Resident Objection Forms – If you have a complaint, please complete a resident objection form and return to us in the office or drop in the night drop. Please allow two weeks for review and action if any is deemed necessary. Please remember that these forms are for use regarding rules and regulations violated as outlined by our community rules and regulations, we can only take action against these violations. If you do not have a copy of the rules and regulations please contact the office and we will be happy to provide you with one. Resident objection forms can be found in the clubhouse. These forms must be signs and dated; if all information is not included the form will not be reviewed and will be discarded. We in the office are spending entirely too much time answering phone calls and talking with residents visiting the office to voice complaints. You MUST complete a resident objection form for your complaint to be reviewed and the complaint must be a violation of the community rules and regulations. These forms can also be used to give someone notice for something well done or to report a problem with community property such as a broken toilet paper holder or a stuck door. Networking for Progress

There is an organization in Florida call Networking for Progress that is made up of representatives from ELS mobile home parks and corporate ELS. They discuss and try to bring resolution to many common concerns. Of course the individual park prospectus, lease, rules and regulations and bylaws take priority over any situation. With that being said, the following are items currently under discussion and some with resolutions.

There is now an agreement in place for the HOA (Homeowners Association) to request to perform work. There is now an application to perform this work. In the past we have volunteered to deal with the back wall (before the mold was this big a problem) and we offered to build the closet in the hall (providing Hillcrest supplied the materials). In place now is a procedure for specifically addressing who owns items purchased by the HOA for the benefit of the community and who has the obligation of replacing it in the future, and the quality of that replacement.

Management Discretion/Special Exceptions. This privilege is to be used sparingly. ELS has agreed to write a policy addressing this privilege. This discussion is ongoing so I wouldn't expect to see any changes just yet. Do be aware however, that in the future you may NOT get what you want if there must be an exception to a rule. This would cover such things as fences, improperly installed storage sheds, additions to carports without proper permits from the city, etc.

ELS Complaint Procedure

There is a procedure in place for resolving problems. The complaint procedure, also called the Nelson Procedure after the person who came up with this plan.

FIRST: COMMUNITY MANAGER

Put the concern in writing, including a fair date (no less than 5 business days) of when you expect an answer. You could put on your form the following: "The courtesy of a reply by _____(5 business days) would be appreciated."

If the complaint concerns the Community Manager, proceed to Step 2 after discussing the problem with the manager. A copy of the complaint should be sent to the manager.

STEP 2. REGIONAL MANAGER

Send a copy of your concern to your regional manager, with a copy of the first step attached and again give a reasonable date (no less than five business days) by which you expect an answer.

STEP 3. VICE PRESIDENT

Send the concern on to the Vice President for your area, along with the copies sent in Step One and Two. Again give no less than 5 business days for a response.

cated in Step 3 communication, move to Step 4.

STEP 4: ERIC ZIMMERMAN

Send copies of all of the above steps by registered letter to Eric Zimmerman. Once again ask for the 5 business day period for a response. This should be by registered letter so there is no argument as to whether the complaint was received or not. An email will accomplish the same goals and provide a paper trail and an accurate account.

ELS recommends that the first point of contact should be directly from an individual resident to the community manager. As stated in Step One this complaint must be in writing. Sitting and discussing it with the community manager is just a gab session. It is recommended by the Hillcrest HOA that you give a copy of the complaint to the HOA so we can help follow up.

One final thing from ELS. **No action will be taken regarding frivolous complaints**. No definition or example given of a frivolous complaint.



Moo! Cows may be smarter than you think

That's the smartest animal you can think of? Dolphins and chimpanzees may spring to mind quickly, but don't neglect one often-overlooked farm animal: the cow.

College students at the University of Sydney (as reported by the Huffington Post) conducted experiments with dairy cows and found that our bovine friends are capable of quickly mastering a maze to find food, and thus may possess better problem-solving skills than previously known.

The cows were tested in a T-shaped maze similar to those used with mice and rats. They learned to follow a sound through the maze to get to their food, with one of them reaching its goals within the first 20 seconds of the test.

