

There was no Board of Directors meeting scheduled in September, 2015. Our financial report for the month of August 2015 shows that income for the month was \$35,030 with expenditures of \$32,660. The financial statement for each month is posted on the bulletin board at the rear of the hall for everyone to review.

Just a Reminder from the Board of Directors:

Additionally, there have been a few incidents where residents have had guest staying at their home over the 15 day limit without directors approval. Per Rule 5 of the Golden Gate Regulations "Occupancy by guests of the shareholder shall be for a period of time not exceeding

(fifteen) consecutive days and 30 (thirty) days total per year, unless a longer period is approved, in writing, by the Board of Directors. Any visit of a guest will be terminated immediately if they fail to abide by the Association Rules and Regulations. Any permission for an approved extended guest who fails to follow the Rules and Regulations will be revoked. For those approved guests whose visits extend beyond 15 (fifteen) consecutive days or 30 (thirty) days total for the year, there will be an additional charge of \$2.00 per person per day. Use of the unit by family members is permitted, provided the shareholder notifies the office prior to arrival of the guests, assumes responsibility for water, sewer, and garbage charges and designates the length of stay. Guests must be registered upon arrival and they must agree to abide by all the rules of the Association."

Shut off water valves

f you are using the water outdoors, please remember to shut off the valve at the house instead of just turn the nozzle on the hose.

Maintenance Staff Assistance

If you identify a maintenance item around the Community, please ask someone in the office (Jane or a member of the board) to complete a work order for Lam or Jim. This allows them to track, prioritize and complete their daily work load. Thank you!

Parking Request

Thenever you, your guests, or contractors need to park out on the street, please follow Community Rules!

V• No parking on the sidewalks. Your maintenance fees pay for all repairs.

• Please use common sense and do not park near or on corners or close to intersections. We would encourage parking on the same side of the street to avoid traffic having to "zig-zag" to get by. This causes obstructions and creates a dangerous situation for cars, golf carts and bicycles trying to proceed by the vehicles.







Soliciting

oliciting of any kind is not allowed in Golden Gate. If anyone comes to your door trying to sell anything, please be safe and just say no thank you; close your door and call the police non-emergency number (on page 2 of the Golden Gate Telephone Directory (727) 541-0758. Do not confront the solicitors. The Office was informed by a resident who was walking and saw an uncomfortable soliciting incident. He used his cell phone to call the police and report it. The police arrived in 3 minutes and when they searched the community they found a number of people who were blanketing the entire community. They were all detained and interrogated. You are not being "mean" when you call the Police. You are protecting yourself and your Community.

Golf Cart Parking

It has been brought to the Board's attention that many unit owners are leaving their golf carts parked between units. This causes a problem for the Association's Lawn Contractor, for it impacts his ability to perform his responsibilities in a proper manner. Please refrain from parking the carts on the lawn areas, especially on Mondays, the designated day for lawn cuttings. Your cooperation is truly appreciated.

WEED PROGRAM

s most of you are aware, we have a problem with the growth of weeds during the summer months, typically May through September. The weed problem we are concerned about is in the planter boxes and the front of the homes. Even those homes that have mulch or stones in the planter boxes will have weed growth.

The board does send "friendly reminders" to alert residents as stated in rule #16..."Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. However, the general response to the friendly reminders has been less than satisfactory.

We would like to aid in solving this problem by having our maintenance staff spray weed killer in the planter boxes or in front of the home for any resident that desires to participate. There will be a \$40.00 per year fee to cover the cost of the material for spraying from May through September. If you wish to participate in this program, send a check

or pay cash to Jane in the office. If you choose to participate in this program, our maintenance staff will spray, beginning in May and ending in September. However, if you have ornamental plants that could be harmed by the spraying, you will have to make other arrangements, since we will not be responsible

for any damages.

If you choose not to participate, the weed issue for planters and the front of your home will continue to be your responsibility, and be subject to the terms of rule #16 concerning work done in your absence.

