Spotlight on John & Bella Lukach

n many occasions, I have seen this good-looking couple participating in events in the clubhouse. They seem to always be smiling and they just exude happiness. I have often wondered about them, so decided I should make an appointment and interview them. I knew I wanted to be friends



I was greeted with delicious cake and ice cream and a nice cup of hot tea. What a "welcome" and a surprise. That was such a nice way to get acquainted. We had some general chit chat while eating, and then I began my usual asking about their lives.

John's parents moved to Northern Ontario, Canada from Ukraine. John was born in Kapuskasing in a log cabin. He was the youngest of five boys and one girl. He had all his schooling there and after high school he worked at a paper mill for about six years. He later moved to Montreal where he worked for Mayflower moving. Then he was hired at Atlas Alloy where he had

a great career and could retire after twenty years with a good pension and great benefits.

Bella was one of five girls and 1 boy-just the opposite of John being one of five boys and one girl. When she was eight years old, her family moved to Sudbury, Ontario. At the end of the eighth grade, she quit school as she wanted to go to business school and take bookkeeping and typing. She was very mature and apparently looked older than her age, so she had no problem finding work. She worked in the office for a dairy, later trained for office manager. She was only fifteen years old and could not be bonded until she was sixteen. The boss was flabbergasted when he found out how young she was, but held off bonding her until she was sixteen as she was such a good employee.

At seventeen Bella married and had three sons. She was a housewife and mother for about ten years. She and her husband and sons moved to

Kapuskasing, and Bella's husband went to work at the mill where John worked. After a while Bella opened a confectionary store. John happened to be one of their first customers and became friends with them.

After thirty years of marriage, Bella's husband passed away. About three years later, and after being alone, Bella contacted John, who had never been married, and she invited him to a show. He accepted and the rest is history. They have been happily married for twenty-three years. John has no children and never really wanted any. He didn't think he had the patience to deal with screaming and crying kids. Bella's children were grown so no problem with that. She has five grandchildren consisting of four boys and one girl. Three of them live in Winnipeg and two are in Ottawa.

Bella worked for a pharmacist as a bookkeeper in Kapuskasing for ten years when she and John married. Later she quit and they moved to Montreal, and they lived there five years and John retired. They lived in Winnipeg, Manitoba. Bella's pharmacist friend bought another pharmacy in Ottawa, Ontario and she helped him and his wife set up an office there. Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.



Spotlight on Sherry Bartmanski & Alex Lozecki. Lot # 102

Thave admired the pristine looking home of Sherry and Alex for several years. In the mid 90's Alex was here for a conference, and when he drove across the Courtney Campbell Causeway (Hwy 60) he just fell in love with the area. A few years ago, he and Sherry stayed at Indian Shores and loved the beaches. Several friends of theirs took them around to ten or twelve parks. One day as they drove into Island in the Sun Community and stopped in the office. Darcy, the saleslady at the time, drove them around on the golf cart showing them homes available. Alex asked to see this one and eventually his offer was accepted and they purchased the home.

They have completely remodeled everything from beautiful flooring to a roof over and lanai. The walls are now all sheet rock, updated electrical, all new bathrooms, new lighting, etc. They have pretty much



done everything except replace kitchen cabinets. They looked fine, so he left them alone. They have some Florida touches like a beautiful, large painting that you see upon entering the home. Alex is quite a handyman and they have done a lot of work themselves. Sherry helped with the demolition, painting and chose colors, decorations, and furniture.

Alex has an older brother and a sister, who is now deceased. He was born and grew up in Hamilton, Ontario, Canada. He boasted that he was the baby in the family and truly a "mamma's boy" and he had a big smile when he said it. Alex has an 8th grade education. He went to work for Al's catering and because he was only about 13years old, he had to be driven to work in the catering truck. He also worked for both Pepsi and Coca Cola hauling cases and eventually became a driver for them. By the time, he was sixteen he was running earth movers and bulldozers. He was a good young man and turned his earnings over to his family.

In 1970 he married and started his own carpet cleaning business. Within a few months, the business grew into full disaster restoration. The company is one of the largest in Canada and has an arm in the US. They clean up and do rebuilds after fires, floods, hurricanes, trauma scenes and environmental issues. Forty-seven years later, he still owns the business which now employs 105 people. Alex's sons run the day to day operation as he retired about 5 years ago.

His marriage produced four sons, all of which are married. They have blessed him with nine grandkids-six girls and three boys. He was married almost forty-two years.

Sherry was born in a little town named Mt. Hope which was just outside of Hamilton, Ontario. Sherry went to school in Stoney Creek and graduated grade 12. She has four sisters, one older and three younger. Two live near her in Hamilton Ontario but the youngest is in PEI and one is in Fairbanks Alaska. Sherry was a good student which allowed her to be exempted from final exams so she left school about a month early. both of her children are married, neither has had any children and they also live in Hamilton. Both Alex and Sherry's parents are deceased.

Sherry worked for the Bank of Nova Scotia for thirty-six years, starting as a clerk, then supervisor and was promoted into management. The bank opened an automotive finance center for car loans both retail and commercial lending. She was Manager of the Accounting, Flooring and Leasing Dept.'s. As well as being the Operations Manager for Ontario. After she retired in 2009 she began doing volunteer work for the Red Cross in the role Emergency Response Team/Disaster Management. Behind the Scenes of the Activity Committee: March 13, 2017

ave you ever thought about what occurs in our monthly committee meetings?

Neither had I and you will not unless you attend one of these meetings.

Here is the step by step process, I hope this allows you to understand why we are always looking for people that will host an event, support an event or contribute to the process.

Let's begin with April events:

Our committee looks at the upcoming month and people start talking about the event itself.

- A. They must decide the one event for the month that will attract our residents.
- B. We have a set monthly dollar amount from Cal Am to use for entertainment for that month only.
- C. So, for example, let's use April 1, as the event, everyone agrees and then we begin building that event.
- D. Who is going to chair this event? Let's say Ned Grove and Linda Webster agree to chairing this event.
 - E. Time of the event to be held: For example 7-10PM.
- F. Will the HOA furnish food, if so what will be offered? We will use finger food for this example.
- G. Entertainment must then be decided. This requires someone to agree to research entertainment for the event, get an estimated cost associated with the entertainers. All entertainers will need to have a contract signed as soon as they are accepted and a Form W-9 filled out. They will get a 1099 at the end of the year if we use them more than once and they are paid \$600.00 and over.
- H. The chair must then prepare a budget for the event. The budget is then presented to the HOA Board for approval. No tickets can be printed until the budget is approved. The chairperson of the event requests tickets be printed by Linda Opaczewski, based on an estimated number to attend the event. Ticket cutoff date is established.
 - I. A flyer is created and presented to Cal AM, who will enter in the display case
- J. Tickets are then given to our sellers along with all the details of the event. Time, Theme, Food menu, cost, entertainment
 - K. Chairperson builds his/her team to work the event.
 - L. Everyone works together and we all relax and move on for the next event.

Our activity committee consists of residents from all types of backgrounds, working together, making suggestions and chairing an event.

We are missing opportunities to host new events because we do not have people to staff the entertainment. I know we have residents that have thought about chairing or helping on an event, but held back due to lack of experience leading a team. We have you covered! Many experienced people are here to help, you are not alone and will get the support you need from the committee as well as the HOA board.

Please help where you can, join us on the **1st Saturday** each month, date is posted and in your media.




