President's Report By Ray Lamoureux



e are still trying to recover from the effects of hurricane Irma. We have eight places with major damage to be repaired. I was told yesterday that most of the contractors are booking out two months or more for repairs to units. Most of the eight that have major damage can be occupied. Two that have major roof damage cannot be lived in. Most of the others have very minor damage usually the pan on the edges of the roof -overs.

The tree limbs and palm trees that fell down during the hurricane are removed from the park. The street of Dunedin is still littered with all kinds of material that the city is slowly picking up and taking to the land fill.

The board finished with the 2018 budget on Tuesday October 10th and it will be mailed out on Monday October 16th. With this budget the maintenance fee will stay at \$165.00 per month. The budget meeting for residents to vote on the budget will be Wednesday November 15th at 10:00 after coffee. Please mark the date on your calendar.

We are also having an audit on the park financials next year for year 2017. We were required by law to have audits done every three years. The law was changed that we could have audits with longer periods in between audits but the board will have audits done every three years and keep on that schedule.

It time to start thinking about elections to the board of directors. Two members of the board are up for the election. The process is to submit to the office the intent to run form by December. Also required is a resume to be sent out with the ballot in January.

The park is starting to fill up. Snowbirds are slowly returning to their winter homes. By the time you read this newsletter a good number of units will be full.

We still only have two units for sale as of this writing. The sales have been slow this summer but it should pick up now that fall is here.

Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

I called and spoke with Dunedin Department of Planning and Development at City Hall and specifically inquired about two rezoning requests that are near Golden Acres.

Applications ZO 17-59 (area along Main street) and ZO 17-60 (Old Knights of Columbus Hall).

ZO 17-59 - Main Street area is requesting rezoning to move to an "urban concept". This was described as retail business on ground floor and residence above. Road frontage will be landscaped.

ZO 17-60 - Old Knights of Columbus Hall. Rezone request is a land use request. Proposed business is a flooring retail sales and service business.

This information should answer any questions and or concerns that you may have had.


Larry told me that he would never even know that there was a storm outside as the shelter was so structurally sound.


