

From The Office

o you believe it is April already? Well I know some "snow-birds" will be starting to plan for their journey back north. Here are a few reminders for your attention:

- Please remember to sign out in the office. Your signature is needed to stop the Water/Sewer/Trash Bill. Per the Golden Gate Rules & Regulations: (#16 Home sites): Shareholders will be exempt from billing for City utilities for any month which the home is occupied less than 7 days providing the sign out procedure with the office has been properly completed. There is a city charge of \$25 to reactivate the water bill.
- When signing out please check to make sure we have an "away" contact number and address to reach you.
- "Weeds Needs" Once again, the Weed program is available for \$40.00. This covers spraying for weeds in your front planters from May through September. If you choose not to participate or if someone is watching out for the upkeep of your property, if there is an issue, the "Friendly Reminder" will be sent to you. Please accept the reminder in the spirit it was intended......just a friendly notice that your property may need a little attention.
- Hurricane Season Please put away or secure all outside items that may become a projectile during a Hurricane. Even items that you may think are heavy (patio chairs/tables, flower box pots or ornaments, etc.) will become airborne in 40+ mph winds. Your neighbors appreciate your consideration. It also does not invite potential thieves in to take your "stuff".
- Don't forget to get a forwarding mail package from either the mail man or there is a limited supply in the Office. If you do forget, you can forward your mail on-line at www. usps.gov.

This is probably a good time to give a refresher on how the Water/Sewer/Trash bills work. If you are here more than 6 days in a calendar month, you will get a bill from the city. The bill date is always 1 month past the usage month. For example, if you were here more than 6 days in April, you will get a bill in May, with a bill date of May. The payment will be due in June. To make it a little more confusing, if you have an electronic debit from your checking account, you will see the payment in June, (because that is the due date) for April's usage. Hope this helps.....if not give Jane a call.

Shut off water valves

If you are using the water outdoors, please remember to shut off the valve at the house instead of just turn the nozzle on the hose.





Weed Program

As most of you are aware, we have a problem with the growth of weeds during the summer months, typically May through September. The weed problem we are concerned about is in the planter boxes and the front of the homes. Even those homes that have mulch or stones in the planter boxes will have weed growth.

The board does send "friendly reminders" to alert residents as stated in rule #16..."Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. However, the general response to the friendly reminders has been less than satisfactory.

We would like to aid in solving this problem by having our maintenance staff spray weed killer in the planter boxes or in front of the home for any resident that desires to participate. There will be a \$40.00 per year fee to cover the cost of the material for spraying from May through September. If you wish to participate in this program, send a check or pay cash to Jane in the office. If you choose to participate in this program, our maintenance staff will spray,

beginning in May and ending in September. However, if you have ornamental plants that could be harmed by the spraying, you will have to make other arrangements,

since we will not be responsible for any damages.

If you choose not to participate, the weed issue for planters and the front of your home will continue to be your responsibility, and be subject to the terms of rule #16 concerning work done in your absence.

Safety & Security "Remove It!!" "Lock It!!" or "Lose It!!"

This is a new campaign to all Pinellas County residents to lock your vehicles. There have been a rash of burglaries to unlocked vehicles. Officers will be using notices on vehicles to instill upon the citizens to lock their vehicles so they won't become a victim.

The following Scam Alerts have been verified by Donna Saxer, Pinellas Park Crime Prevention Officer.....Don't be a victim!

Which tastes Better? Coke or Pepsi? Do not call the phone number...it is a scam to get your personal information. They will try to set up an appointment to sell vacuum cleaners. Never give out personal information to someone you do not know.

People have received fake court documents via email. Do not open the attachment. It will activate a computer virus. DELETE THIS EMAIL! Official court documents such as subpoenas, depositions, court appearances are never sent via email.

Returning Residents

U.S. Postal Service Carrier

If you are returning to the Community after being gone for the summer, please put a note on the outside of your box stating you are back. Also please remove sticker dot from your box. Thank you.

Recycling on Wednesday

- No plastic bags please!
- Aluminum Cans Empty aluminum cans used for drinks or food. Rinse and crush if possible.



- Cartons Empty gable-top beverage containers such as milk, half and half or orange juice cartons. Rinse and crush if possible.
- Glass Empty glass bottles or jars (all colors). Labels okay. No caps or lids.
- Mixed Paper Any clean, dry paper item that tears, such as white or colored paper, shredded paper, office paper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, envelopes, wrapping paper, or paperboard items such as cereal boxes. No paper towels or tissues.
- Newspapers Clean and dry newspapers (including inserts). No string or twine. It's okay to put the news¬papers inside a paper bag.
- Plastic Bottles Empty bottles such as water, soda or mouthwash bottles. Rinse and crush if possible. No need to check for a number—just "check for a neck" (i.e., an opening smaller than the base). Bottles only; no tubs, cups or bags. Labels okay. Caps okay but remove the cap from the bottle so that liquids dry out. Place the cap and the bottle in the bin.
- Steel (Tin) Cans Empty steel cans used for food such as soup cans. Labels and lids okay. No paint cans. Aerosol cans okay. Rinse if possible.
