and or offensive language being used at the pool. Let me be the first to say this should not be tolerated at all. Think of it like this; please do not say anything to someone else that would upset you if someone else was to say this to your mother or grandmother. We need to show the utmost respect to our neighbors and fellow human beings. DRINKING AT THE POOL, although this is your home and your pool and we don't discourage our residents from drinking and having a good time, it says very plainly in the prospectus not to become sloppy drunk in public or common areas which we believe is where our biggest problems with loud and offensive language comes from. So we respectively ask that you govern yourselves accordingly and be very respectful of your neighbors.

Next, cleanliness is a must. Some residents home are still not up to community standards, Whether your yards not being mowed or clutter on carports or clutter on screened in porch can be seen from the street (Supposed to have shades of sorts); I will ask for your neighbors, our office, as well as your own comfort that everyone please take a look around your homes and yards to see if anything needs to be picked up, cleaned up or otherwise stored elsewhere. 


CREATIVE COLORING




