



TRIP OF A LIFETIME

Te will start off by stating that "We live in the Best Country in the World, U.S.A.". I include our Canadian neighbors. Our adventure started on Wed. Feb.26,2015 leaving from Ft. Lauderdale Airport to Houston to Beijing to Hong Kong. Once in Hong Kong we spent a day taking a ride on one of the highest Ferris Wheels in the world on the Kowloon side of the river. In the evening we visited shops, had dinner and viewed "The Symphony of Lights Show" at the Hong Kong Harbor. We boarded the Celebrity Millennium ship on Sun. March 1st to return to Hong Kong on the 13th when we would start a 4 day land tour of Beijing. We lost a day when crossing the International Date Line. From this point on we never were really sure what the date or day was until we got back to the U.S.A. We also had a time zone change in between which didn't help matters. We just followed the tour guide. It wasn't that bad but we had to keep up with it.

We set sail for two days to Taiwan where we visited three different ports before cruising for another 1 1/2 days to Vietnam. We visited the Ho-Chi-Min Zoo (Saigon), Unification Center, National Museum, the country side full of rice fields and family, and enjoyed seeing the locals as they went about their daily business. Saw lot of mo-peds and motor scooter type vehicles which have the right-of-way. It is not odd to see three people on a motor scooter, we saw a few with four and one with a mom and dad with three little ones just cruising along. If nature calls, feel free to stop by the road side and do what needs to be done. Three different ports in Vietnam included Saigon, Da Nang and Ha Long. This was over the course of 6 1/2 days or so including some travel days. Then another 1 1/2 days back to Hong Kong. Not sure of the timing but we did get back to Hong Kong on the 13th. Sites visited are Victoria Peak, Stanley Market, Deep Water Bay, Aberdeen for a ride on a sampan amongst floating villages, back alleys of Kowloon, Jade Market, Bird Garden, and the Wong Tai Sin Temple.

In Beijing we visited Tiananmen Square, had a Peking Duck dinner, Great Wall of China Mutianyu section, Hutong Lanes/ Old Beijing where we met with a local family, Temple of Heaven/Tiantan Park, ForbiddenCity/Palace Museum, Summer Palace, enjoyed a Noodle lunch,

and finished up with some last minute shopping at the popular Hongqiao Pearl Market. I believe I spelled everything correctly, but who would know the difference.

I'm sure I missed a lot. The people were friendly and love to have their picture taken with a westerner, I think because we look funny. All and all it was a once in a life time trip. Our next trip is on schedule for the U.S.A. simply because Nancy and I always said there is so much to see in our own country. We know God doesn't want us to miss it.

A Honeymoon Park Bread Club

s there anything that smells quite as good as homemade bread baking in the oven? Whether it's honey oatmeal sandwich bread or buttermilk biscuits, Swedish limpa rye or Greek pita bread—it all smells divine!

Making your own bread from scratch is cheaper, more delicious, and easier than you think! Instead of paying \$4 for a loaf of crusty French bread, you can make two loaves for less than \$1, or bake a dozen soft golden dinner rolls for less than 85 cents. And if you need a hostess, holiday or birthday present for the person who has everything, everyone loves receiving a special gift of homemade bread.

I was nine when I started making yeast breads in 4-H and I've been at it ever since then. A few years ago, I joined a bread club in Minnesota whose members were mostly just regular folks--men and women with a passion for making bread--but membership also includes a handful of professional bakers who are willing to share their knowledge and insights. I've learned so much and made many types of bread that I would have never tried otherwise and I've had a fabulous time

If a few people at Honeymoon Park are interested, I'll start a bread club here next fall. My plan is to begin in October and meet once (or twice) a month in the rec center to learn from each other with discussions, demonstrations, and participation with recipes, ingredients, and methods, and then bake our breads in the ovens there. I would be happy to lead discussions and do demonstrations, and anyone with a specialty bread that they make can teach the rest of us the ins-and-outs of recipe success.

Club membership will be open to everyone and there will be no dues, no officers, no minutes of the last meeting—just fun and learning and good bread.





Communication..."the eyes and ears of law enforcement" by the Reporting of Suspicious Activity.

Members participate in crime prevention by knowing what to report and how to report it. Don't worry about "bothering" the Sheriff's Office, or being embarrassed if your suspicions prove unfounded.

What is suspicious activity?

Suspicious activity is any event that seems out of the ordinary, or may be the precursor to criminal activity. The resident knows better than anyone else what is normal for your neighborhood.

What are some common examples of suspicious activity?

A stranger loitering in your neighborhood; strangers knocking on doors or soliciting; a vehicle cruising the streets repeatedly; someone peering into cars or windows; strange odors coming from a building; open or broken doors or windows at an unoccupied residence; gunshots; screaming; fighting; etc.

How to report suspicious Activity? Pinellas Sheriff's Office (non emergency call) 727-582-6200

The resident should be prepared to answer a series of questions so the dispatcher can determine the nature and priority of the call. The resident should be prepared for questions similar to the following:

- Location of the activity? an exact address or cross street ensures the deputy's response is timely.
- Description of the individual(s)? suspicious persons could include race, sex, age, height, weight, hair, clothing, complexion, speech, distinguishing features, etc.
- Description of the vehicle(s)? the license plate (tag), color, make, vintage, distinguishing features, etc.
- What is suspicious about the person(s) or vehicle(s)? Many residents feel uncomfortable or are unable to articulate the purpose of their call. Explain the facts accurately of what was observed. Let the dispatcher decide the nature of the call.
- Do you want to be contacted by the deputy responding to the area? Residents are not obligated to leave their name. However, the Sheriff's Office would prefer to be able to contact the resident observer if further information may be helpful. Residents may request that the deputy contact them following resolution of the concern.

Residents are reminded to avoid any form of confrontation relating to suspicious activities. Your job is to observe and report only.

P.S. When you see the Sheriff in the Park, give a big wave and a thank you. After all.... Honeymoon Park Matters, You Matter, Getting Involved Matters.
