# **President's Corner**

For three years now, I've been agitating for the Board to address the lot rent issue. The zigzag route from "designated curmudgeon" to HOA President was not one I anticipated. The old label is stuck, somewhere.

This is the second time in six months that Board members have elected a partial exodus. It highlights the stress of changing from a group of event planners to a group that exercises legal authority over the financial wellbeing of 500+ residents. We hope for a pleasant rocking-chair retirement. Instead we see controversy and argument.

Negotiation with Cal-Am is unavoidable. Florida Statute 723.037 provides the framework for rent negotiations. It is, by definition, adversarial. There may be anger, frustration and stress., but there are also rules of decorum to be followed. It is not everyone's idea of a rocking-chair retirement.

Event planning, on the other hand, is a win-win situation. We all love events. The MHP advertises them as community attractions and subsidizes our entertainment. Event planning

may start with some Facebook postings, but the heavy lifting is done by participants at the monthly Activities Meeting. These meeting are open to all residents

Events require short-term volunteer services for cooking, decoration, serving and clean-up. Each major event has a Host, the person who has volunteered to organize that activity. Given a predicted turnout, tickets are printed (thank you Karen Custy) and flyers put up. We hire the DJ or band. On the Thursday before the event we have a ticket count. One of the Board members assists in the purchasing of the food, plates, and decorations to meet that ticket count. In the following two days, the food is cooked, the tables set up, the volunteers come in and welcome the residents. We eat, we dance, we take pictures. We socialize in the best traditions of the community.

We have more than a dozen routine activities, from pickle ball to rummikub, from yoga to Mah Jongg, every day of the week. These are listed in the Monthly Calendar and there are more on the sign-up sheets in the Clubhouse.

Every day I see neighbors cleaning up someone's weeds, taking out their garbage, sharing rides and meals, helping with home projects. This is the visible humanity of IITS. This is why we endure the controversy.

#### Spotlight article: Clay Bowlen, Lot 141

f you leave Morgantown, WV and get as far as Fairchance, PA, there will be a "fairchance" you will reach Uniontown, PA by 4:00 p.m. Fairchance, PA is the birthplace of Clay Bowlen.

Clay's father worked in the coal mines in Fairchance to support his family. When the mines dried up, his father moved the family to Youngstown, Ohio, for opportunities in the steel mills.

At 16, Clay joined the Pennsylvania National Guard. After the Guard was brought under the direction of the Federal Government, Clay was called for basic training to Indiana with possible deployment to Korea. That career was short-live, however, after his mother informed the National Guard that her son was only 16 years old.

When Clay was 19, he joined the U.S. Air Force. He married Dolores Crager before leaving for basic training and his wife remained in Youngstown, pregnant with their first child.

His Air Force career took him to New York, Mississippi and Georgia. Once his hitch was completed, he headed back to his family in Youngstown. As his family grew and with no work in his hometown, Clay took a job with the Army Signal Corps in Cleveland, Ohio, making the 150-mile round trip journey every day. He worked with the Signal Corps until 1973.

In 1975, tired of the Ohio winters, Clay's wife asked him if he would like to move to Florida. At that time, Clay was selling jukeboxes, pinball machines and other types of vending

machines in Cleveland He sold his business and moved himself, his wife and 5 children to Tampa, Florida. Once in Florida Clay received his commercial radio license where he worked with a marine electronics company fixing the electronics on ships, boats and barges. In order that he might be able to receive a pension from the Federal Government, Clay also went back to work as a Civil Service for the Gainesville Veterans Administration Hospital repairing their equipment.

Tragedy struck the Bowlen Family when his wife was killed in a head-on collision with a log truck on her way to Gainesville for treatment of breast cancer.

With his children grown, Clay married again in 2003 in Trenton, Florida. His second wife passed away in 2009. Shortly after her death, Clay received a 50% share of her home in Trenton which he sold. From there he moved to Crystal River.

In Crystal River, he met his fiancé Joan Ottinger, a retired St. Petersburg school teacher in Weeki Wachee. As their romance blossomed, and with Clay's children in Tampa and Joan's in St. Petersburg, they began to explore moving to the Clearwater area to be closer to them. They discovered Island in the Sun and Joan said that the more they learned about it, the more they were drawn to it. In November 2017, they took residence in the home on Lot 141.

When asked what hobbies he was interested in, Clay answered "Joan – she is my only hobby." Both Joan and Clay take turns walking their miniature Schnauzer, Jack, on daily treks up and down Caribbean. And you will easily recognize Clay because he is often confused as Colonel Sanders. If you see Clay, Joan and Jack, introduce yourself and get to know them. You will be glad you did.






