# From your Board of Directors

There was no Board of Directors meeting scheduled in August, 2019. Our financial report for the month of July 2019 shows that income for the month was \$38,562 with expenditures of \$27,746. The financial statement for each month is posted on the bulletin board at the rear of the hall for everyone to review.

\_\_\_\_

### Just a Reminder from the Board of Directors:

Residents should not park vehicles or golf carts that are for sale at the front gate as this does not present the best atmosphere of our community.

Additionally, there have been a few incidents where residents have had guest staying at their home over the 15 day limit without directors approval. Per Rule 5 of the Golden Gate Regulations: Guest(s) must be registered upon arrival and they must agree to abide by all rules of the Association. Occupancy by guests of the shareholder shall be for a period of time not exceeding 15 (fifteen) consecutive days and 30 (thirty) days total per year, unless a longer period is approved, in writing, by the Board of Directors. A Shareholder who has a guest approved to stay longer than 30 days will be assessed \$40.00 per month for each guest. Any visit of a guest will be terminated immediately if they fail to abide by the Association Rules and Regulations. Any permission for an approved extended guest who fails to follow the Rules and Regulation will be revoked. Use of the unit by a shareholder's family members is permitted, provided the shareholder notifies the office prior to arrival of the family members, assumes responsibility for water, sewer, and garbage charges, and designates the length of stay. Guest(s) must be registered upon arrival and they must agree to abide by all the rules of the Association.

# Shut off water valves

If you are using the water outdoors, please remember to shut off the valve at the house instead of just turn the nozzle on the hose.

If you identify a maintenance item around the Community, please ask someone in the office (Jane or a member of the board) to complete a work order for Lam. This allows them to track, prioritize and complete their daily work load. Thank you!



# **WEED PROGRAM**

s most of you are aware, we have a problem with the growth of weeds during the summer months, typically May through September. The weed problem we are concerned about is in the planter boxes and the front of the homes. Even those homes that have mulch or stones in the planter boxes will have weed growth.

\_\_\_\_

The board does send "friendly reminders" to alert residents as stated in rule #16. HOME SITES: All homes must have their house number visible on the front of the home. Each shareholder is responsible for the neat and orderly appearance of his or her premises at all times. No outside storage is permitted around or under your home. If the home is not maintained in accordance with general established standards set by the Association (i.e., in a run-down condition or is in general disrepair), the shareholder shall be subject to the provisions of Article 3 of these rules. Each shareholder is responsible for the condition of his planter boxes, fruit trees and plantings at all times. Lower branches of fruit trees must be trimmed to a minimum of 48 inches from the ground. Our Board of Directors or their appointee(s) have the authority to designate those residences which are not properly maintained. Flowers, plants, trees, and shrubs enhance the appearance of your lot but a permit is required from the Association before planting other than in planters. The Association is responsible for lawn mowing and maintaining the Association planted trees. Trash and recycle pickup will be established according to city guidelines. Residents are requested to refrain from putting garbage out at the curb the night before, unless in a secure covered receptacle, and are also requested to promptly remove any trash receptacles after pickup. The trash receptacles should not block driveways or sidewalks. Any additions or revisions to your exterior property, including outside painting of any type, must be approved by the Board of Directors and a permit obtained from the office before starting work. The permit must be displayed in a clearly visible area. No fences permitted without approval of Board of Directors. Federal and State laws allow for the installation of satellite antennas 1 meter or less in diameter, but permission from the Board of Directors must be obtained first. Only umbrella type drying lines may be used and should be set in the back of home. No clothes hanging on the carport, including swimwear. Water, sewer, and garbage pickup charges are billed to the individual shareholder by the City of Pinellas Park on a monthly basis. Shareholders are to adhere to county and city water conservation rules. Irrigation and/or other watering must be done by a handheld hose; no automated sprinklers permitted. The Association shall have the right at any time to cause the water to be individually metered at each mobile home. No new wells are permitted. No resident or guest may engage in any type of commercial business in the community. Patio or rummage sales are permitted with approval of the Board of Directors. The Association reserves the right to enforce the rules and regulations at the shareholders' expense should they not be adhered to. Residents leaving for the summer or extended periods of time should obtain a form from the office, completing each item, and returning the completed form

to the office. If a shareholder does not provide for the care of these items in his/her absence, the Association will have the work done, and the Unit will be assessed at the rate of \$25.00 per hour with a two hour (\$50.00) minimum per occurrence. There will be NO exemptions from billing for City utilities unless the home is unoccupied entire month and the sign out procedure with

the office has been completed.

# FRIENDLY REMINDER

There have been reports that individuals have not been obeying STOP signs and speed limits. The speed limit and STOP signs are posted for everyone's safety. Golden Gate Rule #9 reflects "All residents and guest must obey all local and state rules related to the operation of vehicles. The (fifteen) MPH speed limit must be observed by all residents and guest." Please remember safety first! It may take you a few seconds longer to get where you're going. However, should an accident occur it could take you a lifetime to forgive yourself.

