

olden Acres is a different place with everything shut down in the park. Half the winter residents have gone home and most that are left are staying till the worst is over in their home states. The pool has been closed for a couple of weeks and the clubhouse for a little over a week. Everyone has been staying in their own units and walking by themselves. The store shelves are empty of some needed items but are still operating at reduced hours.

The Hardin House passed with a vote of 183 yes and 9 nos. It is in the lawyer's hands to get the sale completed. By state law when a homeowner association buys more property we have to have a survey to add that property to our map. That is in progress as of this writing.

There are still questions of property lines on the Hardin House to the bank. We must have that solved before the sale can be completed. The meeting when the vote was final the board announced that when most residents are back in January that they can tour the house and make recommendations on what to do with the house. The weather is getting hot again here. The daily weather this week is 90-degree temperature and 80 percent humidity and no rain lately. Everything in the park is dry and needs water. Summer has started in Florida.

The board had street drains repaired and the project is still on going as of this writing. We have no other project going on as of this writing.

We had unit #20 up for sale and a few people have toured the unit and it needs a lot of work. We have received three bids so far and others are still interested in bidding. We have no units for sale currently.

The board recommends that everyone stay safe and hope to see you when you return in the fall.



t the time of this writing, we find ourselves in the midst of the coronavirus epidemic. It most certainly has caught the world off-guard as we experience the traumatic effects Lof this dangerous virus. We find ourselves in unchartered waters from a global health policy standpoint, and a crisis resulting from a virus and infectious disease that is, of now, not totally understood.

#### **Good Advice**

to Shelter in Place. Maybe this has allowed us to get a few projects done, clean out a closet, read more, get creative, or meet some new and different folks in the park. For many, it also means long periods of sitting. This can be sitting watching TV, working at a computer desk, sitting at the kitchen table playing cards and more.

As a Massage Therapist and Body worker, I know that sitting can wreak havoc on the physical body. It's even been said that "sitting is the new smoking". Sitting too long can cause a myriad of undesirable symptoms, including stiffness, loss of balance, sciatica, low back pain, hip issues, groin pain, neck problems, headaches and postural deterioration.



It's important to alternate your sitting with other activities at least once every hour by getting up, walking around, stretching, clenching your muscles, then releasing them, shrugging your shoulders then releasing them, flex and point your toes, or attending to whichever area feels stiff or sore as necessary. Our fascia, which is a protective netting just under our skin, gets stuck from non-movement. Did you ever peel the skin off a piece of raw chicken and see that filmy stuff right underneath? That's fascia. Humans have it too. It gets tight and stuck when we don't move around. It also clusters around injuries and scar tissue, which creates more stiffness and immobility, and even pain.

Pain is an indicator that something is out of balance. Pain wants attention; so, if you are experiencing pain, please attend to it. This could mean giving the area a rub or stretch, soaking feet/body in an Epsom salt bath, applying topical analgesics, and/or drinking more water. When it's hot outside, it's a good idea to drink a beverage with Electrolytes in it. Smart Water, Vitamin Water, Emergen-C packets, Propel and Gatorade are just a few of the electrolyte choices available. 



## When it comes to Coronavirus, protect your health and your wallet

#### **How It Works**

- Scammers may set up websites to sell bogus "coronavirus products". From face masks to vaccines to cure-alls and use fake emails, texts and social media posts to get you to share payment or sensitive personal information.
- You may come across emails or social posts claiming to promote awareness or give prevention tips, including fake information about cases in your neighborhood.
- Scammers may use this to tout a new can't-miss "investment opportunity". For example, in face masks or a cure.
- You may get donation requests claiming to raise money to help victims.

#### What You Should Know

- Know that there is currently no vaccine available for coronavirus.
- Any "investment opportunity" that claims to ride the wave of economic activity due to the virus is probably an opportunity to lose money to a scam.
- Your best resources for information on the virus are the ones you know and trust, but first verify that the resource is who you think it is.

#### What You Should Do

Don't click on email links from sources you don't know. They could download malware on your device.

Ignore any online offers for vaccinations or treatments. If a vaccine or treatment is developed, you will hear about it in the news, not from an online ad or sales pitch.

If you receive a communication claiming to be from a government agency like the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, close the email and then visit the agency's website directly at www.cdc.gov.

Engage your inner skeptic when confronted with donation requests. Before giving, check out charity watchdogs like give.org or charitynavigator.org.






