

Just a Reminder from the Board of Directors:

Regulations "Occupancy by guests of the shareholder shall be for a period of time not exceeding (fifteen) consecutive days and 30 (thirty) days total per year, unless a longer period is approved, in writing, by the Board of Directors. Any visit of a guest will be terminated immediately if they fail to abide by the Association Rules and Regulations will be revoked. For those approved guests whose visits extend beyond 15 (fifteen) consecutive days or 30 (thirty) days total for the year, there will be an additional charge of \$2.00 per person per day. Use of the unit by family members is permitted, provided the shareholder notifies the office prior to arrival of the guests, assumes responsibility for water, sewer, and garbage charges and designates the length of stay. Guests must be registered upon arrival and they must agree to abide by all the rules of the Association."

Shut off water valves

If you are using the water outdoors, please remember to shut off the valve at the house instead of just turn the nozzle on the hose.

Maintenance Staff Assistance

If you identify a maintenance item around the Community, please ask someone in the office (Jane or a member of the board) to complete a work order for Lam or Jim. This allows them to track, prioritize and complete their daily work load. Thank you!

Parking Request

Thenever you, your guests, or contractors need to park out on the street, please follow Community Rules!

V• No parking on the sidewalks. Your maintenance fees pay for all repairs.

Please use common sense and do not park near or on corners or close to intersections. We
would encourage parking on the same side of the street to avoid traffic having to "zig-zag"
to get by. This causes obstructions and creates a dangerous situation for cars, golf carts
and bicycles trying to proceed by the vehicles.

Soliciting

Soliciting of any kind is not allowed in Golden Gate. If anyone comes to your door trying to sell anything, please be safe and just say no thank you; close your door and <u>call the police</u> non-emergency number (on page 2 of the Golden Gate Telephone Directory (727) 369-7864. Do not confront the solicitors. The Office was informed by a resident who was walking and saw an uncomfortable soliciting incident. He used his cell phone to call the police and report it. The police arrived in <u>3 minutes</u> and when they searched the community they found a number of people who were blanketing the entire community. They were all detained and interrogated. You are not being "mean" when you call the Police. You are protecting yourself and your Community.

Golf Cart Parking

It has been brought to the Board's attention that many unit owners are leaving their golf carts parked between units. This causes a problem for the Association's Lawn Contractor, for it impacts his ability to perform his responsibilities in a proper manner. Please refrain from parking the carts on the lawn areas, especially on Mondays, the designated day for lawn cuttings. Your cooperation is truly appreciated.

WEED PROGRAM

s most of you are aware, we have a problem with the growth of weeds during the summer months, typically May through September. The weed problem we are concerned about is in the planter boxes and the front of the homes. Even those homes that have mulch or stones in the planter boxes will have weed growth.

The board does send "friendly reminders" to alert residents as stated in rule #16..."Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. However, the general response to the friendly reminders has been less than satisfactory.

We would like to aid in solving this problem by having our maintenance staff spray weed killer in the planter boxes or in front of the home for any resident that desires to participate. There will be a \$40.00 per year fee to cover the cost of the material for spraying from May through September. If you wish to participate in this program, send a check or pay cash to Jane in the office. If you choose to participate in this program, our maintenance staff will spray, beginning in May and ending in September. However, if you have ornamental plants that could be harmed by the spraying, you will have to make other arrangements, since we will not be responsible for any damages.

If you choose not to participate, the weed issue for planters and the front of your home will continue to be your responsibility, and be subject to the terms of rule #16 concerning work done in your absence.

Light up at Night

If you are riding a bike or driving a golf car at night you should have lights on so others can see you.



- Ask to see their license and call the appropriate licensing agency Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board for a county license or for state license to verify the status and insurance.
- Ask for and verify references from past customers.
- <u>Check with the Pinellas County Consumer Protection</u>, local Chamber of Commerce and the <u>Better Business Bureau</u>.
- Get a written estimate from several licensed contractors
 Be sure that the estimate includes all work to be done by the contractor, the materials

involved, date of completion and the total cost.


