#### Hillcrest Manager's Corner - March 2017

#### HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY!!

St. Patrick's Day celebrates the Roman Catholic feast day of the patron saint of Ireland. St. Patrick died on March 17, 641. But did you know that he wasn't even Irish?

#### **History:**

Patrick's birth name was Maewyn. He was born in Roman Britain. He was kidnapped into slavery and brought to Ireland. He escaped to a monastery in Gaul (France) and converted to Christianity. He went back to Ireland in 432 as a missionary. While Christianity had already taken hold in the country, tradition has it that Patrick confronted the Druids at Tara and abolished their pagan rites, making Christianity more widespread.

Patrick became a bishop and after his death was named Ireland's patron saint.. Celebrations in Ireland were understated though. When the Irish emigrated to the U.S., they created the bigger celebrations and parades known today. Eighteenth century Irish soldiers who fought in the Revolutionary War held the first St. Patrick Day parades. The celebrations became a way for the Irish to connect with their roots after they moved to America.

#### Trash, Appliances, Yard & Landscaping Debris

If you do landscaping in your yard, please ensure that any shrubs or trees are no longer than 3 feet in length and bundled up for our maintenance men on Monday and Friday ONLY. If anything is left loose or longer than 3 feet, or if it is set out on a day other than Monday or Friday, it will be your responsibility to dispose of the debris into the large dumpster next to the maintenance building. DO NOT put these into our regular trash dumpster. This has become a problem in the past. Also, please ensure that you throw them INTO the dumpster and not around it or in front of the gate. If you need for us to leave the large dumpster open after hours or over

the weekend, please let the office know and we will make arrangements to leave it open for you. Just lock it up when you are done.

Also, only regular household trash is to go into the "Trash Only" dumpsters. No large items allowed in the smaller dumpsters. It takes up too much space and our dumpsters begin to overflow. Larger items also need to go into the large dumpster next to the maintenance building.

For Appliances - If you have appliances you wish to dispose of, contact the office and we will schedule a hauling company to come out to take your appliance. Please only set it out on the day it is to be removed.

Just a Reminder - Trash days are Monday and Friday. Kindly have your closed, tied-up bags by the curb by 8:00 a.m. on these days. Do not leave any loose rubbish out. You will be responsible for disposing of your own loose trash. You will also be responsible to dispose of your own trash if you miss our morning pick-up. Our maintenance men have other duties after rubbish patrol that they need to attend to.

#### **Homeowners Association Annual Meeting**

The annual meeting of Hillcrest Resident's Inc., the homeowners association was held on Monday, February 6, 2017. The minutes from 2016 were read and accepted as was the treasurers report. Barb Connors term was up and she chose not to run again. Ken Foster had indicated an interest in serving on the board and was elected by acclimation. Welcome aboard Ken.

A review of old business included the completion of the library, a big thank you to Robert Strag and Dick Rankin for their efforts in acquiring the second stove. And special thanks to Butch Goodridge for his efforts in locating a replacement part for the old stove. Unfortunately the old stove had already been traded for the new. A review of Ameripride and the progress they have made. An effort will be undertaken to assure that once we are back to weekly mowing they continue to perform satisfactorily. The complaint procedure was reviewed. See the article on filing a complaint. The office has said this year their goal is to respond in writing to every written complaint.

New business that was presented included the postponement of the clubhouse remodel. The shuffleboard courts are to be done, and there will be additional streets paved.

An open session followed the agenda items and concerns from the residents were listed and will be brought up at the next scheduled meeting with Leslie. Among items of concern are the number of feral cats, the shape of the clubhouse laundry drying area, the number of cars per residence and being parked on grass and empty lots, and children living in the park.

#### **Procedure for Filing A Complaint**

Once again this was reviewed at the annual homeowners meeting. Now e will print this so everyone can follow the same procedure. When you have a complaint you must put it in writing and sign the complaint form. If you do not do this then all you did was rant at the manager and NOTHING will get done. Complaint forms are available in the office, but you may also email your complaint. This year Leslie has said that she will be answering in writing what action has been taken on the complaint. This is the first time any manager has attempted to keep the residents informed about the complaint once it is turned in.

First, if your complaint is about a neighbor, you might try discussing your concern with that neighbor. Maybe their music is too loud and you can't hear your own TV, or loud TV's late in the evening or whatever non-earth shattering event it might be talk to them first. If that doesn't work and your complaint is about a rules violation then you need to write up the complaint, stating what your complaint is, when it occurred and what action you want management to take. You should also put on your complaint the following: "The courtesy of a reply by five (5) business days would be appreciated." If the complaint is about the manager then this step is skipped, go directly to step 2, and also send a copy to the manager. Her email is hillcrestflorida\_mgr@ equitylifestyle.com.

Step 2 would be to send a copy of your concern to the regional manager, Joey Oxford, with a copy of the first step attached and again give a reasonable date (no less than 5 business days)

by which you expect an answer. His email is joseph oxford@equitylifestyle.com. If after the date given you have not received a response, then it's on to Step 3.

Step 3 would be to send the concern to the Vice President of our area, sending along copies of the previous paperwork. Once again you request a response in no less than 5 business days. The Vice President for our area is Dawn Rumpf and her email is dawn rumpf@equitylifestyle.com.

The address for the local VP's office is 5100 W. Lemon St., Suite 109, Tampa, FI 33609. The fax number is 813-289-7628.

If the problem is still not resolved the next step is to send the information in the three previous steps by registered letter to Eric Zimmerman. Once again ask for a response in the 5 business days. By send the letter registered mail, there can be no dispute of the office having received the document. Emails will do the same thing, proof the complaint was sent and received and providing a "paper' trail and an accurate account.

