#### From the Desk of the President

The Annual Homeowners Meeting of Island in The Sun will take place in a little over a month. The voting and election of officers and Directors for the HOA for the 2017-2018 term will take place at that meeting. For your information, I will not be running for reelection as President.

The positions of President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Three-year Director and Two-Year Director will be open for election. The One-Year Directors position will be occupied by Don Salisbury who automatically moves from the Two-Year Directors position.

If you are intending to run for any of the 6 open positions, please contact Linda Walker, #301, 540-272-1992, lindawalker.va2006@yahoo.com, or Gerry Fisk, #275, 797-1230, who are on the Nominating Committee, prior to the February HOA Meeting so that they can place your name in nomination. Nominations from the floor will also be accepted at that meeting.

#### **DUTIES OF BOARD MEMBERS**

#### A. The **President** shall:

- 1. Preside at all meetings of the Board and at all association meetings.
- 2. Be an ex-officio member of all committees, except nominating and auditing committees.
- 3. Appoint chair-persons for each activity.
- 4. Appoint an auditing committee of two (2) persons, two (2) months prior to the annual membership meeting and the report of the auditing committee shall be given at the annual meeting.
- 5. Appoint a parliamentarian.
- 6. Call membership meetings, as necessary, with a minimum of fourteen (14) days' notice. The notice must be posted in the clubhouse at least fourteen (14) days prior to the membership meeting along with the reason for the meeting.
- 7. In concurrence with the Board, appoint a person to fill any vacancy on the Board with said appointment remaining in effect until the next annual membership meeting, except for VI B 1 and VI E 3 of the By Laws, successor language for positions of President and Vice-President.
- 8. Appoint two (2) members as Federation of Mobile Homeowners (FMO) representatives.
- 9. Upon completion of his or her term of office, the President may serve the following year as a non-voting member of the Board.
- B. The **Vice President** shall assume the duties of the President in the absence of that officer, or assume the presidency for the unexpired term of the President in the event of a vacancy in that office. If the Vice-President, upon the vacancy of the office of President, declines that office then the Director with one (1) year remaining in office assumes the position of President. If the Director with two (2) years assumes the position of President. If the Director with two (2)

years remaining in office declines, then the Director with three (3) years assumes the position of President. If the Director with three (3) years remaining in office declines the office of President, a general election must be held to fill the office of President. The Director(s) not accepting the office of President shall retain their current position as Director and assist the President and other members of the Board as required.

1. Complete and maintain the monthly activity calendar from information supplied by the Chair-persons and the Board and coordinate all the activities.

#### C. The **Treasurer** shall:

- 1. Have custody of all funds from all activities and make authorized disbursements.
- 2. Deposit all funds in the designated bank, which shall require a signature card for the Treasurer, President, and Vice President.
- 3. Maintain the Treasurer's ledger and report all receipts and disbursements at each regular monthly meeting.
- 4. Provide a detailed financial report for the year and present this report at the annual membership meeting and make copies available for the members.
  - 5. Make the Treasurer's ledger available to the auditing committee as needed.
  - 6. Maintain a petty cash fund, not to exceed \$100.00
  - 7. Submit the Annual Tax Return to the IRS and the Corporate Registration to the State of FL, plus Quarterly Sales Tax Report to State of FL.
- 8. 12 months Treasurer's Template plus all other records, etc., must be passed on to The Treasurer elect.

#### D. The **Secretary** shall:

- 1. Keep records of all monthly, annual, Board, liaison, negotiating and special meetings.
- 2. Present minutes of all the above meetings for approval.
- 3. Keep an up to date listing of members, addresses, telephone numbers, etc.
- 4. Keep all documents and correspondence for the association.
- 5. Send and receive all correspondence for the association.
- 6. Send a copy of the minutes of the monthly meetings to any member that requests them, if that member is not in the park for four (4) consecutive months. The request for same must be given to the Secretary in writing each year and be accompanied by a stamped, self-addressed envelope.
- 7. After each regular Board meeting post the proposed Agenda for the next association general meeting.
  - E. The three (3) directors who are not officers shall:
    - 1. Assist the officers as required.
- 2. The director with one (1) year remaining on term of office shall assume the office of Vice President upon a vacancy occurring in that office and remain so for the unexpired term until the next annual membership meeting.
- 3. If the Director with one (1) year remaining in term of office declines the office of Vice-President, then the Director with two (2) years remaining in term of office shall assume the office of Vice-President. If the Director with two (2) years remaining in term of office declines the office of Vice-President, then the Director with three (3) years remaining in term of office shall assume the office of Vice-President. Should he/she decline the office of Vice-President.
