The date of Decoration Day, as he called it, was chosen because it wasn't the anniversary of any particular battle.

Macadamia Key Lime Pie

cup crushed shortbread cookies
 cup finely chopped macadamia nuts
 cup sugar
 cup butter, melted

FILLING

1 - 8 oz. package cream cheese, softened
1 - 14 oz. can sweetened condensed milk
1/2 cup key lime juice or lime juice
1 cup heavy whipping cream
1/4 cup coarsely chopped macadamia nuts

- Lime peel optional
- 1. In small bowl mix cookie crumbs, Macadamia nuts and sugar. Stir in butter, press into bottom and sides of greased 9-inch pie place. Refrigerate 30 minutes.
- 2. In large bowl beat cream cheese until smooth. Beat in milk and lime juice until blended. Transfer to crust. Refrigerate covered at least 4 hours.
- 3. In small bowl beat cream until soft peaks form. Spoon or pipe onto pie. Top with macadamia nuts and if desired, lime peel.

Hurricane Season

s just around the corner. Are you prepared? Purchase a few items each week to supply your emergency supplies. Check your flashlights and replace batteries as needed. Be sure to have spare batteries on hand. WATER - 1 gallon of water per person per day. Plan on a 3 day minimum. Another 2 qts per person per day is needed for food preparation and sanitation. If a storm is imminent fill containers of water and keep in the bathroom to flush toilets. Keep plastic milk containers and clean them out, fill with water and freeze, this will keep your food refrigerated if the power goes out. FOOD: Maintain 3-7 days of food for each member of the family - this needs to include pet food for the fur babies. Food in individual containers works best. Other good options include peanut butter, fried fruit, soda, ready to eat meats, fruits and vegetables. High energy foods like granola bars, trail mix, and crackers. Also fresh vegetables that do not need refrigeration. Breads, comfort foods like candy, chips, sweetened cereal, coffee & tea.

INCIDENTALS: Paper plates, cups and utensils. Non-electric can opener. Aluminum foil and vitamins. You will need trash bags, have a tarp on hand, toilet paper, handi-wipes, sanitizer lotion, personal hygiene items. Assemble a first aid kit with the appropriate supplies. Have one for the house and one for each ear.

OTHER IMPORTANT STUFF: Especially if you are ordered to evacuate. Bedding supplies, clothes, sunglasses, lawn chair. Remember to pack something to keep you occupied, books, regular books, games, cards. Cash money, if the power is out the ATM"s won't work. Non-electric clock, paper & pencil. Needle & thread, & citronella candles.

DO NOT FORGET TO CHECK YOUR MEDICATION SUPPLY AND HAVE WHAT YOU WILL NEED ON HAND.

JUST BEFOIRE THE STORM HITS: All items in your garden and on your carport must be secured. Not just put in a pile but in your shed or home. These loose items can become missiles and damage a home, or a person or car. If you are not on property when a storm hits, be sure you have a local person available to do this chore for you. If you are seasonal resident then these items should already be secured. You are not supposed to leave any items on your carports or in your gardens when you are not here. We get some very severe thunderstorms and tornadoes are always a possibility and as already stated these items have become

Many hotels in the area will allow you to make reservations in case of storms in advance. Know where the shelters are - Oak Grove Middle School has traditionally been our local shelter.

THE CLEAN UP: After the storm there is clean up, even if you did everything right. So be sure to have a bucket, broom, mop, hammer & nails, tarps, shovel & rake. Trash bags, pruning shears if you have shrubs.

JUST A REMINDER THAT IF THE PARK IS ORDERED TO EVACUATE, AND YOU DON'T, YOU ARE ON YOUR OWN. NO ONE WILL COME TO YOUR RESCUE.



Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis

Eating more fish may help prevent Alzheimer's

Izheimer's, a disease that afflicts some 5.1 million Americans, is a type of dementia that affects a person's memory, thinking, and behavior. Although at this point no cure exists, you can take measures to reduce your chances of suffering from this debilitating condition.

New evidence suggests that eating more fish—as long as it's not fried—may help to protect your brain from the shrinkage and decline associated with Alzheimer's. Researchers from the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center tracked the diets of 260 people with normal cognitive



function for more than 10 years. Using magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), they measured the brain volume and function of each participant at the beginning of the study, and again at the end. The results: The 163 subjects who ate fish on a weekly basis (the majority consuming it one to four times a week) had a larger orbital frontal cortex and hippocampus (two areas of the brain that are known to shrink in Alzheimer's patients) and better memory function that those who ate less fish.

The researchers determined that the risk for Alzheimer's and mild cognitive impairment was lowered fivefold within the five years following the brain scans. So start eating more fish today.

Follow this 'Golden Rule' to reduce cancer risk

ant to cut your risk of developing cancer? Check the color of your food—particularly your toast and potatoes. Scientists in the United Kingdom day that cooking those two items too long can increase levels of a naturally occurring chemical called acrylamide, which has been linked to cancer in rats.

Acrylamide is formed when starchy foods like potatoes and root vegetables are cooked at over 120 degrees. To reduce it in your foods, follow these guidelines:

- **Cook until golden.** Whether you're making toast, roasting potatoes, or baking vegetables, cook until the food is gold-colored, not brown.
- Check the instructions. Follow instructions for baking or frying packaged vegetables like fries or parsnips.
- Keep raw potatoes fresh. Don't put them in the refrigerator if you're going to roast or fry them. Colder temperatures can increase acrylamide levels.











Leading by example

Bill Gates, co-founder of Microsoft, has his own private jet now, but he didn't always. On the Business Insider website, former senior vice president Brad Silverberg recalls that in the 1990s, all Microsoft employees were required to travel by commercial airline—in coach, despite the fact that by that time Microsoft was a thriving organization. On one flight from Seattle to New York, Silverberg flew with Gates and some other members of the Windows team:

"And there was Bill, sitting in coach, in a middle seat. It didn't matter to him; he spent the whole flight reading. He wasn't as universally recognized then so it wasn't such an issue for him to fly commercial. It made a big impression on me, a new Microsoft employee, seeing Bill lead by example."