Be aware that no action will be taken regarding frivolous complaints.

Finally, your complaints should go to the manager first. A copy to the HOA board would be helpful so that we could follow up and try to ensure resolution.



### Ancient gold belt dug up in U.K.

rcheologists in the U.K. have dug up a 3,000-year-old gold belt in Cambridgeshire, and it's now on display at the British Museum in London.

The object, known as a torc, is the largest ever unearthed. Torcs were usually worn around the neck, but this one measures 49.6 inches, suggesting it was worn as a belt between 1300 and 1100 B.C., or that it was worn by a sacred animal slated for sacrifice. The torc, made of 20 karat gold, weighs 1.6 pounds.

British scientists examining the artifact have found little sign of use or wear on the links used to fasten the torc together, so its original function remains a mystery.

### Astronomers discover the sky's smallest asteroid

he universe is full of objects large and small: Sharp-eyed astronomers have recently discovered a near-Earth asteroid just 6 feet in diameter.

The asteroid, named 2015 TC25, was discovered in October 2015 by scientists working with the Catalina Sky Survey. It's one of the brightest of its kind ever observed, reflecting about 60 percent of the sunlight that hits it, and it's one of the fastest spinning. Astronomers speculate 2015 TC25 was chipped off another asteroid, (44) Nysa, a large bright object in the main asteroid belt that's about 44 miles in diameter.

The small rock is about the size of many meteorites that fall to Earth, but astronomers believe there's little likelihood of 2015 TC25 dropping on our planet very soon.

#### New light on our oldest ancestor, Lucy

The remains of "Lucy," the name given to the oldest human ancestor yet discovered, were found 42 years ago, and ever since scientists have debated whether she spent most of her time walking on the ground or climbing through the trees. The journal PLOS One reports that new evidence suggests the three-million-year-old woman had muscular arms, indicating that she may have been have been a tree dweller, at least some of the time.



A CT analysis of Lucy's fossilized skeleton shows that her arms were heavily built and similar to those of chimpanzees. Scientists speculate that Lucy may have slept up in the trees to avoid predators at night, spending as much of one-third of her life above the ground. The fact that Lucy may have died from falling out of a tree adds weight to the theory.



#### Fresh or frozen? The choice is yours

om may tell you over and over again to eat fruits and vegetables that are fresh, but nutrition experts say that frozen produce isn't necessarily inferior. According to *The New York Times*, most nutrients are surprisingly hardy: Iron, for example, stands up to freezing quite well, and fiber does its job whether it's frozen or fresh.

Scientists at the University of California-Davis analyzed the vitamin content in several different varieties of fresh and frozen produce, including blueberries, broccoli, carrots, spinach, and strawberries. They found no significant differences between fresh and frozen items, and even discovered that frozen broccoli contains more riboflavin—a B

vitamin—than the fresh selection. Similarly, frozen blueberries have more vitamin C than fresh.

Experts recommend looking for produce frozen using the IQF process—individually quick frozen"—for the highest quality.

#### Watch for these sources of illness while traveling

Traveling has enough hassles—check-in lines, lost luggage, bad airline food—without adding germs to the mix. Be safe by watching out for these common sources of germs and bacteria that can make you sick when you travel (from the CNN website):

• Washroom stall locks. In one test, airport stall locks were found to have an average of 70 colony-forming units (CFUs) per square inch. Use soap and water or a good hand sanitizer after touching them.

• Seatbelt buckles. Clean your hands after buckling up. Airplane belt buckles can have up to 230 CFUs per square inch.

• Lavatory flush buttons. These can get pretty nasty, containing 265 CFUs per square inch (although overhead vents and tray tables have more).

• Drinking fountains. Thirsty? Maybe buy a bottle of water instead. The buttons on airport drinking fountains have been found to hold 1,240 CFUs per square inch.

#### Keep your home safe with these tips

our home is your castle, but you don't have a moat to protect it from intruders. Burglars are always looking for vulnerable targets, so be careful of these flaws that they can too easily exploit:

- Alarm panels. If you have a home security system, don't place the panel where it's visible through a door or window. Burglars can peer inside to check whether the system is armed, and if it isn't, they'll be tempted to break in.
- Motion sensors. Be sure to place a motion detector near the window of your master bath. It's a favorite spot for burglars to enter, and it's usually right next to the main bedroom—where you probably keep most of your valuables.
- Audible alarms. An audible alarm will make most intruders hesitate. Even if they continue to break in, that short pause will cut down on the time they're willing to spend in a house and risk getting caught. Plus, neighbors will be more likely to call police if they hear an alarm.

### Sahara Desert wasn't always a desert

The Sahara Desert is a dry, waterless, dusty place, as seen in countless photos and movies. But it wasn't always a sandy, desolate wasteland. Some 6,000 years, the Sahara was covered in grassland and received significant amounts of rainfall. So what happened?

According to the Science Daily website, scientists think the dramatic shift in climate was caused by the Hadley circulation, a tropical atmospheric phenomenon that rises near the equator. Related to the subtropical trade winds and tropical rainbelts, it can influence the position of severe storms, hurricanes, and the jet stream. When it lowers on the subtropics, it can create desert-like conditions. Most of the world's arid regions are located in areas beneath the descending parts of the Hadley circulation.

The scientists' findings indicate that rainfall can migrate from one part of the world to another even though the Hadley circulation doesn't. Their observations may be useful in predicting future climate changes related to El Niño and La Niña, which can cool or warm waters in the Pacific Ocean and influence weather patterns around the globe.
