### From the Office

Tell we know most, if not all Canadian "snow-birds" have left for their journey back north and many U.S. "snow-birds" are preparing for their journey north as well. Here are a few reminders for your attention:

- Please remember to sign out in the office. Your signature is needed to stop the Water/Sewer/Trash Bill. Per the Golden Gate Rules & Regulations: (#16 Home sites): Shareholders will be exempt from billing for City utilities for any month which the home is unoccupied providing the sign out procedure with the office has been properly completed.
- When signing out please check to make sure we have an "AWAY" contact number and address to reach you.
- "Weeds Needs" Once again, the Weed program is available to GG residents for \$40.00. This covers spraying for weeds in your front planters from May through September. If you choose not to participate or you have someone watching out for the upkeep of your property and if there is an issue, the "Friendly Reminder" will be sent to you. Please accept the reminder in the spirit it was intended......just a friendly notice that your property may need a little attention.
- <u>Hurricane Season</u> Please put away or secure all outside items that may become a projectile during a Hurricane. Even items that you may think are heavy (patio chairs/tables, flower box pots or ornaments, etc.) will become airborne in 40+ mph winds. Your neighbors appreciate your consideration. It also does not invite potential thieves in to take your "stuff". Pinellas County Emergency Management (727-464-3800) has provided Golden Gate Community with Hurricane/Tropical storm fliers on important information and how to contact the County & sign up for emergency notifications through Alert Pinellas (www.pinellascounty.org/alertpinellas). They will be distributed to those residents still in the park.
- Don't forget to get a forwarding mail package from either the mail carrier or, there is a limited supply in the Clubhouse. If you do forget, you can forward your mail on-line at www.usps.gov.

This is probably a good time to give a refresher on how the Water/Sewer/Trash bills work. If you are here for 1 day in a calendar month, you will get a bill from the city. The bill date is always one month past the usage month. For example, if you were here for 1 day in April, you will receive a bill from City of Pinellas Park in May, with a bill date of May. The payment will be due in June. To make it a little more confusing, if you have an electronic debit from your checking account, you will see the payment in June, (because that is the due date) for April's usage. Hope this helps, if not give Jane a call at the office.

We would like to aid in solving this problem by having our maintenance staff spray weed killer in the planter boxes or in front of the home for any resident that desires to participate. There will be a \$40.00 per year fee to cover the cost of the material for spraying from May through September. If you wish to participate in this program, send a check or pay cash to Jane in the office. If you choose to participate in this program, our maintenance staff will spray, beginning in May and ending in September. However, if you have ornamental plants that could be harmed by the spraying, you will have to make other arrangements, since we will not be responsible for any damages.

If you choose not to participate, the weed issue for planters and the front of your home will continue to be your responsibility, and be subject to the terms of rule #16 concerning work done in your absence.

### Highlighted Golden Gated Rules and Regulation of the month...

16. HOME SITES: All homes must have their house number visible on the front of the home. Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. No outside storage is permitted around or under your home. If the home is not maintained in accordance with general established standards set by the Association (i.e., in a run-down condition or is in general disrepair), the shareholder shall be subject to the provisions of Article 3 of these rules. Each shareholder is responsible for the condition of his planter boxes, fruit trees and plantings at all times. Lower branches of fruit trees must be trimmed to a minimum of 48 inches from the ground. Our Board of Directors or their appointee(s) have the authority to designate those residences which are not properly maintained. Flowers, plants, trees, and shrubs enhance the appearance of your lot but a permit is required from the Association before planting other than in planters. The Association is responsible for lawn mowing and maintaining the Association planted trees. Trash and recycle pickup will be established according to city guidelines.

Residents are requested to refrain from putting garbage out at the curb the night before, unless in a secure covered receptacle, and are also requested to promptly remove any trash receptacles after pickup. The trash receptacles should not block driveways or sidewalks. Any additions or revisions to your exterior property, including outside painting of any type, must be approved by the Board of Directors and a <u>permit</u> obtained from the office before starting work. The permit must be displayed in a clearly visible area. No fences permitted without approval of Board of Directors. Federal and State laws allow for the installation of satellite antennas 1 meter or less in diameter, but permission from the Board of Directors must be obtained first. Only umbrella type drying lines may be used and should be set in the back of home. No clothes hanging on the carport, including swimwear. Water, sewer, and garbage pickup charges are billed to the individual shareholder by the City of Pinellas Park on a monthly basis. Shareholders are to adhere to county and city water conservation rules. Irrigation and/or other watering must be done by a handheld hose: no automated sprinklers permitted. The Association shall have the right at any time to cause the water to be individually metered at each mobile home. No new wells are permitted. No resident or guest may engage in any type of commercial business in the community. Patio or rummage sales are permitted with approval of the Board of Directors. The Association reserves the right to enforce the rules and regulations at the shareholders' expense



should they not be adhered to. Residents leaving for the summer or extended periods of time should obtain a form from the office, completing each item, and returning the completed form to the office. If the shareholder does not provide for the care of these items in his/her absence, the Association will have the work done, and the unit will be assessed at the rate of \$25.00 per hour with a two-hour \$50.00 minimum per occurrence. There will be NO exemptions from billing for City utilities unless the home is unoccupied for the entire month and the sign out procedure with the office has been completed.

### **Prevention & Treatment**

### **Prevention**

There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus. However, as a reminder, CDC always recommends everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory diseases, including:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Follow CDC's recommendations for using a facemask.
  - o CDC does not recommend that people who are well wear a facemask to protect themselves from respiratory diseases, including COVID-19.
  - o Facemasks should be used by people who show symptoms of COVID-19 to help prevent the spread of the disease to others. The use of facemasks is also crucial for health workers and people who are taking care of someone in close settings (at home or in a health care facility).
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
  - o If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol. Always wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.

These are everyday habits that can help prevent the spread of several viruses. CDC does have specific guidance for travelers.

**Treatment** 

There is no specific antiviral treatment recommended for COVID-19. People with COVID-19 should receive supportive care to help relieve symptoms. For severe cases, treatment should include care to support vital organ functions.

People who think they may have been exposed to COVID-19 should contact their healthcare provider immediately.






