



#### **Notes from the office**

ow did March get here so quickly I'll never know? This has been the busiest year in the last ten that we have had such robust sales. And, it is the first time that we currently have no sales listings since they go so quickly. There are always more units in the wings for sale.

The timing has to be right for the seller. Since January we have had 10 sales! Our normal for an entire year is about 12 and this is only the first 2 months of 2016. Not all of the 10 units have closed yet, but the sales are in progress.

Those of you who are still waiting to close, patience is appreciated. Our office and our attorney's office are scrambling daily to get all paperwork in order to make things go smoothly. This time next year you will all be nestled into your new units and enjoying all the park activities when you are not doing reconstruction or fixing things up.

Just as a reminder for those of you purchasing or have friends buying, the procedure for paying varies and I'd like to post the process:

- 1. If you use a certified check, there is a \$50 fee for processing from the attorney's office and it takes a week to clear if it is a US bank.
- 2. If it is a Canadian Bank, Damonte's bank has to send the paper check to Canada to be processed. This usually takes three weeks to clear.
- 3. If you wire funds to Damonte's office (which is their most requested way to receive funds) your bank may charge a fee. It's still the easiest and fastest.
- 4. If they are paying you as the seller, they will give you a check or they can wire funds into your account.

Tax season is fast approaching and everyone needs to fax something to their accountant. Please do this on Tuesday and Thursday's when the office is not quite so busy. It takes time, so be patient if we are busy. Have some money to pay for this convenient Service (.50 page).

Has anyone noticed what a great working Board of Directors we have. Dave Merriam is our latest addition who will be a great help being a full time resident, and Joe Lemon has accepted the position for the remainder of Skip's term. Three of our Board Members will be attending an all-day training session in March to officially be certified meeting the requirements of Florida Statutes

Pertaining to cooperatives (719.106). The course is also approved by the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulations (DBPR). This prepares them for directorship in our community. We commend them for attending.

Don't forget to sign out when departing the park. This information is for PMI so they know WHEN you will be RETURNING to the park in the fall or winter. They can send your proposed budgets and or other items to your correct mailing address. Also remember that forwarding with the post office lasts for 6 months only. You have to extend if it is longer than this

It is with a heavy heart that I write these notes from the office since I will be retiring from the wonderful community of Golden Acres April 15th. What a great gig I have had from the very start, under the grand tutelage of Pat Perry as President in 2006 to the dedicated and determined guidance of Ray Lamoureux in 2016. The joys we have shared together from the moment you have purchased a unit in Golden Acres until you became a fully fledged resident has been especially fun and rewarding. 