- If the project is for repairing damage, check with your insurance company first to verify that your insurance will cover the repairs before you sign a contractor.
- An occupational license or business tax receipt (BTR) is not sufficient in the construction trades.
- Beware of contractors or alleged contractors who ask to be paid in cash, ask for large payments up front, or ask for you as the homeowner to pull the permit.
 After you choose a contractor:
- Make sure your contractor obtains a permit and posts it on the front of the property.
- If the contractor requests a final payment before all final inspections are completed and the permit placard has been signed by the appropriate inspectors, request that he/she obtains all final inspections prior to your final payment. However, you must abide by your contract.
- Make sure your contractor provides you with releases of liens from his subcontractors and suppliers.
 - Before signing a contract, be certain your contract includes:
- The contractors name, street address, telephone number and state or local license number.
- A precise description of the work to be completed, including a draw schedule and list of materials.
- Completion date, including cleanup after work is finished.
- Warranty agreements, including length, terms and recourse.
- A notice of consumers' rights under the Florida Homeowners' Construction Recovery Fund for contracts involving general, residential and building contractors.
- Read your contract carefully and personally fill in any blank spaces. Consider having an attorney review the contract. If you do not have an attorney the Florida Bar offers a lawyer referral services.

Beware of unlicensed contractors:

• If you are planning to build a new home, a room addition, add on a second story, begin remodeling on your home, or have work done that requires a building permit, take care to select a qualified person to perform the work. Under state and local ordinances, any person you hire under contract (verbal or written) to perform construction on your property must be a licensed contractor. The contractor must be state certified or registered. All printed advertising material such as business cards, newspaper ads and telephone book ads must show his or her state license number.



- Also, beware of people that claim that you will save quite a bit of money by not obtaining a permit. A permit will only lead to compliance with the appropriate building codes, these are only minimum requirements.
- Unlicensed contractors do not have insurance coverage. Any injury that occurs on your property will be a claim against your insurance.
- If you wish to check on the license of an individual you can call the Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board at (727) 582-3100. Additionally, you can contact the Pinellas County Building Department at 464-3888.

Chocolate may be good for your heart

In case you're looking for an excuse to eat some chocolate, consider this: It may reduce your risk of irregular heartbeat.

An analysis of some 55,000 adults from Denmark found that eating 2-6 ounces of chocolate a week was associated with a 20 percent decreased risk of atrial fibrillation, or A-fib, otherwise known as an irregular heartbeat. A-fib can compromise blood flow in the upper chambers of the heart—the atria. People with A-fib are five times more likely to suffer a stroke, according to the American Heart Association, and have twice the risk of a heart-related death.

Moderate consumption of chocolate, especially dark chocolate, appears to reduce that risk, although binging on larger amounts can obviously lead to weight gain and associated problems.

Carbon monoxide safety tips for your home

arbon monoxide (CO) is a colorless and nearly odorless gas that's created by the incomplete burning of solid, liquid, and gaseous fuels. Appliances that burn LP gas (liquefied petroleum), oil, coal, kerosene, coal or wood may produce carbon monoxide. Carbon monoxide is also poisonous to animals and people. Symptoms of its effects include:

- Headache
- Fatigue
- Shortness of breath
- Nausea
- Dizziness

To prevent CO poisoning, take these precautions:



- Buy and install a CO alarm. Make sure it is listed with Underwriters Laboratories or that there is information on the package that indicates that it meets the requirements of IAS 6-96 standards. Follow the directions for placement and installation.
 - Install appliances properly. Most of them should be installed by a professional.
- Practice good maintenance. Have your heating system (furnaces, flues, and chimneys) inspected and serviced by a professional every year.
- Burn charcoal outdoors only. Never burn it in a tent, home, garage, vehicle, etc. Don't use portable fuel-burning camping equipment indoors or inside tents, etc.
- Make sure you turn off fuel-burning engine equipment when you are inside a garage or basement. Just having the doors open does not ensure your safety.


