



MHP Rules – A Two Edged Sword

In Florida and elsewhere, property prices have risen to such a point that living in a mobile home park (MHP) is frequently a last and best option, especially for retirees. However, the arrangement, where the resident buys a house but depends on monthly lot rentals from the MHP operator, is a marriage of unequals. In any dispute, the resident is ill equipped to fight an

opponent with more experience and better access to legal defense.

Most states have laws to regulate MHP's. In Florida, State Law 723 partially mitigates this disparity, but it still exists.

When you sign a rental contract for a lot, you must be given both a copy of the rules and a prospectus for the unit you are purchasing. The prospectus is not a marketing document, it's required by law. The legally binding prospectus is the one in force when the house was first placed in the MHP. That document sets the boundaries of your lot, designates the overall layout of the park with common areas and access roads. It may specify fences, carports and other requirement that each house must meet. Those additions are "grandfathered in". The MHP operator is required to provide this prospectus, and if they do not, they must refund your payments and the purchase price of the house upon application by the new owner with 15 days of the purchase.

Along with the rental agreement is a set of rules. These rules bind the resident to certain behaviors and bind the MHP to certain provisions. The MHP cannot make up new rules, change the rules, and cannot enforce anything that is not set out either in the rules or in FS723. The MHP cannot threaten or evict you for failure to observe rules that are not in the set of rules you were given when you signed the rental agreement. The rules are a two-edged sword.

Protection under these rules requires the resident homeowner to take action. There is no automatic protection against an arbitrary or capricious MHP. That is the problem. Action always requires access to a hearing, a mediation, an arbitration or a court of law.

The Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc. (FMO) was created to help residents who may have an actionable issue against their MHP, or who are facing unjust eviction. They can recommend qualified attorneys, give advice on how to proceed and represent common issues before the Florida legislature. They offer a range of articles and brochures on everything from proper tiedowns to training the officers of an HOA. No MHP resident can afford not to join the FMO for their modest fee of \$25 per year.

Frogs in the Rain

When a frog estivates, his heart rate and digestive system slow dramatically, allowing him to spend several months, and in some cases more than a year, without eating or moving. His fat stores provide energy. Unlike a human, the frog does not lose muscle tone or flexibility as a result of prolonged immobility. Frogs estivate to survive hot summer temperatures or periods of drought. Hibernation, on the

other hand, is a frog's means of surviving freezing winter temperatures.

Unlike hibernation, which is triggered by the season or number of daylight hours, estivation is triggered by the amount of available moisture, regardless of the time of year. When there isn't enough moisture for a frog to survive, the frog buries himself in the mud, sand or other shelter where his bodily functions slow down enough that he can survive until the next rain. As soon as moisture arrives, the frog emerges and his heart rate, breathing and digestion return

to normal. He will return to estivation if conditions become too

dry again.

So those frogs have been with us all winter, through that long dry spell, buried in the mud and sand of the pond. Now they have enough water to mate, lay eggs and in a few weeks tadpoles will swim in numbers large enough to attract wading birds. Four months later, there is new generation of frogs, hopping around and looking for mates.

The bufo, or cane toad, is an invasive species that is poisonous to dogs. If in doubt, catch one, freeze it and go to this site:

Solar Eclipse of 2017

Kenn Brody, lot 64

Like 2 million others, we'll be going to see the total eclipse of the Sun on August 21. In the South Carolina campground we had reserved since March, the total eclipse will start in mid afternoon and last about 2minutes 30 seconds. Don't bother to make camping reservations, there are no more openings in the path of totality. There will not be another one in the US in our lifetimes.

There is something very special going on here. The Moon and Earth all orbit in the plane of the ecliptic, with the Sun at its center. The moon is 238,900 miles away and 2159 miles in diameter. The sun is 93,000,000 miles away and 864,576 miles in diameter. The remarkable thing is that with those exact distances and diameters the Moon exactly fits in the image of the Sun. During a total eclipse, and only in a total eclipse, you can see the atmosphere of the sun, the Corona, roiling out from the Sun in a pearly phosphorescence. No photograph does it justice.

The experience stirs something fundamental in people. First, the day darkens gradually as the Moon's penumbra washes over the landscape. From a high point of vantage you can see the shadow of totality approaching at 1000 miles per hour. Birds go to nest and the world becomes eerily still. Then the disk of the Sun disappears and the glowing strands of the corona, fed by thermonuclear fires at 10,000 degrees Celsius, writhe around the dark disk. You may see a solar prominence or a flare lance out like a Star Wars weapon. The temperature drops. Ever so slowly the sunlight leaks through crater rims on the Moon and shows us the famous "diamond ring" effect. Then the day begins after the short night and the startled birds take flight again.

The eclipse of 1917 was used to prove one prediction of Einstein's General Relativity. The gravitational field of the sun was seen to displace the apparent position of nearby stars exactly as predicted. The effect is known as gravitational lensing, and it is observed in every eclipse.

The penumbra is wide enough so you will see that much even in Florida (see the diagram).

The Buzzard

If you put a buzzard in a pen that is 6 feet by 8 feet and is entirely open at the top, the bird, in spite of its ability to fly, will be an absolute prisoner.

The reason is that a buzzard always begins a flight from the ground with a run of 10 to 12 feet. Without space to run, as is its habit, it will not even attempt to fly, but will remain a prisoner for life in a small jail with no top.

The Bat

The ordinary bat that flies around at night, a remarkable nimble creature in the air, cannot take off from a level place.

If it is placed on the floor or flat ground, all it can do is shuffle about helplessly and, no doubt, painfully, until it reaches some slight elevation from which it can throw itself into the air. Then, at once, it takes off like a flash.

The Bumblebee

A bumblebee, if dropped into an open tumbler, will be there until it dies, unless it is taken out. It never sees the means of escape at the top, but persists in trying to find some way out through the sides near the bottom. It will seek a way where none exists, until it completely destroys itself.

People

In many ways, we are like the buzzard, the bat, and the bumblebee. We struggle about with all our problems and frustrations, never realizing that all we have to do is look up!

That's the answer, the escape route and the solution to any problem....

Just look up!

Sorrow looks back,

And trust in our God, who loves us.






