From the Office

Tell we know most, if not all Canadian "snow-birds" and now our U.S. residents are leaving for their journey back north. Here are a few reminders for your attention:

- Please remember to sign out in the office. Your signature is needed to stop the Water/Sewer/ Trash Bill. Per the Golden Gate Rules & Regulations: (#16 Home sites): Shareholders will be exempt from billing for City utilities for any month which the home is unoccupied providing the sign out procedure with the office has been properly completed.
- When signing out please check to make sure we have an "AWAY" contact number and address to reach you.
- "Weeds Needs" Once again, the Weed program is available to GG residents for \$40.00. This covers spraying for weeds in your front planters from May through September. If you choose not to participate or you have someone watching out for the upkeep of your property and if there is an issue, the "Friendly Reminder" will be sent to you. Please accept the reminder in the spirit it was intended......just a friendly notice that your property may need a little attention.
- <u>Hurricane Season</u> Please put away or secure all outside items that may become a projectile during a Hurricane. Even items that you may think are heavy (patio chairs/tables, flower box pots or ornaments, etc.) will become airborne in 40+ mph winds. Your neighbors appreciate your consideration. It also does not invite potential thieves in to take your "stuff". Pinellas County Emergency Management (727-464-3800) has provided Golden Gate Community with Hurricane/Tropical storm fliers on important information and how to contact the County & sign up for emergency notifications through Alert Pinellas (www.pinellascounty.org/alertpinellas). They will be distributed to those residents still in the park.
 - Don't forget to get a forwarding mail package from either the mail carrier or, there is a limited supply in the Clubhouse. If you do forget, you can forward your mail on-line at www.usps.gov.
- This is probably a good time to give a refresher on how the Water/Sewer/Trash bills work. If you are here for 1 day in a calendar month, you will get a bill from the city. The bill date is always one month past the usage month. For example, if you were here for 1 day in April, you will receive a bill from City of Pinellas Park in May, with a bill date of May. The payment will be due in June. To make it a little more confusing, if you have an electronic debit from your checking account, you will see the payment in June, (because that is the due date) for April's usage. Hope this helps, if not give Jane a call at the office.

- 1. Keep doors and sheds locked at all times. Yes, even if you are home.
- 2. Consider installing a motion sensitive porch or yard lights. Thieves hate lights!
- 3. Do not leave tempting items in your carport or <u>in back</u> of your home. A lot of thieves cruise the area first to see what is available and come back after dark. So, keep your sheds closed, locked and valuables out of sight.
- 4. Report any known theft, vandalism, or <u>suspicious characters</u> to the Police on (727) 369-7864 <u>IMMEDIATELY</u>. <u>Don't call the Office or the Directors</u> and DO NOT confront the individual(s) let the police do the investigation! Although it is important information for us to know, the Police will not accept reports from anyone other than the person who witnessed the event and can describe first-hand what has happened. You can let the office know once you have reported it to the Police.
 - a. Pay attention to details: What does the suspect look like (size, features, clothing, vehicle (color and make if possible), etc. This will help the Police search our area and surrounding communities.
 - b. <u>Do not follow the suspect.</u> That is dangerous for your safety and will only delay the report to the police.
- 5. If you go away for a few days or a few weeks, don't forget to stop the mail and paper delivery. A loaded mailbox or newspapers in your carport screams "Break in I'm not here".
- 6. Don't assume that strangers are just someone's family visiting. If your gut tells you something is wrong, it probably is. <u>DO NOT</u> confront the individual(s) <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> call the Police non-emergency number (727-369-7864). It is much easier to apologize to a neighbor for the error than explaining to them ..."gee I'm sorry, I thought it was someone related to you" after their home is broken in to.
- 7. Lock/Secure your Golf Cart and Bicycles.

Shut off water valves

f you are using the water outdoors, please remember to shut off the valve at the house instead of just turn the nozzle on the hose.

Weed Program

s most of you are aware, we have a problem with the growth of weeds during the summer months, typically May through September. The weed problem we are concerned about is in the planter boxes and the front of the homes. Even those homes that have mulch or stones in the planter boxes will have weed growth.



The board does send "Friendly Reminders" to alert residents as stated in rule #16..."Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. However, the general response to the friendly reminders has been less than satisfactory.

We would like to aid in solving this problem by having our maintenance staff spray weed killer in the planter boxes or in front of the home for any resident that desires to participate. There will be a \$40.00 per year fee to cover the cost of the material for spraying from May through September. If you wish to participate in this program, send a check or pay cash to Jane in the office. If you choose to participate in this program, our maintenance staff will spray, beginning in May and ending in September. However, if you have ornamental plants that could be harmed by the spraying, you will have to make other arrangements, since we will not be responsible for any damages.

If you choose not to participate, the weed issue for planters and the front of your home will continue to be your responsibility, and be subject to the terms of rule #16 concerning work done in your absence.

Maintenance Staff Assistance

If you identify a maintenance item around the Community, please ask someone in the office (Jane or a member of the board) to complete a work order for Lam. This allows them to track, prioritize and complete their daily work load. Thank you!
