to have the authorization forms printed and distributed to all communities within the next week or so.




We look forward to this being a thing of the past and getting our Bingo up and running again in October.




