Rochester, N.Y. - Although there are more than 15,000 new coronavirus cases in Florida, snowbirds are still planning on traveling to the sunshine state when winter comes. Elaine Cole and her husband from Irondequoit have driven to Largo, Florida every January for the last 8 years. She expects to leave again this coming winter even if the number of coronavirus stays the same or continues to rise. She says the people in Largo are more responsible about their health.

Cole will make one change to her road trip; normally she'd stop and visit friends and family

along the way but next year, that won't happen.

"I think we would do it quickly with as few overnight stops as possible; but again, I'd rather spend COVID-19 in Florida where we can be outdoors and not up close with people, we can control our surroundings," said Cole.

Florida is on the list of the states with travel restrictions. Anyone traveling back from one of those states to New York must quarantine for two weeks.

- 1. **DEBRIS IN YARDS & CARPORTS**---While some of you think I am just picking on you or your neighbors that is not at all my intentions. Residents are still not cleaning up around their homes and its getting really old having to tell them over and over, House dirty, Yard is a mess with debris, awnings, building materials. When every resident in Gateway moved in they signed paperwork in the office saying they would keep their yards and carports clean and debris free.
