








President's Report

ummer is almost over and it will be time to head back to our winter homes. We have been having nice weather here on Cape Cod but in the last couple of days the fall weather is starting to take over. The trees are slowly turning the leaves a different color and the air has a fall breeze to it. It is a great time to be on Cape Cod.

The water tower meeting with the city went well. The city had six officials and the contractor that is going to do the work at the meeting in our clubhouse. They explained how the tower was going to be dismantled and about the fall area. The contractor who is in charge of the project said there was no danger to our residents living in the fall area. He also said this was a small contract for his company that takes down large buildings and larger towers. The city gave us the manager to contact if we needed more information in the future. We also talked to the city officials after the meeting on a number of different subjects that affect our community.

I will be contacting the city about the storm water flooding on Third Avenue when I return. The city manager said he will work with Golden Acres for what can be done

about the problems we are having with storm water. I discussed the possibility of a holding pond for the excess water we are getting from the runoff of the bank parking lot.

We also asked what the city was going to do with the land after the water tower is removed. I told the city manager that Golden Acres would be happy to take the land off their hands to be added to our park. He told me the city does not give land away. I told him we would like to be first on the list to buy it.

The storm water and unit charge on our water bill was discussed. We currently pay about \$60,000.00 a year on our water bill for these charges. I asked if everyone pays the same rate and because we are an older community if the rate could be reduced. He laughed and said the rate was not negotiable. We also asked what the bank pays for a rate and he said the same as

we do.

The palm trees will be trimmed when I return in October. We have been having so much rain in Florida this summer that the palms are almost touching the sidewalks. The curtains in the clubhouse are being cleaned. They have been up for five year and need cleaning.

We have had various water leaks in the park over the summer. We are trying to keep the water leaks under control. I met with the plumbing company we used to repair the leak when I was down in August for the city meeting. I gave him maps of the water system to see if we can find the shut offs that are not working. I would like to fix the problem of having to shut off the whole park for a water leak. He will get back to me when I return to the park. I received an e-mail from Bob Mickle and he has been tracking our water bills. He reported to me that our water bills are down 27% from last year. We are making head way on water leaks in the park, but we still have more leaks to find. If you see water on the ground please report it to the office. We had one leak that ran two months and wasn't reported.

The board received our proposed budget from P.M.I. this week. We are presently looking it over so the board can vote on accepting it so it can be mailed out to our shareholders for their vote on November 12th.

We hope everyone has a safe trip back to their winter homes.

When your return to the park, please sign in. You may do this in the office or in the clubhouse. There is a new procedure this year requested by PMI. It is a form you must fill out verifying your away address.

Our next mailing from PMI for the proposed budget will go out October 10th. If you are in transit during this time let the office know so you are not chasing your mail. Please mark your calendars for these dates:

Norma Miller (unit 34), we have started an in-the-park Calling Tree System to inform residents when the water is turned off for repairs in the park. The list of 61 full-time residents is small and several volunteers we can contact everyone fairly quickly. If this occurs during the winter, we will need more volunteers. Please let us know if you are available to call 8-10 people if a full shut-down occurs. The key issue of not having water is also to turn off your hot-water heater during this outage so

the element does not burn-out. Often we can isolate an area and repair the leak with a few valve turnoffs, but on occasion this is not possible. Leaks occur with little warning. If you should notice a wet area near your coach notify the office immediately. Solving plumbing leaks is our number one project this season.

Back on the Bombing Run

Toan and I flew over to the United Kingdom to witness the last two Lancaster Bombers flying together. We, like millions of others, were thrilled.

In tribute to the 55,000 brave aircrew who lost their lives in the Second World War, one of the worlds' last two airworthy



Lancaster Bombers (made famous by the Dambusters Raid) take the same route over Bomber Country where some 389,000 sorties were flown by Bomber Command between 1939 and 1945. The Canadian Lancaster Vera - dedicated to Andrew Mynarski, the last Canadian airman to be awarded the VC in World War II – made the long journey to Britain from its base at the Ontario's Warplane Heritage Museum and joined the Lancaster Thumper, from the Battle of Britain Memorial Flight, at various events - marking the first time the two Bombers have flown together in 50 years.

Editor's Note: The Dambusters Raid (code named Operation Chastise) set out to destroy 3 dams in a key industrial area of Germany on May 16, 1943. Although the mission was hailed a success, eight aircraft and fifty three crew were lost during the raids.





Water and Swimming Safety

From the Red Cross

recent Red Cross survey found that eight out of ten Americans are planning water activities such as going to the beach, pool, water park or boating or fishing this summer. A third (32 percent) of all Americans plan to swim at a place without a lifeguard. The Red Cross has launched an anti-drowning campaign this summer that promotes swim lessons and safe swimming.

If a trip to the beach is part of someone's plans, the Red Cross has ten tips that will help beachgoers stay out of harm's way:

- 1. If someone plans to swim in the ocean, they should always check weather conditions before going in the water.
- 2. Swim only at a lifeguard protected beach, within the designated swimming area and listen to all lifeguard instructions.
- 3. Always swim with a buddy and always swim sober.
- 4. Young children and inexperienced swimmers should wear a Coast Guard-approved life jacket.
- 5. Everyone should enter the water feet first if they can't see the bottom or don't know how deep the water is.
- 6. Be aware of the danger of rip currents. If caught in one, swim parallel to the shore until out of the current. When free, turn and swim toward shore. If unable to swim to the shore, call out for help, float or tread water until free of the rip current and then head toward shore.
- 7. Limit the amount of direct sunlight received between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., and wear a broad-spectrum sunscreen with a protection factor of at least 15. Reapply often.
- 8. Stay hydrated. Drink plenty of water regularly, even if not thirsty. Avoid drinks with alcohol or caffeine in them.
- 9. Protect the eyes by wearing sunglasses that will absorb 100 percent of UV sunlight.
- 10. Wear beach shoes. The sand is hot and can burn someone's feet and glass and other sharp objects can cut them.





isasters can strike at any time and the Tampa Bay Chapter of the American Red Cross encourages everyone to take the first step during National Preparedness Month and joinAmerica's PrepareAthon, creating a disaster plan for their household that can help keep people safe in an emergency.

"Having an emergency plan is an important step so everyone in the household knows what they should do if something happens," said Linda Carbone, CEO of Florida's West Coast Region and the Tampa Bay Chapter. "We believe people should mark National Preparedness Month by creating or updating their plan."

Here in Florida, Red Cross chapters have joined together in a landmark statewide campaign that will mobilize communities to be better prepared in the face of disaster. Prepare Florida will educate and empower hundreds of thousands of Floridians on how to take necessary action to care for themselves, their families and their neighbors during emergencies and will educate our citizens about what to expect during and after a disaster.

MAKE A PLAN: Everyone in the household should help put the emergency plan together so they know what they should do if something occurs. Because everyone may not be together at home when a disaster happens, the plan should include ways to contact one another and two places to meet – one near the home in case of a sudden emergency like a fire, and one outside the neighborhood in case circumstances prevent people from returning home. The plan should also identify an emergency contact person from outside the area in case local telephone lines are overloaded or out of service.

Any emergency plan should also include decisions about where to go if ordered to evacuate and what route to take to get there. It's a good idea to include alternate routes in case roads are closed. Don't forget family pets. Make sure to include plans for them such as pet-friendly hotels and animal shelters along the evacuation route.
