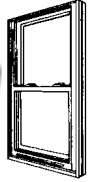

It wasn't until they both signed up for a community college course that their lives converged. In 1984 they married and started a life together enjoying their two sons, their lake house in the Ozarks for 17 years, and a great life style of a summer home indulging in outdoor water sports, fishing, boating, and relaxing.

Linda continued the community college and transferred to a four year college program of computer science. She retired from Boeing after 25 years as a software engineer.