The results suggest that cattle farmers could train cows to obey specific sound signals to come in for milking, producing greater efficiency on dairy farms.

Global warming, not Ice Age, may have killed mammoths

iant wooly mammoths roamed the Earth until about 11,000 years ago, when they abruptly went extinct. For years, scientists theorized that they were killed by the cold temperatures of the last Ice Age. Now some believe the explanation is just the opposition. The extinction event was caused by a gudden warming event known.

According to research published in the journal Science, DNA studies of ancient animals point to the sudden extinction of many large species in past ages. As more DNA from fossils became available, and carbon dating methods improved, scientists discovered that the wipeouts didn't correspond to the rise of glaciers and cold weather, but rather to periods of rapid global warming.

Early humans also contributed to the demise of the mammoths and other large beasts, but the evidence suggests that climate change was a major factor in their extinction—raising concerns about the future of our present environment.

Plying may be the fastest and safest way to travel, but we all have our own preferences and quirks when traveling by air. A survey of more than 1,100 family travelers by ExpertFlyer looked at passenger habits. Their findings included:



- Airline choice. United? American? Southwest? Forty-five percent of participants said that airline mile redemption was a factor in choosing which airline to fly on.
- Storage space. Space is at a premium on most airplanes. Seventy-five percent admitted to "stealing" overhead bin space beyond their authorized allotment.
- Food. In-flight meals aren't the only option if you're hungry. More than one-third of passengers said they bring their own food to eat during flight.
- Complaints. Flying can be stressful. The top complaint: A bad seat or a seat not near companions (35 percent), followed by delays (25 percent), and general discomfort (24 percent).
- Worries. Lost luggage is one thing, but 21 percent of survey participants said that terrorism is their biggest concern when traveling with their families. That was followed by getting lost or separated (19 percent) and crime (19 percent).

Coffee is somewhat more popular with the older generation, with 74 percent of people 55 or older drinking it daily, a habit shared by just 50 percent of the 18-34 crowd. And Caucasians drink more than African-Americans—67 percent to 59 percent.

- Use fresh cups. Don't drink from reusable glasses and cups. Stick with your own water bottle, or plastic disposable cups wrapped in plastic.


Don't sabotage your diet during the long afternoon

Mice controlled with new brain implants

Prain control seems to be a reality—in mice, at least. Scientists at the Washington University School of Medicine and the University of Illinois have developed a tiny implant, thinner than a human hair, that allows them to control the movements of mice.

Previous attempts involving photostimulation through fiberoptic cables or drug injection through metal tubes required surgery and damaged brain tissues. The new technique uses a small device mounted to the head of a mouse and powered by a battery. The device delivers drugs from small reservoirs to the mouse's brain. In one test, a mouse was made to walk in circles after its brain was injected with a chemical that mimics morphine.

In another set of experiments, scientists modified mice brains to make them sensitive to light and stimulated brain cells with tiny LEDs. The mice were kept on one side of a cage by flashing light pulses on specific brain cells.

Scientists and physicians hope that the experiments will lead to more minimally invasive procedures to treat humans suffering from stress, depression, addiction, and pain.



Lasers become even more powerful

The most powerful laser beam yet developed is at Osaka University in Japan, according to the Fortune magazine website. In July, researchers fired a beam for one-trillionth of a second containing energy equivalent to 1,000 times the amount of electricity consumed by the entire world—2 quadrillion watts.

The beam was generated using a device called a Laser for Fast Ignition experiments (LFEX), which amplifies laser energy with four specialized devices inside the laser. Scientists hope to increase its output to 10 petawatts (10 quadrillion watts) in the near future.

 - Kidney failure. High blood pressure can also caused narrowing of arteries in the kidney, inhibiting their ability to filter blood and regulate hormones and fluids in your body. Ultimately, kidneys can shut down if the arteries grow blocked.
 - Vision loss. In the eyes, hypertension can cause bleeding, as well as swelling of the optic nerve—both of which can damage your eyesight.
