

## Highlighted Golden Gated Rules and Regulation of the month...

9. VEHICLES AND GOLF CARTS IN THE COMMUNITY: All residents and guests must obey all local and state rules related to the operation of vehicles. The 15 (fifteen) MPH speed limit must be observed by all residents and guests. Parking on sidewalks or blocking of sidewalks or parking between homes is not permitted per City Fire Code. No overnight parking on the streets. Guests may park their cars in the area around the clubhouse for a period of 15 days with Board of Directors approval. Residents are not allowed to park around the clubhouse on a continuous basis. A permit, obtainable from the Association office, is required to park any recreational vehicle and/or boat in the parking area around the clubhouse. Permits will be issued for a maximum of two days and must be displayed on the windshield of the vehicle. No unlicensed vehicles are allowed in the community. No person under 16 years of age shall be allowed to drive vehicles/golf carts. Shareholders assume all liability and responsibility for any injuries and damages arising from the operation of their golf carts.

## **Bicycles**

Please remember that bicycles are vehicles and must obey all traffic laws including stopping at all stop signs. This applies to residents and visitors.