Sidewalk cleaning

Your board has agreed on the issue of pressure washing our sidewalks. This will begin in July. The sidewalks in the worst condition will be done first. For anyone who is not in residence at the time of their cleaning, no water will be turned on at your home.

Shuffle Club

n 8/16 while visiting the swimming pool I noticed that the lights were lit on the shuffle-board courts from the night before. Someone playing on the courts drinking beer spilled or poured beer all over the foot of court #2.

When they had finished abusing the courts they chose to leave the lights burning all night. If the beer was spilled accidentally, there was a hose available at that court to flush away the liquid. Now let's consider what is happening here, members of our community are responsible for all guests that use the facilities. Members need to accompany their guests to supervise everything they choose to do, and respect the rules. The shuffle courts are treated with a surface that will only tolerate water. No other liquids can be brought onto the courts at any time especially alcoholic beverages handled by irresponsible people who see nothing wrong with damaging what we work so hard to maintain. Walking away and leaving beer bottle caps, cups, spilled beverages, and all the lights left on overnight shows extreme disrespect for our community. Whoever is responsible for what has happened to our courts needs to correct both their behavior and any guests' behavior.

The first shuffle club meeting will be on October 13th at 7:00 pm in the hall. We always welcome new member interested in learning to play shuffleboard. Our two beginner teams need new members every year, just come out to practice on Wednesday at

1:00pm, all through April begins at 12:45pm bring .50 to play.

Avoiding the dentist? It may cost you

Proper dental care is important to your overall health. Unfortunately, many of us tend to avoid visiting the dentist—often because of the cost.

A survey commissioned by Aspen Dental found that almost two out of five Americans have delayed needed dental work, or had it only partially performed, because of their financial situation. It's a figure that has jumped by almost 8 percent over the last two years, even though 80 percent say they're aware that staying away from the dentist will be more expensive in the long run.



Take one step to lose weight

Tant to lose weight? Step onto a scale every day. That may seem like obvious advice, but it's supported by the results of a study reported on the Live Science website.

In the study, researchers challenged 162 people to reduce their weight by 10 percent over the course of the year. They weren't given any specific advice, but about half the participants were given scales and told to check and record their weight every morning.

Although few of the participants in either group achieved their goal of losing 10 percent of their body weight, 29 percent of those given scales succeeded in losing at least 5 percent, but only 11 percent in the scale-free group lost as much. In addition, participants given scales managed to maintain their weight loss for a second year.

The researchers have theorized that checking weight once a day may help people pay more attention to what they eat (and how much), and reinforce positive weight-loss behaviors like skipping dessert.

ne important factor that can unbalance a marriage or romantic relationship is debt. A survey conducted by Harris Poll for NerdWallet determined that 35 percent of adults have brought at least some credit card debt into their romantic relationships—more than student loans, car payments, medical loans, and mortgage debt.

More men than women bring it, with 42 percent of adult men coming into relationships with credit card debt, as opposed to 29 percent of women. Whoever's behind it, though, such debt can have costs beyond interest payments: 25 percent of couples with at least one partner dealing with credit card debt reported that it had a negative impact on their relationship.

If you or a loved one begins exhibiting a number of these symptoms, consult with your doctor. Although Alzheimer's has no cure, many treatments can delay its onset and provide a meaningful quality of life for years.

- Expectations. Clarify what you expect from your colleagues in the way of information, assistance, and results. Get to know each other's goals so you can provide the right kind of support.
- Mutual trust. Can you count on each other to follow through on commitments—or at least warn that problems are approaching? This is possible only if you both take responsibility for cooperation and communication.
- Sociability. Can you do more than merely tolerate each other? Go beyond common
 courtesy and show a genuine interest in other people's lives outside the job. Relationships
 grow through getting to know each other on a personal basis instead of just talking about
 work
- Communication. This is the acid test of any working relationship: Can you tell each other what's on your mind? This isn't simply a matter of airing complaints. Delivering praise or thanks to a co-worker may feel awkward, but it's the heart of a good relationship. Be honest with the people around you, and listen to their words in the same spirit.


