

Day 1: The crew arrived and installed ladders, ropes and tools.

Day 2: They started cutting pie shapes in the bottom of the tank using cutting torches. The men were actually inside the tank while they cut. Some of the sparks started a fire on the ground, but it was quickly extinguished.

Day 3: More cutting of pie shapes in the bottom of the tank.





Day 4: The crew was cutting on the top of the tank and removed the entire top.

Day 5: They were cutting more pie shapes, but this time from the outside of the tank, hanging from ladders.

Day 6: More cutting of pie shapes on the outside of the tank.

Day 7: Day of rest. No work was performed today.

Day 9: The entire tank has been removed, only the tank legs remain.

Day 10: They started cutting down the legs and disposing of them. The big crane is gone and smaller equipment arrived to pick up the metal and load it into trucks.

Day 11: Finished, packed up, and left.