# **Light up at Night**

If you are riding a bike or driving a golf car at night you should have lights on so others can see you.



- Ask to see their license and call the appropriate licensing agency Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board for a county license or for state license to verify the status and insurance.
- Ask for and verify references from past customers.

\_\_\_\_

- Check with the Pinellas County Consumer Protection, local Chamber of Commerce and the Better Business Bureau.
- Get a written estimate from several licensed contractors

Be sure that the estimate includes all work to be done by the contractor, the materials involved, date of completion and the total cost.

- If the project is for repairing damage, check with your insurance company first to verify that your insurance will cover the repairs before you sign a contractor.
- An occupational license or business tax receipt (BTR) is not sufficient in the construction trades.
- Beware of contractors or alleged contractors who ask to be paid in cash, ask for large payments up front, or ask for you as the homeowner to pull the permit.
   After you choose a contractor:
- Make sure your contractor obtains a permit and posts it on the front of the property.
- If the contractor requests a final payment before all final inspections are completed and the permit placard has been signed by the appropriate inspectors, request that he/she obtains all final inspections prior to your final payment. However, you must abide by your contract.
- Make sure your contractor provides you with releases of liens from his subcontractors and suppliers.
  - Before signing a contract, be certain your contract includes:
- The contractors name, street address, telephone number and state or local license number.
- A precise description of the work to be completed, including a draw schedule and list of materials.
- Completion date, including cleanup after work is finished.
- Warranty agreements, including length, terms and recourse.
- A notice of consumers' rights under the Florida Homeowners' Construction Recovery Fund for contracts involving general, residential and building contractors.
- Read your contract carefully and personally fill in any blank spaces. Consider having an attorney review the contract. If you do not have an attorney the Florida Bar offers a lawyer referral services.

Beware of unlicensed contractors:

• If you are planning to build a new home, a room addition, add on a second story, begin remodeling on your home, or have work done that requires a building permit, take care to select a qualified person to perform the work. Under state and local ordinances, any person you hire under contract (verbal or written) to perform construction on your property must be a licensed contractor. The contractor must be state certified or registered. All printed advertising material such as business cards, newspaper ads and telephone book ads must show his or her state license number.

• Beware of anyone that asks you to obtain the building permit as an "owner/builder", this may indicate that they themselves are not properly licensed to obtain the permit.

- Also, beware of people that claim that you will save quite a bit of money by not obtaining a permit. A permit will only lead to compliance with the appropriate building codes, these are only minimum requirements.
- Unlicensed contractors do not have insurance coverage. Any injury that occurs on your property will be a claim against your insurance.
- If you wish to check on the license of an individual you can call the Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board at (727) 582-3100. Additionally, you can contact the Pinellas County Building Department at 464-3888.

Contractors are required to be licensed by the Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board (PCCLB). You can verify a contractors' license complaints by calling:

# Surprising discoveries around the solar system

The solar system is full of surprises. Here are three startling new discoveries about other worlds orbiting the sun:

• The moon. A mass of metal beneath the surface of the moon's south pole has been discovered by scientists, The New York Times reports. It's under a huge, 4-billion-year-old impact crater, and it's five times bigger than Hawaii. Scientists at Baylor University speculate that it's composed of the remains of an ancient meteor that created what's known as the South Pole-Aitken—near where the Chinese Chang'e 4 lunar rover landed in January.



- Mars. Scientists have discovered a huge reservoir of water underneath the Martian north pole, the Gizmodo website reports. The water was detected inside a deposit of multiple layers of water ice mixed with sand, and it formed over hundreds of millions of years. It's about 1.2 miles beneath the north pole, and contains enough water to submerge the entire planet.
- Europa. This moon of Jupiter has long been known to have an ocean beneath its surface layer of ice—an ocean with more water than all of Earth's oceans combined. Now the Hubble Space Telescope has detected what appears to be sodium chloride— NaCl—in the seas, the Fox News website reports. Sodium chloride, which makes up ordinary table salt, is also a major ingredient in Earth's salt-water oceans—meaning that Europa may be more Earthlike than previously thought.



# **Responding to adversity**

# Search for Earthlike worlds takes a step forward

Cientists searching for Earthlike worlds beyond the solar system have a new tool: NEAR (Near Earths in the Alpha Cen Region), which began operating in May, will scan the Alpha Centauri system for habitable planets.

NEAR is a thermal coronagraph installed in a telescope in Chile that can block the light of stars and look for heat radiating from worlds in orbit. Alpha Centauri is a three-star system located 4.3 light-years away, the closest system to our world. Astronomers have already discovered planets in the system—an Earth-size planet dubbed Proxima b, orbiting the red dwarf star Proxima Centauri, and a planet candidate circling the same star.

NEAR will look at Alpha Centauri AB, a binary star system, using an upgrade to an existing instrument to block out the glare of the two stars and also compensate for the blur of Earth's own atmosphere. It's capable of spotting planets twice the size of Earth or larger.


