





Snakes in Florida

Plorida has a rich diversity of snakes and other reptiles which play an interesting and vital role in Florida's complex ecology. Our 44 species of native snakes are found in every conceivable habitat, from coastal mangroves and saltmarshes to freshwater wetlands and dry uplands, and many species thrive in residential areas. However, there are just a few species that are commonly seen in developed area, although any snake may occasionally be found in urban settings.



Snakes occupy a valuable place in Florida's ecosystem. For example, snakes help reduce rodent populations, which destroy crops and sometimes carry diseases which can infect people. Non-venomous snakes also consume venomous ones and can help maintain ecosystem balances. Venomous snakes are also beneficial; for example, some rattlesnake species have been reported to consume ticks in their native ranges.

<u>https://myfwc.com/wildlifehabitats/profiles/reptiles/snakes/red-rat-snake/</u>, The rat/corn snake is colorful, oranges, yellow and black and it is not poisonous.

Behavior - The diet of the red rat snake primarily consists of small mammals (i.e. rodents), lizards, birds, and bird eggs. This species kills its prey by constriction, as they have no toxic venom or fangs

Behavior - The Eastern indigo snake is a non-venomous, bluish-black colored snake and their diet primarily consists of a variety of species, including small mammals, birds, toads, frogs, turtles and their eggs, lizards, and small alligators (National Park Service, n.d.).

All of them, snakes or cats, have no interest in humans or pets, so just let them go on their way!

Madeira Way Renovations to Begin Monday Sept. 9th


