It's that time of the year and the budget will be presented to the board before it is mailed out to all owners. The budget meeting for all owners will happen in December.

The palm tree trimming was delayed due to road closures and I hope to get it started in the next week or two. They are hanging down to the sidewalks now.

The projects are not getting completed without a lot of help. Karin in the office gets the brunt of arranging all the necessary pieces to come together to get them done smoothly. All the board thanks you, Karin, for Your Hard work.





I has been one year since my life was changed with the passing of my darling Gail. Finding myself was a process. Partly crazy and partly intelligent but it was a process. I first decided I would get my physical body in condition to what I knew was very overweight by 25 pounds, so walking daily several miles and eating proper was a start. Doing so helped the grieving process immensely because as I walked the emotions could take their natural course and I could look for diversions through nature around me. I was always looking for something different to do and often with others. Thankfully I have very many friends across the Pinellas County and at GA which helped me during this year.

Gail has been by my side almost every day of my life since age 18 when I married her at age 17. So, her voice and guidance are always within me and yet I had to come to terms with the reality I am no longer WE and I must live on as (I.) Many reading this article fully have lived this and understand this. In the past I took my direction each day as to what would best serve Gail. Now finding what best served my new condition was a true journey. I have done well in rebuilding myself over this year. I am healthier physically and involved in some social programs.

I have teamed up with a friend of thirteen or more years Linda Althof whom is director and a founder of Special Needs program Gliding Stars which provides everything necessary to give ice skating experience to everyone regardless of physical or other conditions. This year we have 104 participants and 109 volunteer coaches and helpers to get everyone on the ice every Monday night until the stars receive a Gold Medal for succeeding in the "I Can Do It" Awards Program in March. Linda is also a career Special education teacher, she also co-directs a homeless feeding program every Sunday at her church where she is a Deacon and will be working in winter opening the church to shelter them from our freezing winters. I will be in and out of GA this year as I will return on occasions. I have been kept very busy these last months and enjoying performing and traveling with her up to Canada seeing friends and just plain loving life.

Marking this one year of losing Gail, my life will never be what it was, but likened to the air that I breathed yesterday that sustained me I am breathing new air and still standing. God Bless.




