

ANNUAL MEETING PARTICIPATION

Because of an outbreak of COVID-19 in the park in November, the Board of Directors was forced to close the clubhouse and pool till further notice. Since the closing, the Board decided to re-0pen the pool to residents and guests as Monday, 11/23.



If we have a meeting, you can cancel your proxy at the meeting and vote in person.

If we do not have a meeting quorum, then, we must start the process all over costing residents an additional \$2,000.

In the event we are not able to re-open the clubhouse prior to the December 15 Budget meeting, to allow Golden Gate resident's the opportunity to attend the meeting, we will be using the 'Zoom' meeting software.

Once your email address is received, you will be sent a Zoom meeting invite by email. When you click on the link in the email it will take you to the Zoom page and allow you to download the Zoom software. You will then be asked to fill in your information to create a "FREE" Zoom account. Once you have created your account you will be able to attend any Zoom meetings you have received an email invite for.

The Zoom invite will give you the date and time of the meeting. You will not need any password to log into the meeting...the link will do that for you.

The first notice of the Annual Meeting to be held on February 16, 2021 will be mailed or distributed to all shareholders on or before December 04, 2020. This notice describes the procedure to be followed in qualifying to run for the Board of Directors. At that Annual Meeting it will be necessary to elect two directors to our Board. The terms of Pat Stephenson and Jerold Thompson will expire in February, 2021. Important: Your notice of intent to run must be back to the office BY December 30th, 2020 to be eligible.



How to pay your monthly maintenance fees

olden Gate residents use many different methods to pay their monthly maintenance fees

- 1. Write a monthly check, place in the mail, or deliver to the office before the 1st of each month to avoid late charges
- 2. Write one check to cover two, three, six or twelve months mail or deliver to the office
- 3. Pay with twelve separate checks. Checks postdated to be applied monthly relying on the Office Manager to correctly apply your monthly checks
- 4. Pay in cash or money orders monthly or annually

Cash payments are discouraged as the homeowners' association incurs a bank charge. The bank charges approximately \$10 for large cash deposits. Seems outrageous but they must call for a pickup to deposit extra cash in the federal reserve bank and remove it from their premises.

Recycling on Wednesday

T o plastic bags please!

Aluminum Cans – Empty aluminum cans used for drinks or food. Rinse and crush if possible.

Cartons – Empty gable-top beverage containers such as milk, half and half or orange juice cartons. Rinse and crush if possible.

Glass – Empty glass bottles or jars (all colors). Labels okay. No caps or lids.

Mixed Paper – Any clean, dry paper item that tears, such as white or colored paper, shredded paper, office paper, magazines, catalogs, phone books, junk mail, envelopes, wrapping paper, or paperboard items such as cereal boxes. No paper towels or tissues.

Newspapers – Clean and dry newspapers (including inserts). No string or twine. It's okay to put the news¬papers inside a paper bag.

Plastic Bottles – Empty bottles such as water, soda or mouthwash bottles. Rinse and crush if possible. No need to check for a number—just "check for a neck" (i.e., an opening smaller than the base). Bottles only; no tubs, cups or bags. Labels okay. Caps okay but remove the cap from the bottle so that liquids dry out. Place the cap and the bottle in the bin.

Steel (Tin) Cans – Empty steel cans used for food such as soup cans. Labels and lids okay. No paint cans. Aerosol cans okay. Rinse if possible.

Highlighted Golden Gate Rule...#18

18. COMPLAINT, COMPLIANCE, AND DEFAULT: Any complaints regarding breaking any of the rules in the governing documents by a Shareholder or their guests are to be written on a complaint form (available in office) and must name the resident or guest against whom the complaint is being filed, specify the rule being violated and date when alleged violation occurred, be signed and dated and presented

to the office. The Board of Directors should send a Notice of Violation to the Party noted in the complaint containing a description of the alleged violation, statement identifying which provision of the governing documents has been alleged violated, a reasonable time to abate the violation and a statement that a hearing may be held or requested. The Board of Directors will notify the person registering the complaint as to what action the Board of Directors has taken in addressing the complaint. Personal conflicts and domestic quarrels are not within the scope of the Association's responsibility; the Association will not become involved unless the dispute is deemed detrimental to other residents of the Community. The Board of Directors will not share the signed complaints or name of the complainant with the Shareholders. The Association reserves the right to pursue all remedies permitted under Chapter 719 Florida Statutes.






