

Take a cold shower—for better health

howers keep you clean, but a cold shower can be good for your health. An article on the Success website spells out the benefits of taking cold showers:

- Immunity. Scientists believe there's a correlation between cold showers and increased production of an amino acid called glutathione, which boosts the immune system, gets rid of toxins, and eases stress.
- Better skin health. A hot shower removes important oils from the skin, making it dry and itchy. Cold showers reduce skin inflammation. They also prevent your hair from becoming brittle.
- Muscle recovery. There's a reason why athletes soak in ice baths after a tough game. The cold water helps speed their recovery time and relieve soreness quicker.
- Better moods. Cold showers may prevent depression, according to researchers at Virginia Commonwealth University. Decreasing the temperature of your water and then spending two or three minutes under cold water sends a lot of electrical impulses from the nerves in your skin up to your brain, which could have an anti-depressive effect.

Climate change strategy a mixed bag

cientists scrambling for a solution to the problems caused by climate change have come up with an intriguing idea: shooting tiny particles high into the atmosphere to scatter the light of the sun.

The Science magazine website reports that sulfur dioxide gas can cool down temperatures by reacting to water vapor and forming droplets that scatter sunlight. It happens during major volcanic eruptions, such as the eruption of Mount Pinatubo in the Philippines in 1991 and the eruption of El Chichon in Mexico in 1982.

Scientists have used computer modeling to project the effect of injecting light-scattering aerosols into the stratosphere.

Unfortunately, the probable results appear mixed. Although the model predicted that corn harvests would increase 6.3 percent due to reduced heat, other crop yields would fall because of diminished sunlight, and the strategy would likely have no effect on yields for crops like soybeans, rice, and wheat. Scientists continue to study the theory in hopes of finding a viable approach to managing climate change.

ow much do you spend dining out every month? Acosta and Technomic's "The Why? Behind The DineTM" survey looked at trends among different demographics. Here's what it found:

- Diners with children 17 and under spend an average of \$544 on food a month, with 38 percent spent on food prepared outside the home.
- Generation Z diners ages 18–21 spend \$360, 29 percent on food from outside.
- Millennials, ages 22–36, spend \$513, of which 40 percent is prepared outside the home.

Is it a headache—or a brain tumor?

Is that headache a sign of a serious medical problem? Maybe, but don't panic. A severe headache makes many people worry that they have a brain tumor, but according to The Cut website, the time to worry about brain tumors is when you have a headache combined with vomiting. These types of headaches come on suddenly, often at night, and feel worse when you're lying down. Over time they'll create other symptoms—numbness, weakness on one side of the body, and speech and vision difficulties.

More likely, a severe headache is either a migraine or a cluster headache. Both of these tend to appear in one side of the head. Some 36–44 million Americans suffer from migraines, which can last up to 72 hours. Cluster headaches also occur on one side of the head, and come in waves—people may have up to eight per day. They're more painful than migraines, but they're also over more quickly, lasting from 20–45 minutes.

Seek treatment, but don't worry yourself sick about brain tumors.



Doctors shortchanging patients, study says

octors are busy people—sometimes too busy. A study conducted by the University of Florida found that patients, on average, have only about 11 seconds to tell their doctors what's wrong with them before the doctor interrupts, sometimes sidetracking the interview. That may have something to do with the study's other finding—that doctors identified the patient's reason for the visit correctly only about 36 percent of the time.

The researchers offered several explanations for the situation: physician burnout, time constraints caused by the necessity of dealing with health insurance issues, and limited training in patient communication skills for physicians trained before 2004 (after that, training put more emphasis on communicating with patients).

Surprising sources of pain

The causes of pain aren't always obvious. Consider these unexpected sources:

- Back pain. Taking your vitamins? Chronic back pain can be caused by low levels of vitamin D. Another possibility: constipation caused by blockage in the colon. Eat more fruits, vegetables, and fiber for better digestion. (Source: Prevention magazine)
- Headache. Cheese may be the culprit. A substance called tyramine in cheese can trigger headaches. Also, low blood sugar can create a headache even before you realize you're hungry. A snack like whole-grain crackers with peanut butter can bring quick relief. (Source: the WebMD website)








Reading for pleasure is on the decline

Thether it's because of the internet, binge TV watching, or other factors, reading for leisure has declined in the United States over the past two decades. A survey from the Bureau of Labor Statistics found that leisure reading has dropped by more than 30 percent since 2004, when approximately 28 percent of Americans 15 and older read for pleasure on a given day. In 2017, that figure had dropped to 19 percent.

"That steep drop means that aggregate reading time among Americans has fallen from an average of 23 minutes per person per day in 2004 to 17 minutes per person per day in 2017," according to The Washington Post, which reported on the survey.

The decline is sharper among men, whose reading for pleasure dropped from 25 percent to 15 percent. Among women, leisure reading fell from 31 percent to 22 percent.



The digital divide on online shopping

nline shopping is more common than ever these days, but some people do it more than others—women, specifically. According to a survey by First Insight, men prefer shopping at physical brick-and-mortar stores, whereas women are more likely to shop via the internet.

For example, the survey found that 60 percent of women frequently shop on Amazon, but only 46 percent of men. Similarly, 40 percent of women frequently use their mobile devices to shop, but only 22 percent of men do.

The divide holds on comparison shopping online: Thirty-one percent of women will compare prices on a mobile device while in a store, but just 21 percent of men do. Sixty-seven percent of women will check product prices on Amazon before making a purchase, compared to 54 percent of men.

One area where men are in the lead? Help from artificial intelligence. The survey found that 51 percent of men will use AI to research prices, but only 46 percent of women do the same.



Sharpen your mind to learn better

s we grow older, learning and remembering new information can grow more difficult. Here are some tips to help you stay on top of the knowledge game and keep you learning as you age:

- Focus on concentrating. Distractions are the bane of any learning attempt. If you're attending a seminar or training session, for example, sit near the instructor and maintain eye contact with him or her. Try not to fidget; simply relax into the session and let your focused attention do the job.
- Say it out loud. Read aloud the material you're trying to learn and repeat out loud the facts you want to retain. This way, both your eyes and your ears are delivering information to your brain.



Busy as a bee—even when the bees are sick

Toneybees are hard workers—even when they're sick. The (e)Science News website reports that researchers using radar technology have learned that honeybees continue to seek and collect honey for their hives even when they're suffering from infections or viruses.

The scientists mounted tiny, lightweight transponders to bees' thoraxes, enabling them to track individual bees using a radar signal. Studying the flight paths of 78 bees, the researchers found that although the sick bees didn't fly as far or as long as their healthy counterparts, they continued their search, suggesting that bees are hardwired to seek and procure honey even when they're ill.

Copper bracelet suggests vast ancient trade network

n ancient copper band unearthed with cremated human remains in Georgia suggests that Native Americans may have traded across greater distances than previously was thought, according to the EurekAlert website. The band, a little wider than a bracelet, came from the Great Lakes region some 1,500 miles away. Scientists were able to determine the band's origin because copper sources have a unique chemical makeup.

The fact that the Native Americans were cremated is also significant, because cremation was unknown in the Southeast United States during the time period the bracelet dates from—some 3,500 years ago—but was commonly practiced in the Great Lakes region and other northern regions. This suggests that our ancient ancestors may have had connections across large distances, allowing for wide trading networks across North America.

The question is one of judgment. For the distinguishing element of science is not intelligence but judgment. Or perhaps it is simply luck.
