President's Report

e have going through a trying time on the board lately. We have only one resident running for two openings on the board. I know it means you have to give up some time to make our community the best it can be but the satisfaction of knowing you are doing a job to help your friends and neighbors have a happy retirement with you. I want to thank Clyde Delf for running for one of the open positions. We had a new member of our community step forward and take the other open position. Frank St. Peter has agreed to fill

the other board member's position thanks Frank. The board will be mostly all new members in two years. We are hoping new people will step forward and take over these needed positions.

I hope by the time this news letter comes out that the fence on the north end of the park is completed. I put it on hold last spring because of the water tank removal. We were trying to talk the city into the property where the tank was removed but we did not succeed with our inquires at this time.

We have a new lawn service starting on February 25th. The old service was causing way too much damage to our community. This is the third lawn service that we have hired in the last six years. They all start off great but seem to get lax over the course of time. We will see how the new service works out.

As of this writing we only have one unit up for sale in the park. We had five on the list in January and all were sold. We went a week with no unit for sale. We as a park are in high demand from people looking for homes. We have a waiting list of buyers in the office that are preapproved that are looking for certain types of units. I have yet to talk to anyone that comes in the office that does not think we have the best community around this area.

We are still working on our water losses and have not put it on the back burner. We will in the near future be checking each unit for water leaks. We can do this from the outside of each unit. It will not take that long at each home to determine if there are leaks. The last water bills still show we are using 100,000 gallons less than last year per month.

The board picnic is scheduled for March 23rd at noontime. We will let everyone know where it will held when we put the signup sheets in the clubhouse.
