Please note the following, the office received a few complaints from owners who have dollar weeds, we contacted Trugreen which is our fertilization vendor and they supplied us with the following information:- As per Pinellas County, FL. Code of Ordinances Sec. 58-478 – Fertilizer-free zones. "Fertilizer shall not be applied within ten feet from the top of bank of any surface water, landward edge of the top of a seawall, designated wetland or wetland as defined by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Chapter 62-340, Florida Administrative Code, as it may be amended or superseded)".

However, if a Shareholder wishes to use a good product on their grass area, between Trugreen's monthly visit they are recommending a good product called Ortho B Gone. It can be purchased at both Home Depot and Lowe's stores.

Please DO NOT drop-off old tools and equipment like ladders, hand trucks, etc. to our maintenance area unless you inform the office and get the Board's approval to do so.
