

These drawing games can spur your brain

rawing can spur your creativity. You don't have to be a Picasso. Just try some of these games with your friends (from the My Modern Met website):

- The Exquisite Corpse. In this game, developed by the 20th-century Surrealist artists, one person begins a drawing at the top of a sheet of paper, then folds it over or covers it up so only a bit of the bottom is showing. The next person continues the drawing, folds it down, and so on. Unfolding it to reveal the completed drawing should produce surprises, laughs, and even some ideas.
- Paper Telephone. One person writes a short, descriptive phrase on a piece of paper, then passes it to the next. He or she then draws a picture based on the phrase. The next person looks only at the picture and then writes a phrase or sentence describing it. The following person then draws a picture of that phrase, and so on. By the end, the final picture and the original phrase may have nothing to do with each other.

• Blind Contour. In this exercise you (and a partner) draw something around you, but without looking at the paper—just the subject of your drawing. Keep your pen or pencil on the paper at all times. You might be surprised at what you see.

• Scribbles. One person scribbles on a piece of paper, eyes closed. The next person has to turn that doodle into a drawing. This forces your mind to make sense of nonsense.

A simple exercise for imagination

our subconscious mind can help you exercise your imagination. Try this technique (used by Thomas Edison):

Ten minutes before you go to sleep, organize your thoughts. Think about a problem you're trying to solve, or ask your brain a question. Keep thinking about this as you drift off to dreamland. Then, during the first 10 minutes after waking up, write down whatever pops into your head. You'll often find that your brain has answered your question during your sleep. In the morning your mind is looser, and you're more likely to remember dreams and connect them to your daytime reality.

Watch these risk factors while you're driving

taying safe on the road means being aware of the risks. According to the Knowledge at Work website, these factors can increase the chance of an accident while driving:

- Driving while fatigued or sleep-deprived—six hours of sleep or less triples your risk.
- Driving long distances without taking sufficient breaks for rest.
- Driving through the night, during a midafternoon energy dip, or when you would normally be asleep.
- Driving under the influence of sedating medications like antidepressants, cold tablets, antihistamines, and the like.
- Working more than 60 hours a week. This can raise your risk by 40 percent.
- Drinking alcohol, even in small amounts.
- Driving alone.
- Driving along a long, dark, or boring road.



Mystery of the missing Martian methane

It's a mystery—what happened to the methane on Mars? Science Magazine reports that in 2004, the Martian Express orbiter detected signs of methane in Mars' atmosphere. In 2014, the Curiosity rover observed a methane spike in Gale crater that lasted several months, and a few years later Curiosity detected a small seasonal cycle of methane eruptions in the Martian northern hemisphere.

Some scientists doubted the findings. The European Space Agency sent the Trace Gas Orbiter up, arriving in the red planet's orbit in 2016. Although some issues with the readings remain to be cleared up, researchers report that they haven't found any methane at all.

What happened? No one knows, but the Trace Gas Orbiter will keep reporting data until 2022, so maybe scientists will be able to solve the mystery after all.

Exercise puts the brakes on aging, study suggests

Let's no secret that exercise keeps you healthy, but new evidence suggests that it can actually keep your body young as the years roll on. NPR reports that a recent study indicates that people in their 70s who have been exercising regularly for decades appear to have halted the aging process.

A study at the Human Performance Laboratory at Ball State University, looked at individuals in three groups. Two groups consisted of people with an average age of 75, some of whom had exercised strenuously throughout their lives and some who'd performed only mild exercise such as golfing or hiking. The third group was made up of people with an average age of 25, all of whom worked out as strenuously as their older counterparts.

Comparisons of oxygen intake, which tends to decline as people age, showed a strong similarity between the young and older high-energy exercisers. Observations of muscle health were similarly consistent.

You might not be able to go back in time and persuade your younger self to start working out, but aerobic exercise at any age can do wonders for your overall health as you age.

Sleep: Get just the right amount

etting enough sleep is essential to good health. Now it turns out that getting too much sleep may be detrimental to your health.

An article on the Medical News Today website notes that six to eight hours of sleep is considered necessary for most adults. Sleep deprivation can contribute to such chronic health problems as diabetes, cardiovascular disease, depression, and other unhealthy conditions.

However, data from more than 116,000 people participating in the Prospective Urban Rural Epidemiology (PURE) study found that people who sleep more than eight hours a night are at advanced risk of cardiovascular disease and premature death. The risk is 5 percent higher for those who slept eight to nine hours per night, the study found. For those who slept nine to 10 hours, the risk of heart and blood vessel problems rose to 17 percent, and those who reported sleeping more than 10 hours were 41 percent more likely to develop cardiovascular problems and die early.

One more reason to get a good night's sleep—but not too much sleep.

Small asteroid holds big, wet surprises

tiny asteroid 1.2 billion miles away is covered with boulders and is moister than previously was thought, NASA reports. An article on the U.S. News & WorldReport website relates that the Osiris-Rex space probe has taken orbit around Bennu, an asteroid only about three city blocks wide and weighing about 80 million tons.

Readings and photographs from Osiris-Rex show that Bennu is surprisingly studded with hundreds of small boulders across its surface. Scientists expected only a handful. Although there's no liquid water, plenty of moisture is evident in wet clay. Researchers speculate that Bennu broke off from a larger asteroid that could have contained water.

Osiris-Rex will orbit Bennu for a year, then dive close to its surface in 2010. A robotic arm will shoot puffs of nitrogen into Bennu's soil and collect grains of dirt from the asteroid; Osiris-Rex will return them to Earth in 2023.



Scientists grow artificial venom glands from snake stem cells

Ilking venomous snakes probably isn't on anyone's list of most desirable jobs. Venom is needed to create antidotes for deadly snake bites, though. Now scientists are working on a process for creating that venom in the laboratory.

The Science News website reports that researchers in the Netherlands have successfully grown copies of the glands that produce venom in snakes. The scientists dissected the eggs of Cape coral snakes and used stem cells to create different types of tissues, called organoids, that could create the venom. The team has since grown venom glands from seven or so species of snakes, which have survived in the laboratory for up to two years.

Some 2.7 million people around the world are bitten by venomous snakes each year. Many die, and many others lose limbs or suffer other disabilities. The artificial process to create antivenom could save lives and prevent lots of suffering.

Ancient plant virus dug up in Arizona

cientists have discovered a 1,000-year-old plant virus in corncobs from an Ancestral Puebloan ruin in Arizona, the Sci-News website reports. It's the oldest plant virus discovered so far.

The Ancestral Puebloans who lived at the Antelope House subsisted on planted crops of maize, squash, and beans, with maize being a major food source. Researchers excavated Antelope House in the 1970s and uncovered more than two tons of food refuse.

Recently analysis using carbon-14 found the corncobs and other refuse to be 1,000 years old. The analysis also isolated three almost complete genomes of a previously unknown RNA virus.

Dubbed ZMCV1, it's a chrysovirus, part of a family of viruses that infect plants and fungi, transmitting from generation to generation through seeds—but which cause no disease in humans and are rarely detected.

Science means constantly walking a tightrope between blind faith and curiosity; between expertise and creativity; between bias and openness; between experience and epiphany; between ambition and passion; and between arrogance and conviction—in short, between an old today and a new tomorrow.


